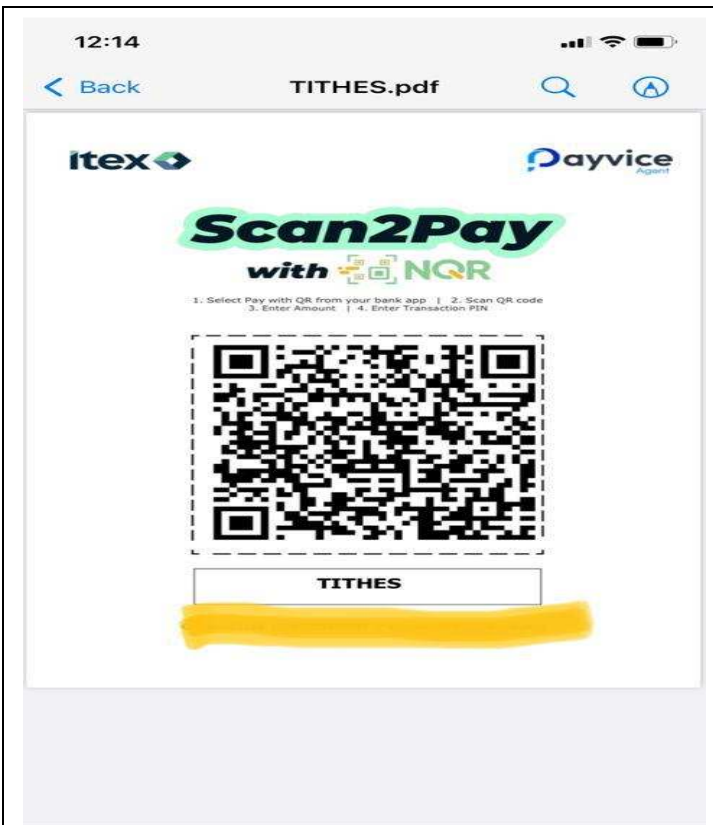

Welcome to today's Sunday service. May God bless you abundantly and grant all your request in Jesus name. Amen.

INTRODUCTION:

This morning we are considering the conversation that happened on the last night before the crucifixion of our Lord Jesus Christ, during the Passover meal. In John chapter 13, Jesus had washed the disciple's feet, predicted his denial by peter, predicted his betrayer by Judas and also talked about his departure that will soon occur. All of this prompted questions about where Jesus was going and what manner of man he is.

In John chapter 14:6, Jesus told and also showed them his IDENTITY "Jesus answered, I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me"

Read this short story Sometimes ago, there was a missionary who lost his way in an Africa jungle. He could not find any landmarks for there was nothing like GOOGLE MAP as at that time. Eventually, he stumbled upon a small hut where he met a young man, he asked if he could lead him out. The young man nodded, rising to his feet and he proceeded into the bush. The missionary followed him for more an hour, at a time the missionary became worried and he asked the young man, "are you sure this is the way? I don't see any path". The young man chuckled and said over his shoulder, "I am the path". That is, I am only the path that will show you the way but I am not the way.

I AM THE WAY:

This statement is one of the “I am” statement of the gospel of John. Jesus declared “ I am the bread of life in John 6:35; “I am the light of the world” in John 8:12; “I am the door” in John 10:9; “I am the good shepherd” in John 10:11; “I am the resurrection and the life” in John 11:25.

“I M” is a substantially loaded Jewish phrase. It finds its roots in Exodus chapter 3, when Moses stands before a burning bush, that is a theophany of God, a display of God, and Moses asks God what is His name, and God replied that “I M WHO I M” (Exod 3:14). So every time Jesus declares “I M” He is saying that He is not just a man, that He is God Himself. The Greek word for way is hodos which means a road, a route, a course. In John 14:6, Jesus gave the assurance of eternity to his followers, sin have created an unmeasurable distance between us and God, but He has come to be the way, and the space between us and God. This plan of salvation through Jesus had been agreed upon before the foundation of world was laid. “according as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world”(Eph 1:4a). This agreement between the father and the son before the foundation of the world is called the covenant of Redemption. It is expected of all believers to follow Him daily. The Rt. Rev. Dr. James Olusola Odedeji said, “When God is leading you, you can never lack direction”.

The only way that can benefit you is JESUS CHRIST.

I AM THE TRUTH:

Jesus is the embodiment this reality. According to John Gill, He said, “Jesus is the true of God, and eternal life; truly and really man; as a prophet he taught the way of God in truth; as a priest, he is a faithful, as well as a merciful one, true and faithful to him that appointed him; as a king, just and true are all his ways and administrations: he is the sum and substance of all the truths of the Gospel; they are all full of him, and Centre in him; and he is the truth of all the types and shadows, promises and prophecies of Old Testament; they have all their accomplishment in him; and he is the true way, in opposition to all false ones of man’s devising”. This is nothing but the truth. Jesus is the key that unlocks all of life’s secrets.

Grant these Your servants purity of heart, strength of purpose, wisdom and selfless spirits so that they may always be best for this Church.
