4. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 15TH JANUARY, 2023 THEME: JESUS TURNS SHAME TO FAME READINGS: PSALM 19, I SAMUEL 3:1-10; 1 CORINTHIANS 6:11B-20; JOHN 2:1-11.

Nobody prays to be put to shame. In fact one of the prayer points everyone must pray this New Year is that God will not allow him or her to be put to shame. Shame is not a good thing to experience. It is a situation whereby one is ridiculed, humiliated, pitied, embarrassed until every iota of dignity and respect is lost and one is put in confusion of what to do.

In John 2:1-11, we read a story of two young intending couple who invited Jesus, his disciples and the mother to grace the occasion of their wedding ceremony. No doubt, one of the joyous occasions in human life is wedding. Therefore, it was a great moment in their lives not just as a couple but as well as mature individuals in the society. Everyone looks towards this day with great pride and honour, especially in Jewish culture; it is always a time to show one's capability to take responsibilities of life. Therefore, the more wine and food people are able to eat is a clear indication of how responsible the couple of the day is.

On this faithful day, Jesus was invited to this wedding in Cana, a village in Galilee, with his mother Mary and his disciples. At the peak of the ceremony, the wedding host's supply of wine runs out. Since hospitality is a vital part of the culture, failing to provide enough wine for guests is a serious problem. The host would be ashamed, embarrassed, and even potentially liable legally for the wine shortage.

Concerned about that, Mary went to Jesus and asked him to intervene. At first, Jesus expressed reluctance, asking Mary, "... why do you involve me?" and telling her that, "My hour has not yet come." (John 2:4). Jesus apparently hadn't intended to start performing public miracles yet. However, moved by compassion, he decided to go ahead and do so – quietly. Jesus focused on love first, and because of his love for everyone at the wedding, he chose to exercise his power to solve the problem.

When Jesus turned water into wine, He did something that no one else could do. He turned the shame of the couple to fame, their ridicule to miracle, their pain to gain. This made the people to believe in Jesus who had the power to turn things around for good. There are lessons we can learn from this story which are:

1. If only we will invite Jesus, He is able to help us in that situation. Jesus is a noble Father, until he's invited, He may not show up. He said- Call upon me in the days of trouble and I will deliver you and you shall glorify me. Psalm 50:15. It is our duty to pray to God, it is the duty of God to answer. Then we can't do our part? The truth is- Devil can only stop us from praying, he cannot stop God from answering us.

- 2. Those who put their confidence in Jesus will never be disappointed. It's clear from this passage that Mary has the confidence that Jesus will grant her request to help the host and guests, and sure enough, Jesus does so. Those who trust in God can never be put to shame. Listen to the confession of the Psalmist in Psalm 9:10 about God-'those who know your name trust you because you have not abandoned any who seek you, Lord'.
- 3. Nothing is impossible to God- God said- I am the Lord, God of all flesh, is there anything too difficult for me? Jer 32:27. Just as God is asking you now- is anything too hard for me? Gen 18:14. One thing is certain- your problem is too small to make God a liar; the one who created the universe cannot lack the ability to re create your life for good. Man's extremity is God's opportunity to show forth His power and majesty.
- 4. His love covers it all. Why would Jesus save the couple from shame? He did that because He loved them. Beloved, God loves you. He does not want shame for you. He came from Heaven to earth to bear your shame that you might be in fame. His Love for you has paid all the cost. The love of God covers your weakness and God is ready to help you out.
- 5. If Jesus is the supplier of your wine, you cannot run out wine. It was true the supplier of the wine fumbled just as any man can fumble. Trusting man is an application for disappointment. Man cannot be trusted 100%. The joy in the story is the fact that there was no more shortage of wine after Jesus provided the wine. As long as the people were ready to drink, the wine was likewise available. This is a call to us. If Jesus is the supplier of your Joy, nothing can bring you sorrow.
- 6. Obedience to God's instructions is what guarantees your miracle this year. Mary told the people, whatever he tells you to do, do it- John 2:5. Your miracle is proportional to your degree of your obedience. Though, it may not make sense, obey it and you will see the miracles of God
- 7. The question I want to ask you is **Who do you run to when you need to refill?** Mary knew Jesus was the right person to run to, she knew because she had a personal relationship with Jesus, she ran to Jesus because she knows the person of Jesus not just Jesus as a son but as a son of God; she recognized the anointing on His life and she honored it... How many people do you think you know but familiarity has made you not recognize & honor the anointing on their life and you fail to go to them when you needed to? Let me ask you- what price do you place on Men of God?

Beloved, God doesn't want us to only believe in miracles, signs and phenomena. He wants us to believe in Him and use our beliefs to cause others to believe in Him. The purpose of His plan is to show His love for us, not only for us to have our fill of wine, or money, or other physical things of this earth. God wants us to hear Him and trust Him, and He responds by His blessings in our lives.
