**5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
SUNDAY, 13TH NOVEMBER, 2022**

THEME: CONTINUING IN FELLOWSHIP IN & OUT OF SEASON

**TEXT: PSALM 76; ZEPHANIAH 1:14-18;
1 THESSALONIANS 5:1-11; MATTHEW 13:24-32.**

Glory to God for the grace and privilege given to us to witness this wonderful Sunday. Our prayer is that as we come humbly before Him, we shall be fed abundantly in Jesus Christ name.

Fellowship is described as the unity of the Spirit that comes from Christians' shared beliefs, apostolic doctrines, convictions, and behaviors. When those shared values are in place, genuine Christian fellowship occurs. This fellowship produces our mutual cooperation in God's worship, God's work, and God's will being done in the world.

Fellowship involves communion and relationship with God and other Christians. It connects us with other believers in the Spirit of God and with God’s blessings. It is a binding force which enables Christians to engage either in a battle or assignment with unity of spirit, soul and body. Undeniably, fellowship is the base of Christian strength and this is the desire of the Lord Jesus that the Church should be one through constant communion.

“Christian fellowship is always a threat to kingdom of darkness. They know that we are strong as we fellowship together and as weak as we do things apart. Satan always hates Christian fellowship; it is his policy to keep Christians apart. Anything which can divide saints from one another he delights in. He attaches far more importance to godly intercourse than we do. Since union is strength, he does his best to promote separation”. [Charles Spurgeon](#)

The depth of fellowship among the early Christians is portrayed in the early chapters of Acts. The believers met together in house groups for teaching, fellowship, the Lord’s Supper, and prayer (Acts 2:42, 46). So deep was their sense of togetherness that the Christians pooled their possessions together and distributed them to brothers and sisters in need (2:44-45; 4:32-35). Love among the believers may have been the dominant characteristic of the early church (1 Thessalonians 4:9; 1 Peter 1:22). Motivated by love, Paul organized a collection for poor believers in Jerusalem. In Romans 15:26, which speaks of the gifts of the churches in Macedonia and Achaia, the word translated “contribution” is the common Greek word for “fellowship.” Similarly, the fellowship that the Philippian church shared with Paul was expressed by the gifts they gave to support the apostle’s ministry (Philippians 1:5; 4:14-15).

And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near (Heb. 10:25 NLT). To neglect Christian meetings is to give up the encouragement and help of other Christians. We gather together to share our faith and to strengthen one another in the Lord. As we get closer to the day when Christ will return, we will face many spiritual struggles and even persecution. In fact, Anti-Christian forces will grow in strength in order to attack the faith of many.

Therefore, difficulties should never be an excuse for missing church services and other spiritual programmes. Rather, as difficulties arise, we should make an even greater effort to be faithful in attendance in and out of season. We must know that this is one of the devices of Satan to break apart, so he can attack us apart. A lot of people are going through the trauma of being apart. They are depressed and confused because no one is there to encourage them.

Beloved, when was the last time you take notice of the person who usually sit close to you at every Church programme but has not been coming? What steps have you taken about the member of your society that you have not been seeing both in the Church and society meetings? What relationship do you even have with those you see regularly? This is a perilous time and if truth be told, we need one another to survive it. Our fellowship is the driving force to fight against the enemy of our souls who is ever out looking for who to devour.

continuous fellowship in and out of season will foster the following:
