THEME: WALKING THE TALK
TEXT: PSALM 125, I CORINTHIANS 10:31; COLOSSIANS 3:17, 23; EPHESIANS 5:1-2; MATTHEW 21:28-32.

We know what God does and does not want us to do. Do not lie. Do not steal. Do not commit adultery. Do not covet what others have. Do not dishonor thy father and thy mother.
