# 5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 4<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER, 2022

THEME: THE BIBLE: GOD'S CURE FOR LIFE'S ILLS

READINGS: ROMANS 15:4-13; JOHN 5:36B - END; ISAIAH 11:1-10

# A. Introduction

Happy and Blessed Sunday to you in Jesus name. All thanks to God Almighty for bringing us to the first Sunday in December, 2022. The rest of the planned goodness for 2022 will not elude you. Sometimes, God reserves the best till the last as he crowns the year with goodness. What is meant for you will find its way to you in Jesus Name. Amen. Truly not of him that wills, not of him that runs, but of God who shows mercy. Today, we are looking at the Bible being the cure for life's ills. If we need to have a peaceful life, the word of God must be the driver. The Bible brings us into the culture of Heaven. The faster we bring people into this culture, the better for the world we live in. The challenge we face now is bringing people into this culture. Until we do this, many ills will keep bedeviling mankind. This meditation will focus on the **Profitability of the Word of God.** Profit is about Gains.

The Bible is a unique Book containing 66 books, written by 40 people, on three continents, in three languages, over a period of 16 centuries. Amongst the writers were fishermen, prophets, scribes, shepherds, farmers, kings, poets, vinedressers, orchard worker, lawyer, and physician. Many lived centuries apart and some lived in countries separated by hundreds of miles. Yet they produced 66 books which together have a remarkable internal harmony. The wonderful unity of the theme is amazing. One thing to also remember is that the Scripture is God-breathed (2Tim3:16). Men were inspired to write what happened and what will happen.

# **B.** The Scriptures Center on Jesus Christ

The writings of the Scriptures are all thematically centered on Jesus Christ as its very life and essence. Jesus made this convincingly clear in John 5:39 'you search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; it is these that testify about me'. The Bible is about Jesus. Jesus who is God in flesh (John 1:1&14), the one who became a sacrifice on our behalf before the Father. This is whom the Bible is written about. Only in the Bible do we read about him from those who knew him and walked with Him. Only in the Bible do we find the words of 1 Cor. 1:9 which says, "God is faithful, through whom you were called into fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord." Only in the Bible do we find the words of Christ who says, "I am the way, the truth, and the life, and no one comes the Father but by me," (John 14:6). Only in Christ, whom the Bible is about, can we find rest. Jesus said, "Come to me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. "Take My yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart; and you shall find rest for your souls. "For My yoke is easy, and my load is light," (Matt. 11:28-30). The length and breadth, high and deep of the Bible is about Jesus Christ. So, if you want to be central, you must center on Jesus Christ, the Word made Flesh.

Do I regularly allow God to correct, teach, rebuke and train me through His Word?

Now I commit you to God and to the word of his grace, which can build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified. (Acts 20:32)
