- 5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 5TH MARCH, 2023
 THEME: MAKING SELF DENIAL MEANINGFUL READINGS: PSALM 33:17-21, ISAIAH 53:1-12; 1 JOHN 3:1-10; LUKE 15:1-10.

INTRODUCTION

Welcome to today's Sunday Service. May God's presence envelope you and give you an undeniable experience in Jesus Name. Amen. The Lenten season is on. This morning we are considering how to make selfdenial meaningful. We want to know the ways we can get the best out of this season. We must know that being mere religious about Lent will fetch us nothing because that was the exact thing the religious people in the days of Prophet Joel were doing. They would rend/tear their garments but not their hearts (Joel 2:13). Any person can put up an act showing they are disciples but their fruits don't align. The difference is simple. A religious person is ceremonial and shallow; lacking relationship with the object of worship. A disciple is a follower intently understudying, learning and living in the life of the master. Following is a major constituent of denying self. Self-denial is about forgetting about yourself. It is about making yourself insignificant for a higher call. Denying yourself is an essential part of the Christian life. Jesus called upon those who wish to be His followers to reject the natural human inclination toward selfishness. "Then Jesus told his disciples, 'If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me" (Matthew 16:24). Self-denial is the willingness to denv oneself of possessions or status, in order to grow in holiness and commitment to God. So I ask this question, what time is it?

1. TIME TO SACRIFICE

Isaiah 53:7 says "He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he opened not his mouth". Jesus denied himself. He could had opened his mouth and call down fire to destroy the Roman Soldiers dragging him but he chose to let go of himself and submit to the assignment to save mankind. That was huge sacrifice. We must follow in his steps. We must be willing to give up something for someone or for some people or for some good course.

2. TIME TO DE-EMPHASIZE

This is not the time play your titles, position, powers, wealth, affluence and might. This is the time to deemphasize. This is the time to understate yourself. This is the time to truly emphasize who Jesus is to the world and live in his life to others. This is not the time for selfglorification. It is not the time for loudness of ego and accomplishment. Nobody contests that you have might but this is the time you soberly deploy your might under the Almighty in reaching the people with no might at all. Phil 2:5-8 says "Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of **no reputation**, and took upon him the form of a servant. and was made in the likeness of men; And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross".

3. TIME TO SERVE

Jesus served.and took upon himself the form of a servant. Please note that he wasn't made a servant. He made himself a servant! The Lord Himself exemplified self-denial (John 13:1–17). He washed the feet of his disciples. All of them. He didn't just washed them. He dried them with a towel. He did a good job of it. Maybe you want to tell the Guild of Stewards that for this Lenten Season, I want to join you in the services to help. Maybe you want to come around and join the janitors in cleaning the Church premises. Something that is flowing from you not compelled or imposed. Maybe you want to join the intercessors in prayers.

4. TIME TO UNCOVER YOUR SINS AND REPENT

Proverbs 28:18 says "He who covers his sins will not prosper, but whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy" This is the time to uncover. Remove the lid. Break the gourd or box wherein you hide those bad behaviours. Repent! Repentance is a personal, sorrowful, regretful and absolute turning away from ungodliness to godliness; turning away from sin to righteousness; turning away from evil to good; turning away from the devil to God. This is the very first call God is made to mankind. Repentance is a U-turn: a complete turn-away from what you have been doing to something new. Repentance is a jettison of the old direction and an embrace of a new one. In Matthew 3:1-2, the Bible says, in those days, John the Baptist came, preaching in the wilderness of Judea and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near. Lent is a time to dump old and spiritually unprofitable ways and embrace the ways of righteousness.

The way God expressed his love towards us was in denying himself for our sake. So, when you deprive yourself of pleasure. The savings made is meant to benefit someone else. Isaiah 58:6-7 throws more light on this. "Is not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ve break every voke? Is it not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? when thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh?" Brethren, Lent is not a time to save money for ourselves. It is a time show love in terms of giving and helping people. The food you deny yourself of must go to someone else.

6. TIME TO FOR SPIRITUAL SERIOUSNESS

So a lot of people fast but neither pray nor study the Bible nor get spiritually serious. They just go through the motions. Fasting is denial of the flesh but you must feed your spirit. When we fast, we beat down the flesh. It is a time to sow unto the Spirit to reap eternal life (Gal 6:8) "Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life". It is the time to properly take our cross and begin to follow Jesus more intently. This is the time our spiritual sensitivity should be higher. This is the time to seek deep revelations from God.

7. TIME TO SOW

Psalm 126:5-6 says "They that sow in tears shall reap in joy. He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him" A wise farmer doesn't eat his seeds. He sows them. For those who are spiritually sensitive, this is the time to sacrificially sow seeds of faith, love, peace, relationship, success et al. Careless farmers eat up their seeds. They consume their seeds. What efforts are we making today for a brighter tomorrow. It might be more time with your spouse or children. You can withdraw from your many activities and spend more time with people to grow and build them.

CONCLUSION

From the moment of our new birth into Jesus Christ, self-denial becomes a daily exercise for the rest of this life on earth (1 Peter 4:1–2). Through daily self-denial and crucifying the flesh, our life in Christ grows and develops more and more. When you are willing to sacrifice your time, energy, rights, position, reputation, privileges, comforts, and even your very life for the sake of Christ, you exemplify what it means to deny yourself (Matthew 10:39) I bid you welcome to a most meaningful time of Lent in Jesus name. Amen
