You are welcome to another wonderful week in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We rejoice with the Harvest Committee for their doggedness and tireless efforts towards the successful hosting of 2022 Adult Harvest.

Believing is a conviction and confession from the heart. In the world system, it is when you see something yourself, you will believe that it is true or exits. But with God, believing comes before seeing. This was why the Lord Jesus had to address the heart of Martha while she was clinching firmly to what she was seeing *-the death of her brother Lazarus;* by reminding her what she had been told before. John 11:40 "Jesus responded, "Didn't I tell you that you will see God's glory if you believe?"

Many people came to Jesus asking for a miracle or healing. Jesus challenged them with this question "do you believe" to challenge their inner intention to actually know if they themselves believe in the power of Christ to heal. There are copious Biblical references as to where Jesus asked whoever looked up to Him for miracle if they believed.

Apart from those asking for either healing or miracle, the importance of believing before seeing was emphasized after the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Then Jesus told him, "You believe because you have seen me. Blessed are those who haven't seen me

and believe anyway." (John 20:29) This was the response of Jesus Christ to Thomas who was resolute that he would not believe the resurrection story told by other disciples until evidences were shown to him by Christ himself. "One of the disciples, Thomas (nicknamed the Twin), was not with the others when Jesus came. They told him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he replied, "I won't believe it unless I see the nail wounds in his hands, put my fingers into them, and place my hand into the wound in his side." (John 20:24-25)

Thomas said, I won't believe it unless I see the nail wounds in his hand, put my finger into them, and place my hand into the wound in his side. Thomas wanted an empirical proves which by world standard was right. At least, no one had ever died and resurrected since the world began. This was the first case and it must be proven beyond any doubt. But the response of Jesus Christ nullified his mindset and taught him a great lesson that it is when we first believe that the blessing of God could rest upon us – "Blessed are those who haven't seen me and believe anyway."

In the New Testament, faith and believe were used interchangeably to represent confident attitude and trust in God, involving commitment to his will for one's life. A person who believes is one who takes God at his word and trusts in Him for salvation. Therefore, it is sufficient to say that it is impossible to please God without believing. Whoever comes to Him must first believe in Him.

In the Gospel appointed for today, we see the family of Mary and Martha that was bereaved. They lost the only man in that family – Lazarus to the dreadful hand of death. Though John only introduces us to the family of Mary, Martha, and Lazarus at the end of Jesus' ministry, Jesus and the disciples often visited their home. Jesus enjoyed their close friendship and hospitality on his visits to Jerusalem, for Bethany was a village just outside of the city. Lazarus was sick, so the sisters contacted Jesus, their close friend who had healed so many. Instead of Jesus to rush into the matter while Lazarus was still sick, He waited two more days.

So, before His arrival, Lazarus had already been in his grave. In the warm climate of Palestine, a dead body would decompose quickly, so a person's body was often buried the same day of death. When Jesus and the disciples arrived in Bethany, many Jews from Jerusalem had gathered to console Lazarus's family.

When they saw Jesus, Martha said to him, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died." Martha possibly realized that Jesus could not have arrived much earlier, but she was confident that Jesus' presence would have prevented Lazarus's death if He had come earlier. Mary makes the same comment later (John 11:32). Despite their pain and sorrow, their faith in Jesus did not waver. The implication for us is that we should not quickly assume that God has let us down when we are in the midst of difficulties.

Then she added, "But even now I know that God will give you whatever you ask." Perhaps Martha thought Jesus would bring her brother back to life. But her reply in verse 24 and subsequent protests at the tomb (John 11:39) suggest otherwise. She did not realize, understand, or dare to hope that Jesus would ask God to give Lazarus back his physical life and be returned to his family. Instead, she reaffirmed her trust in his power even though she thought Jesus had missed an opportunity to display it by healing her brother.

Of a truth Lazarus had died. The situation was crystal clear to everyone around. Nevertheless, Jesus assured Mary and Martha that if they believe they would see the glory of God which is bringing back to life their beloved brother. As Christians, we must always fix our eyes on things that are not seen, because the most effective way through which we can enjoy the manifestation of God's wonders is believing in what He can do regardless of whatever we are passing through.

BENEFITS OF BELIEVING BEFORE SEEING ARE:

1. WE WILL SEE THE GLORY OF GOD:

God's glory refers primarily to his majestic beauty, might and splendor. It also refers to the expression of God's character (Romans 3:23). God's glory is the manifestation of God's character-his ultimate power, transcendence, and moral perfection. God is completely above man and his limitations. Yet God reveals himself to us so that we can worship and follow him. These are what we stand to experience whenever we demonstrate our faith in Him. The glory of God was seen by everyone at the tomb of Lazarus when they saw a dead, decaying and stinking corpse came back alive. Only God could do this.

2. IT BRINGS GOD'S BLESSING

Blessing is God's favor released upon his people. To keep, protect, be gracious and make his face shine upon them. When you ask God to bless others or yourself, you are asking him to do these four things. The blessing you offer will not only help the one receiving it, it will also demonstrate love, encourage others, and provide a model of caring to others.

3. IT ATTRACTS THE PRESENCE OF GOD

Believing even when we have not seen anything any light attracts His presence. By so doing, we are simply demonstrating our confidence in His power to rescue from whatever we are passing through. When God called Abraham to leave his father's house to go to a land He would show him, Abraham left without knowing where he was going to because he knew that the One who had spoken is faithful to whatever He says.

CONCLUSION

Beloved, in our present situation, who do we trust? I hope our trust is not like some Christians who always want to base their faith on what they see alone? In candles, oil, water, handkerchief, mantles etc. that can be carried around. With God, it is what we don't see that birth what is seen and not otherwise. God deals with us in accordance to the state of our heart. What attracts His is the conviction of our heart. Believers see what they are asking God for, not what is happening to them physically. Believing is seeing the result not the problem.
