#### 5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK **SUNDAY, 21<sup>ST</sup> MAY, 2023**

THEME: SURELY, JOY COMES AFTER SORROW **READING: PSALM 97; II KINGS 2:1-15;** 

EPHESIANS 4:1-13; JOHN 16:12-24

We really welcome everyone into God's presence this new day, the Day of the Lord. It is the Lord's doiling that we all are alive today and in the name of 1 our Risen Lord, Jesus Christ we welcome you to this worship service. It is another wonderful privilege to partake in His abundant blessing again today.

Our focus this week in the Liturgy is on the topic: "Surely, Joy comes after Sorrow"

In the given text, Jesus is getting His disciples ready for the immense sorrow they would soon experience as they witnessed His arrest, mockery, scourging, and crucifixion. Their entire world would collapse around them. They had placed their expectations and future on the belief that Jesus was the promised Messiah of Israel. On the previous Sunday, they were elated as Jesus entered Jerusalem to the cheers of the crowd. However, their dreams would come to an abrupt and shocking conclusion as they observed their Master undergo agony and death. Jesus readies them (and us) for suffering by instructing that:

# The risen Lord Jesus will turn our sorrows into lasting joy as we look to Him in faith and prayer.

The statement made by Jesus in John 16:16 has caused confusion among Bible commentators and the disciples. There are various interpretations regarding the meaning of the two "little whiles" Jesus referred to. Some argue that the first "little while" refers to His ascension, while others believe that the second "little while" refers to His second coming. However, it seems that the first "little while" refers to Jesus' death, and the second "little while" refers to His resurrection, according to the context. After the disciples saw the risen Lord, their sorrow turned into joy that would last. Nevertheless we must face the reality:

In this fallen world, we are bound to experience sorrows.

Death, which God decreed as the punishment for sin, continues to cause emotional pain when we lose someone dear, despite Christ having eliminated its power and triumph (1 Cor. 15:54-57). Therefore, it's important to acknowledge that being a Christian does not protect us from profound sadness. The intensity of our grief is

is often proportional to the depth of our love, and unexpected deaths can amplify the sorrow. Nonetheless, it's crucial to realize that experiencing deep sorrow and grief during times of loss is not unspiritual. Our grief may differ from that of the world since we have ultimate hope in Christ (1 Thess. 4:13), but we still grieve. Even our Lord Jesus, as described in Isaiah 53:3, experienced sorrow and grief. Hence, it's not ungodly to grieve.

How does the Lord turn our sorrow into joy? Briefly, in four ways:

1. The Lord transforms our grief into joy by revealing the splendor of the cross.

The disciples witnessed the crucifixion of Jesus, which was a shocking and awful event, but they did not depict the cross as melancholic and sorrowful. Instead, they saw it as a glorious and victorious moment because it provided the foundation for God's forgiveness of our sins. The cross is emphasized in preaching because of this reason. Jesus promised to transform the sorrow of his disciples into joy, using the example of a woman giving birth where the pain and anguish are replaced with joy upon seeing the newborn baby (John 16:20-21).

Paul writes in Philippians 3:10-11 that our suffering brings us closer to Christ's sufferings and ultimately leads us to the resurrection of the dead. He also declares in Romans 8:18 that the sufferings we experience in this life are nothing compared to the glory we will experience in the future. Hebrews 12 tells us that as we fix our eyes on Jesus and His suffering, we can then submit to God's discipline in our lives, which yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness. The Lord turns our present sorrow into joy as we get a deeper understanding of the glory of His cross.

- 2. The Lord provides an eternal perspective that turns sorrow into joy. He didn't answer the disciples' questions about the cross immediately, but gave them instruction that allowed them to understand later. After the resurrection, the disciples saw the big picture of what God was doing in history, allowing them to endure suffering for His kingdom. Similarly, the psalmist in Psalm 73 found joy by perceiving the end of the wicked and God's eternal portion for the godly.
- 3. God, through Jesus Christ, acts as our mediator and turns our sorrow into joy by granting our prayers when we ask in line with His will and for the advancement of His kingdom and glory. This promise is reiterated by Jesus in John 16:23-24, and is also mentioned in John 14:13-14 and 15:7,16. When we pray in Jesus' name, we are asking for what He would want, based on His merits and righteousness, not our own. If our prayers are answered, we will experience complete joy.

Although we cannot physically see the risen Lord as the disciples did, we can perceive Him spiritually through our belief in the apostolic testimony. Despite not having seen Him, we can still love Him and experience inexpressible joy that is full of glory. In times of suffering, the Holy Spirit may reveal the riches of Christ to us in new ways, allowing us to see Jesus more clearly. Our sorrows will be completely eradicated when we witness Christ's return in His full power and glory, ushering in our ultimate and eternal joy.

#### Why does the Lord turn our sorrow into lasting joy?

- The Lord turns our sorrow into lasting joy because we grow to be like Him through the process of suffering.
   We become more like our Savior through trials and tribulations, which produce perseverance, proven character, and hope. Even Jesus learned obedience through His sufferings, and we can learn to be more like Him if we trust Him through the process.
- 2. God transforms our grief into enduring happiness, allowing us to guide others towards His allencompassing provision. As Jesus teaches in John 12:24, it is through the death of a grain of wheat that abundant fruit is produced. Similarly, in 2 Corinthians 1:4, Paul explains that God consoles us in our suffering so that we may in turn console others with the same comfort we have received from God.

#### In Conclusion

During times of suffering, it is important to prioritize spending time in God's Word and prayer. Before facing trials, it is essential to seek the Lord to gain wisdom and prepare for the storm. However, when in the midst of the trial, it is crucial to increase the time spent in the Word and prayer. In James 1:5, it is emphasized that those who lack wisdom can ask God for help, and He will generously provide without reproach. Similarly, Jesus encourages His disciples to ask the Father in His name during their time of sorrow, promising that their prayers will be answered.
