THEME: FAITHFUL STEWARDSHIP
COMMANDED

READINGS: PSALM 27:1-8, EXODUS 33:12-END; 1 JOHN 1:1-7; MATTHEW 8:1-13.

Happy and wonderful Sunday to you, I pray that this week shall be filled with God's goodness in Jesus Christ's name.

Christian Stewardship refers to the responsibility that Christians have in keeping and using wisely the gifts that God has bestowed. God wishes human beings to be his collaborators in the work of creation, redemption and sanctification. Faithful stewardship is simply doing God's work in God's own way. The most important thing that God looks for whenever in any man before entrusting any assignment into his hand is faithfulness. It is applying and managing all resources God provides for the glory of God and the furtherance of His creation.

Right from the beginning, God created man in the garden to be responsible. God took the man and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it; not only to give him pleasant employment, but to place him on probation, and as the title of this garden, the "garden of the LORD "(Genesis 13:10; Ezekiel 28:13), indicates, it is evident that God intended man to work. This is why slothfulness is condemned in Scripture (Proverbs 15:19; 19:24) and work is encouraged (Ecclesiastes 2:24; 9:9-10; 2 Thessalonians 3:6-13).

Every child of God is commanded by God to be responsible. The only way through which we can be fruitful is to be a faithful stewards of His mandate. The great commission that the Lord Jesus Christ gave to all His disciples is to go into all the world and preach the gospel (Matt. 28:19; Mark 16:15). Jesus told his disciples to go into the world, telling everyone that he had paid the penalty for sin and that those who believe in him can be forgiven and live eternally with God. What an assignment!

Christians today in all parts of the world are telling this Good News to people who haven't heard about Christ. The driving power that carries missionaries around the world and sets Christ's church in motion is the faith that comes from the resurrection and the work committed to their charge. Do you ever feel as though you don't have the skill or determination to be a witness for Christ? You must personally realize that Jesus rose from the dead and lives for you today. As you grow in your relationship with Christ, he will give you both the opportunities and the inner strength to tell his wonderful story of love to the whole world.

For anyone to be a successful steward in the Kingdom, the following points must be noted:

1. ACKNOWLEDGING THE OWNERSHIP OF GOD:

A steward is never the owner of the garden; he is only a custodian. God is the Employer, while he is just an employee. In the beginning of Genesis, God creates everything and puts Adam in the Garden to work it and to take care of it. It is clear that man was created to work and that work is the stewardship of all of the creation that God has given him. Nevertheless, God gave an instruction to the set He puts in the garden. In other word, man is responsible to God.

Therefore, stewardship expresses our obedience regarding the administration of everything God has placed under our control, which is all encompassing. Stewardship is the commitment of one's self and possessions to God's service, recognizing that we do not have the right of control over our property or ourselves.

2. FAITHFUL RESPONSIBILITY:

We are called as God's stewards to manage that which belongs to God. While God has kindly assigned us with the care, development, and enjoyment of everything he owns as his stewards, we are responsible to manage his holdings well and according to his desires and purposes. We must do our best with whatever God has given to us. The Lord calls us to be faithful stewards in everything we do. This is why it is so important, among many things, to honor God with our time, gifts, money, health, and relationships.

3. DAY OF RECKONING AND ACCOUNTABILITY:

As stewards, it is very clear that we are accountable to God. With accountability, there are consequences. This points to the fact that whatever we have are entrusted to us to be used, if an opportunity is not taken, it is lost. An arm not used will atrophy. The Christian steward is called to live in courageous faith because he shall one day give account of everything he was given.

Like the servants in the Parable of the Talents, we will be called to give an account of how we have administered everything we have been given, including our time, money, abilities, information, wisdom, relationships, and authority. We will all give account to the rightful owner as to how well we managed the things he has entrusted to us.

THE DAY OF PAYBACK AND REWARD:

In Colossians 3:23-24 Paul writes: "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving". No one works in vain with God. whatsoever a man does, he shall receive reward commensurate to his deed. We cling to status quo, hoping we can get by without too many crises and challenges, we are content with the usual routine.

Our Lord Jesus Christ commanded us to do business till he comes again and while we do the work, we must ensure that the work is done in accordance to His blueprint.
