- THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 1ST JANUARY, 2023 THEME: FOLLOWING GOD'S LEADING READINGS: PSALM 8:1-6, GENESIS 17:19-24; ROMANS 4:8-14; LUKE 2:21-24.
- 1. Today is the first Sunday of the New Year 2023. Happy New Year to all of us. We thank God who brought us into the New Year by his grace and mercy. I like the spiritual rhyme of Deuteronomy 6:23 "Then He brought us out from there that He might bring us in, to give us the land of which He swore to our fathers" God brought us out of 2022 on purpose and brought us into 2023 on purpose. We must not take it for granted. Being alive is beyond anyone's permutation or calculation or carefulness or ability. It is basically the workings of God. My prayer is, as God brought us to the first Sunday of 2023, He will take us to the last Sunday and beyond in Jesus Name.
- 2. So, we are talking about following God's leading today. Two Sundays ago, we talked about submitting to God's will. We were reminded of how Mary and Joseph accepted God's will for their lives and they became celebrated in the history of mankind. The wise men in Matthew Chapter 2 were divinely guided to where the baby Jesus was born. A mysterious star led them all the way from the East to Jerusalem and to Bethlehem. We can safely assume it was a long journey but they were safely guided. They didn't miss their way. The star ensured they accomplished their mission or better said, they cooperated with the star. The word 'cooperation' has been used by the Dean repeatedly in the past few weeks. There is something in God's mind. There is a destination ahead. There is something big ahead in 2023. To be on same page with God and get there, we must **cooperate** with him. God is going to ensure you are LED this year unto great accomplishment in the Name of Jesus. Immediately the wise men left, God sent his Angel to go and tell Joseph to flee with the baby and mother to Egypt (Matthew 2:13-15) because Herod will seek to destroy him. Again, after the death of Herod, God spoke to Joseph in a dream to return, saying "for they are dead which sought the young child's life" Matthew 2:19-21. Many of us only listen to God in the morning when we wake up and dump him till when we want to sleep. We have in today's

vocabulary, 'zoned' God. We have created boundaries for him. Like, we can hear whatever he has to say on Sundays only but distant every other day. That shouldn't be. God is interested in our moment by moment endeavors.

- 3. None of us has an inkling of the bit by bit happenings of this year. We can only rest on the one who knows the end right from the beginning. There is a saying that, you cannot know the corner corner of a house more than the occupier of the house. The same way, no one knows what is embedded in 2023 except God, the owner of the year. Over and over again we find the subject of God's leading brought before us in the Word of God. In the Old and New Testaments we have wonderful examples of those who sought God's guidance. We also have a number of very clear statements which show us our need of guidance. Jeremiah 10:23 says, O Lord, I know that the way of man is not in himself: it is not in man that walketh to direct his steps. In Psalm 25, the psalmist kept praying; "Show me your ways...Teach me...Guide me..." (Psalm 25:4,5&9).
- 4. In the Bible, we have examples of people God led. They did certain things which we can learn from as God leads us.
 - a. Believe God: Abraham left his native country not knowing where he was going, but wholly dependent on the leading of God (Genesis 12:1); will you believe God for every inch and mile this year?
 - b. Pray Habitually: Eliezer, Abraham's servant prayed to God to lead him as he went in search of a wife for Isaac (Genesis 24: 42-67); will you pray about every issue this year or you will allow happenstance determine your direction?
 - c. Follow God: Moses and the children of Israel were led by the pillar of cloud by day and of fire by night (Exodus 13:21-22); will you follow God or follow celebrities this year. God is the only pillar. Will you allow God to hold you in the rough terrains on 2023?
