SUNDAY, 28TH MAY, 2023**

THEME: POWER FROM ABOVE

READING: PSALM 130; JOEL 2:28-32;

ACTS 2:1-21; JOHN 20:19-31

1. INTRODUCTION

Happy Pentecost Sunday, Beloved of God. Big congratulations to us all for witnessing this year's Pentecost Sunday.

Today is the day we commemorate the outpouring of God's Spirit on the Church. Nobody had an inkling what God had in mind that very day. The disciples only obeyed the instruction to tarry in Jerusalem until they are endued with power. Since that experience, the Church has not remained the same. The Church was launched with fire and has been spreading unquenchably since then. The name of Jesus keeps doing wonders. Tongues keep confessing he is the Lord and knees keep bowing to his Lordship. Many Christians have been killed, churches burnt, Bible stopped in some places, yet, Christianity is on the move and on the glow. The gate of hell can't prevail, neither will the scheme of man. The power we received is unrivalled. No other power can match. Rest assured, the battle we fight here on earth is a won battle. If no one can defeat God, his power released unto the Church remains superior. In Luke 24:49 Jesus said, "*Behold, I send the Promise of My Father upon you; but tarry in the city of Jerusalem until you are endued with power from on high.*" He that is from above is above all...John 3:31. Nobody can get this power without the Holy Spirit." *But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth*" (Acts 1:8). **If the proofs of witnessing are not present in any one or any group, it must be that such persons and groups have not been empowered by the Holy Spirit.**

2. THE UNUSUAL PENTECOST

Traditionally in the Jewish culture, Pentecost is a feast celebrating the giving of the Torah (instruction, teachings and laws) and the summer wheat harvest. It was celebrated 50 days after Passover and was marked by pilgrims coming to Jerusalem from all over the world to celebrate the event (Acts 2:6-11). God aligned the death and resurrection of Jesus with the Passover feast and the empowerment of the Church with the Pentecost. He heralded the dispensation of the Holy Spirit with the unprecedented event of that particular Pentecost. This unusual Pentecost would give birth to an unusual people. No one encounters the Holy Spirit and remains usual.

3. THE UNUSUAL PEOPLE

This unusual Pentecost gave birth to an unusual people. The disciples only gathered to celebrate the normal Pentecost but suddenly, the Holy Spirit made it abnormal. He showed up like a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. Then, there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. They were as amazed as other people around for Pentecost. They thought they were drunk with wine but nay, they were filled the Holy Spirit of the Living God. God launched and commissioned them. Disciples became Apostles. Then we have the Acts of the Apostles. The Holy Spirit acted through them. God worked through them. Power from above will make unusual a usual person.

4. IMPLICATIONS OF THE POWER

The Power of God at work has several implications. Let's look at 6 of them;

- a. **Power to Save Eph 2:1-10:** Nobody is "good enough" to earn salvation! Nobody can work for it. The Gospel of Jesus is the power of God unto salvation. The power from above can save anyone and everyone. On Pentecost day, 3,000 souls were won! Paul told the Ephesians in Eph 2:1-10 that this power was given to us for salvation. It is superior to the power of the devil. *"And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins; Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience....."*
- b. **Power to Overcome Sin and Temptations Romans 6:14:** One of the benefits of the power of God is the ability to overcome sin and temptation. *"For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace."* This verse reminds us that through the power of God, we can overcome the power of sin in our lives. Through the power from above, we can resist the devil and he will flee from us (James 4:7).
- c. **Power Above Limitations Romans 8:11:** The power that indwells every born-again believer is the same power that raised Jesus from the dead and exalted him to the right hand of the Father. This very power that raised Jesus from the dead abides and dwells in you right now precisely so that you might *transcend the limitations of life* and perform supernatural deeds like those performed by Jesus.

Whatever deficiency you may experience in your Christian "life" and your pursuit of "godliness" can be overcome and richly and abundantly supplied to you through God's power.

e. Power for Signs and Wonders Matthew 16:17-18;

Luke 10:19: *"And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."* Immediately the disciples got the power, they were released to do the miraculous. In Acts 3, we read of how Peter and John healed the cripple by the beautiful gate. That was the same gate they have been walking by before and the lame they have been seen before.

f. Power for Greater Works: Now Jesus gave the believers

an open cheque in John 14:12-13: *"Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son"*. We are not limited to only what Jesus did while physically on earth, we can do much more.

5. HOW CAN WE ACCESS THIS POWER FROM

ABOVE? It is as simple as the instruction Jesus gave the disciples in Luke 24:49 Jesus said, *"Behold, I send the Promise of My Father upon you; but tarry in the city of Jerusalem until you are endued with power from on high."* You must tarry in Jerusalem. This means you must wait on God for it. You must ask God for it. Luke 11:13 says *"If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him"*.

6. CONCLUSION

The Holy Spirit is the life wire of the Church and every Christian. No member of the Church can effectively function without the Holy Spirit. What is important right now is to ask yourself if you have received the Promise of the Father; **His Spirit**. When people saw what happened to the disciples of Jesus in Acts 2, they were moved to action. *"Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Men and brethren, what shall we do?"*
