# 5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 27<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER, 2022 THEME: CASTING AWAY THE WORKS OF DARKNESS READINGS: PSALM 122, ISAIAH 2:1-5;

The first Sunday of Advent is the beginning of the church year. It is the period beginning on the fourth Sunday before Christmas and ending on Christmas Eve. Advent means coming, and it is a time of preparation for Christmas; the celebration of Christ's first coming. Advent also looks ahead to the Second Coming. It is a penitential period which focuses and prepares Christians majorly for the second coming of the Lord Jesus Christ.

ROMANS 13:8-14; MATTHEW 24:36-44

Preparation is the act of preparing; getting ready, planning, training, or studying with a goal in mind. As Christians, this life's journey for us is temporary, we shall one day come face to face with our Creator either to receive commendation or condemnation (Matt. 25:19 – 28). There is a saying that "proper preparation prevents poor performances". Going by this saying, lack of preparation for the second coming of the Lord will definitely lead to eternal doom and damnation.

In any life adventure, preparation has no alternative. For an aircraft, adequate ground preparation is crucial to successful operation in the air. If you do not want to fail in the air, then, you must prepare well on the ground. Anything that will go well in life must be given adequate preparation. Preparation is the panacea for any impending fear and failure in any given assignment. The level of preparation largely determines level of encounter and quality of results.

One of the major reasons why we must prepare to meet the Lord is because no one can determine His return and it is good that we do not know exactly when Christ will return. If we knew the precise date, we might be tempted to be indolent in our work for Christ. Worse yet, we might plan to keep sinning and then turn to God right at the end. Heaven is not our only goal; we have work to do here. And we must keep on doing it until death or until we see the unmistakable return of our Savior.

Christ's second coming will be swift and unexpected. There will be no opportunity for last-minute repentance or bargaining, because there is no post death arrangement for salvation. The choice we have already made will determine our eternal destiny. This is why we must be very careful how we live our life here. We are put here on earth to prepare for eternity. Another salient truth is that everything we do strikes a cord in eternity.

Jesus' purpose of telling us about his return is not to arouse predictions and calculations about the date but to warn us to be prepared. His prophecy is to warn, charge and prepare our mind that He would sure come back again to take us to be with Him in heaven eternally, but before then, we must occupy for Him. Will you be ready when the Lord shall come? If the trumpet sound as you read this reflection, will you go with Him?

As we await the second coming of the Lord Jesus Christ, we as Christians must give adequate attention to preparing to become a worthy bride of Him when He shall appear. The follow nuggets will help us to adequately prepare if we would apply them to our life

#### 1. PERFECT OBEDIENCE TO HIS WORD (Matt. 24:46):

Like a loving parent, God sets standards for our good and to protect us from evil and harm. God desires obedience motivated not by fear but by love and trust. Obedience actually frees us up to enjoy life as God intended, because it keeps us from becoming entangled or enslaved to those things that distract us and cause us heartache. Even though God's command is sometimes difficult, or doesn't make sense from our human perspective, obedience will always bring blessing, joy, and peace.

## 2. RECOGNIZE CHRIST'S PASSION THAT BRINGS REDEMPTION:

For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works (Titus 2:11-14).

The power to live as a Christian comes from the Holy Spirit, and only those who have been saved can have this kind of experience. Because Christ died and rescued us from sin, we are free from sin's control. God gives us the power and understanding to live according to his will and to do good. Then we will look forward to Christ's wonderful return with eager expectation and hope.

Every Christian is expected to always bear in his/her mind that Christ went through severe agony in order to bring us out of darkness into His marvelous light. Therefore, it become difficult to lay our hands on anything that will jeopardize our relationship with Him.

#### 3. REFLECT ON CHRIST'S SERVANTHOOD

He who is greatest among you, let him be as the younger, and he who governs as he who serves. For who is greater, he who sits at the table, or he who serves? Is it not he who sits at the table? Yet I am among you as the One who serves (Luke 22:26-27).

Paul gave one piece of evidence to illustrate Christ's humility when He came to earth: He took "the form of a bondservant" (Philippians 2:7). There is a divine connection between humility and service. Speaking of Himself, Jesus said that "the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many" (Mark 10:45). He also taught that greatness comes through service. In fact, there is a priority of promotion: servanthood before sainthood (Matthew 20:26-27; 23:11).
