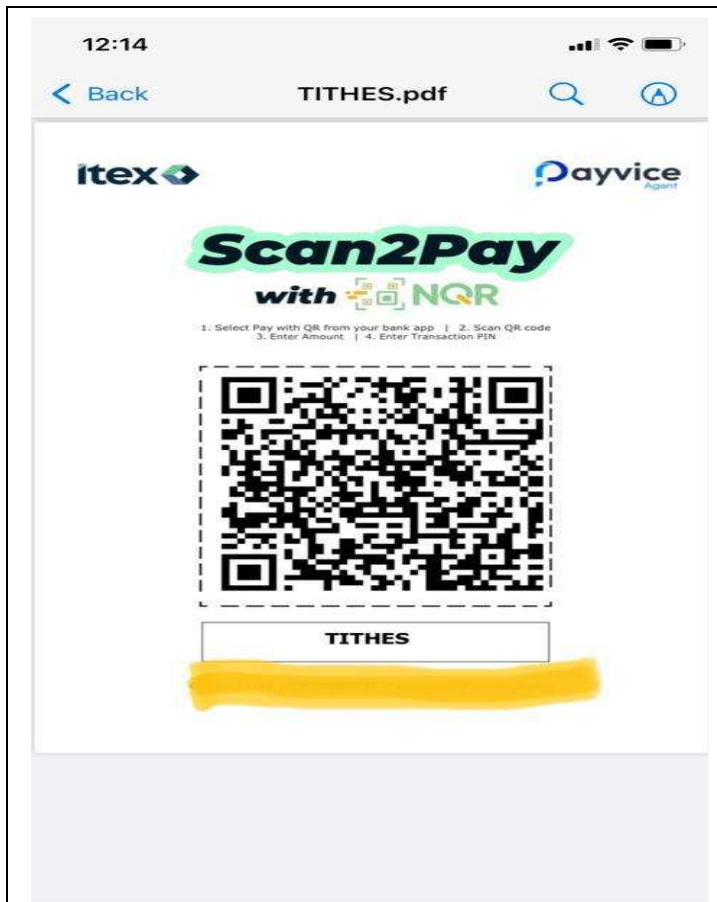

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 19TH FEBRUARY, 2023

THEME: THE CALL TO REPENTANCE

READINGS: PSALM 99:4-9, HOSEA 14:1-7; COLOSSIANS 1:18-23; MARK 2:13-17.

It in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ that we welcome you all to Church and into a new week. Our prayer is that we all shall be richly blessed in Jesus Christ name.

What is repentance:

Literally, many of us understand the word repentance to mean regretting sin and turning from it. But in deeper biblical definition, the word *repent* means changing one's mind so that one's views, values, goals, and ways are changed and one's whole life is lived differently for the glory of God. The change is radical, both inwardly and outwardly; mind and judgment, will and affections, behaviour and life-style, motives and purposes, are all involved. Repenting means starting to live a new life. The Bible also tells us that true repentance will result in a change of actions (**Luke 3:8-14; Acts 3:19**). In summarizing his ministry, Paul declares, "I preached that they should repent and turn to God and demonstrate their repentance by their deeds" (**Acts 26:20**). The short biblical definition of repentance is "a change of mind that results in a change of action."

The call to repent was the first and fundamental summons in the preaching of Jesus (**Matt. 4:17**), John the Baptist (**Matt. 3:2**), the Twelve (**Mark 6:12**), Peter at Pentecost (**Acts 2:38**), Paul to the Gentiles (**Acts 17:30; 26:20**), and the glorified Christ to five of the seven churches in Asia (Rev. 2:5, 16, 22; 3:3, 19). It was part of Jesus' summary of the gospel that was to be taken to the world (Luke 24:47). It corresponds to the constant summons of the Old Testament prophets to Israel to return to the God from whom they had strayed (Jer. 23:22; 25:4-5; Zech. 1:3-6). In fact, the many of the Old Testament from the fall of man is call to repentance. Repentance is always set forth as the path to remission of sins and restoration to God's favor, impenitence as the road to ruin (Luke 13:1-8). Repentance is a fruit of faith, which is itself a fruit of regeneration. But in actual life, repentance is inseparable from faith, being the negative aspect (faith is the positive aspect) of turning to Christ as Lord and Savior.

The idea that there can be saving faith without repentance, and that one can be justified by embracing Christ as Savior while refusing him as Lord, is a destructive delusion. True faith acknowledges Christ as what he truly is, our God-appointed king as well as our God-given priest, and true trust in him as Savior will express itself in submission to him as Lord also. To refuse this is to seek justification through an impenitent faith, which is no faith.

According to the gospel read (Mark 2:1), Capernaum was a key military center for Roman troops as well as a thriving business community. Several major highways intersected in Capernaum, with merchants passing through from as far away as Egypt to the south and Mesopotamia to the north.

Levi (Matthew), a Jew, was appointed by the Romans to be the area's tax collector. He collected taxes from citizens as well as from merchants passing through town. Tax collectors were expected to take a commission on the taxes they collected. Most of them overcharged and vastly enriched themselves. Tax collectors were despised by the Jews because of their reputation for cheating and their support of Rome. The Jews must also have hated to think that some of the money collected went to support pagan religions and temples.

Our Lord Jesus Christ met the Levi in the heart of his business. The day that Levi met Jesus, he held a meeting at his house to introduce others to Jesus. This act of Jesus having relationship with someone they refer to as an ardent sinner was repulsive to the Pharisees and Sadducees. Nevertheless, it was this encounter with the Lord that brought an instant, absolute and perpetual transformation in the life of Levi.

Besides, he did not waste any time starting to witnessing for Jesus! Some people feel that new believers should wait for maturity or training before they begin to tell others about Christ. But, like Levi, new believers can share their faith right away with whatever knowledge, skill, or experience they already have.

IMPACTS AND EVIDENCES OF REPENTANCE

1. A Repentant Person Eschews Sin

A genuinely repented person does not sin because he has no opportunity to sin, but because he hates sin. He does not toy with sin again. With passion, he runs away from every appearance of evil in order to keep his certificate of new birth in Christ.

And if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount"*.

3. A repentant Person Accepts Consequences

A genuinely repentant person will accept consequences. These may include losing the trust of others, relinquishing a position of authority, or submitting to worldly authorities such as law enforcement.

4. There Is A Behavioral Transformation

A truly repentant person will realize he needs God to sanctify his heart. He will proactively work to change his behavior and take steps to avoid sin and temptation that may lead him back to his old life. He is ready to jealously guard his faith against any contamination that may bring reproach to the body of Christ.

CONCLUSION

The main reason for the coming of Jesus Christ is to call sinners to repentance. This is the only thing that the Lord is requesting from anyone who desire to walk with Him. As we are approaching the Lenten Season, let us lay aside every excess weight of sin that easily beset us from running the race set before us and fix our eyes on Jesus Christ, the Author and Perfector of our faith.
