



5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 2ND APRIL, 2023 THEME: HAVING THE MINDSET OF CHRIST READING: ZECHARIAH 9:9-12; PSALM 24; ISAIAH 50:4-9A; PHIL 2:5-11; MATTHEW 21:1-13

We welcome you all to Church today. Today is Palm Sunday, a special feast in the history of the Church. It is the Sunday before Easter, on which Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem is celebrated in many Christian churches by <u>processions</u> in which branches of <u>palms</u> are carried. This began His journey to the cross. May He give us victory in all matters of life.

INTRODUCTION

Having the mindset of Christ means cultivating and accepting the values, attitudes, and behaviours of Jesus Christ. It involves striving to live a life that is consistent with his teachings and example, and seeking to develop qualities such as love, compassion, humility, forgiveness, and selflessness. This is beyond internal impression, but practical demonstration of the attitudes of Christ with a genuine heart.

The mindset of Christ also means accepting the will of God in its entirety without murmuring. Besides, it involves recognizing that we are all created equal in God's eyes and treating others with the same love, respect, and kindness that Jesus showed throughout His life.

Ultimately, having the mindset of Christ is about striving to become more like Jesus in every aspect of our lives, and seeking to serve others, and making positive difference in the world, just as He did. Jesus Christ was humble, willing to give up his rights in order to obey God and serve people. Like Christ, we should have a servant's attitude, serving out of love for God and for others.

The core mindset of Jesus in this scriptural passage is His humility, love, and obedience. Jesus was GOD and yet, out of His great love for us, He chose to come to earth as a human. Jesus even chose to obey God the Father to the point of dying an embarrassing and painful death on the cross for our sins. Jesus is the perfect example of humility, and we are called to follow His example.

Riding on a donkey into Jerusalem by Jesus is symbolic. It is a pure portraiture of His unprecedented spirit of humility and peace. Why did Jesus not ride a warhorse, as He did in Revelation? In the ancient Middle Eastern world, leaders rode horses if they rode to war, but donkeys if they came in peace. First Kings 1:33 mentions Solomon riding a donkey on the day he was recognized as the new king of Israel. Other instances of leaders riding donkeys are **Judges 5:10**; 10:4; 12:14; and **2 Samuel 16:2**.

His rule will extend from sea to sea and from the river to the ends of the earth." (Zech. 9:10)

Developing the attitude of Christ involves making a conscious effort to adopt the values and behaviors of Jesus Christ as outlined in the Bible. Here are some steps that can be helpful in this process:

- 1. STUDY THE LIFE AND TEACHINGS OF JESUS: Read the Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John) in the Bible to gain a deeper understanding of who Jesus was and how he lived his life. Pay attention to his attitudes and behaviors towards others, his humility, his compassion, and his selflessness.
- 2. PRACTICE FORGIVENESS: Forgiveness is a core value of Christianity, and it is essential to developing the attitude of Christ. Make a conscious effort to forgive those who have wronged you, just as Jesus forgave those who crucified him.
- **3. CULTIVATE HUMILITY:** Humility is a key characteristic of Christ. Seek to be humble in your thoughts and actions and put the needs of others before your own.
- **4. DEVELOP A SERVANT'S HEART:** Jesus modeled servanthood, and as his followers, we are called to do the same. Look for opportunities to serve others in your community and in your church.
- **5. PRACTICE LOVE AND COMPASSION:** Love and compassion are at the heart of Jesus' teachings. Make a conscious effort to show love and compassion to those around you, even those who may be difficult to love.
- 6. SEEK TO OBEY GOD: Jesus lived a life of obedience to God's will, and as his followers, we are called to do the same. Seek to align your will with God's will, and make choices that honor and please him.

Remember that developing the attitude of Christ is a lifelong process, and it requires continual effort and growth. But with the help of the Holy Spirit, we can become more like Jesus every day.
