

All: **I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the Communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the Resurrection of the body and life everlasting.**

**6. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
SUNDAY, 9TH APRIL, 2023**

THEME: OVERCOMING SIN AND DEATH

**READING: EASTER ANTHEM, ISAIAH 25:6-9,
1 CORINTHIANS 15:12-20; JOHN 20:1-18.**

Greeting in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, who has given us grace to witness another Easter in the land of the living. May we all receive grace to witness many more years ahead in Jesus Christ name.

Easter is a feast that celebrates the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. It is considered one of the most significant holidays in the Christian calendar, along with Christmas. In a clear term, at Easter, we celebration our redemption and victory over sin and death through the death of Jesus Christ.

The significance of Easter lies in the belief that Jesus' resurrection represents the ultimate triumph of good over evil, and of life over death. Jesus died on the cross to atone for the sins of humanity, and his resurrection on the third day is the proof of his divine nature and the promise of eternal life for all who believe in him. That is, those who believe in His redemptive work have crossed from death to life.

But tell me this—since we preach that Christ rose from the dead, why are some of you saying there will be no resurrection of the dead? For if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ has not been raised either. And if Christ was not raised, then all our preaching is useless, and your trust in God is useless (1 Cor. 15:12-14). The celebration of Easter is the central belief of our faith; that through Jesus Christ, we have been reconciled to God and have the hope of eternal life. If Christ did not resurrect, then, our faith and gospel are mere vague. If Christ had not risen on the third day as promised, those who falsely indicted Him would be the first set of people to expose His corpse to the public on the third. Besides, the apostles would not have been ready to die for a cause they were not sure of.

People who heard about the Resurrection of Christ for the first time may need time before they could comprehend this amazing experience. Like Mary and the disciples, they may pass through four stages of belief.

1. At first, they may think the story is a fabrication, impossible to believe (John 20:2).
2. Like Peter, they may check out the facts and still be puzzled about what happened (John 20:6).
3. Only when they encounter Jesus personally are they able to accept the truth about the Resurrection (John 20:16).
4. As they commit themselves to the risen Lord and devote their lives to serving him, they begin to understand fully the reality of his presence with them (John 20:28)

The unbelief of the disciples as at that time or anyone else has no capacity to nullify the fact that Jesus had died and risen. He conquered sin and death at His resurrection and has therefore given the same measure of grace to as many that receive Him. As He overcame, so we are as long as we are in Him

"There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death (Rom. 8:1-2). "Not guilty" "let him go free" "he has been pardoned" "someone has paid the price for his crime" etc. What would those words mean to you if you were on death row? The fact is that the whole human race is on death row, justly condemned for repeatedly breaking God's holy law. Without Jesus we would have no hope at all. But thank God! He has declared us not guilty and has offered us freedom from sin and power to do his will.

This life-giving Spirit is the Holy Spirit. He was present at the creation of the world (Genesis 1:2), and he is the power behind the rebirth of every Christian. He gives us the power we need to live the Christian life (John 3:6; Acts 1:3; 1:4-5; 1:5).

Our Lord and Saviour expects that we His children should walk continually in this victory we received through His resurrection. A man is not made free by mere quotation of scriptures, but by walk. We possess our land by walking. Walk is both for the establishment of a law and the breaking of another. When God wants to set a man free, he would make him walk on laws not against it. Let us then consider how we can victoriously keep our walk in the victory that Christ wrought for us?

1. **Confess and repent:** The Bible teaches that we should confess our sins and repent, turning away from sin and towards God. 1 John 1:9 says, *"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness."*
2. **Walk in the Spirit:** The Holy Spirit gives us the power to overcome sin and do the will of God. Galatians 5:16 says, *"So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh."*
3. **Renew your mind in the light of the gospel:** Romans 12:2 says, *"Do not conform to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind."* By focusing on God's truth and renewing our minds with His Word, we can overcome sin which leads to eternal death.
4. **Avoid temptation:** We can overcome sin by avoiding situations that tempt us to sin. Proverbs 4:14-15 says, *"Do not set foot on the path of the wicked or walk in the way of evildoers. Avoid it, do not travel on it; turn from it and go on your way."*
5. **Avoid a sinful lifestyle:** sin is disobedience to God. It separates us from God, and creates a barrier between us and Him. Isaiah 59:2 says, *"But your iniquities have separated you from your God; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear."* Sin leads to death, both physical and spiritual. Romans 6:23, *"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."* Sin brings feelings of guilt and shame. Adam and Eve felt shame after they sinned in the Garden of Eden and tried to hide from God.

Benefits of living a life that has overcome sin and death.

1. **Peace of mind:** Living above sin brings peace of mind, as we are no longer controlled by our sinful desires.
2. **Closer relationship with God:** Living above sin allows us to draw closer to God and experience His presence more fully.
3. **Inner joy and contentment:** Living above sin brings inner joy and contentment, as we no longer seek fulfilment in worldly pleasures.
4. **Positive impact on others:** Living above sin can have a positive impact on others, as we model a Christ-like life and show them the love and grace of God.
5. **Eternal reward:** Living above sin has eternal rewards, as we store up treasures in heaven and inherit eternal life.

Since death could not stop Christ on the third day, this is an assurance for us that death has no power over and after our departure from this part of eternity, we shall definitely reign with the Lord.
