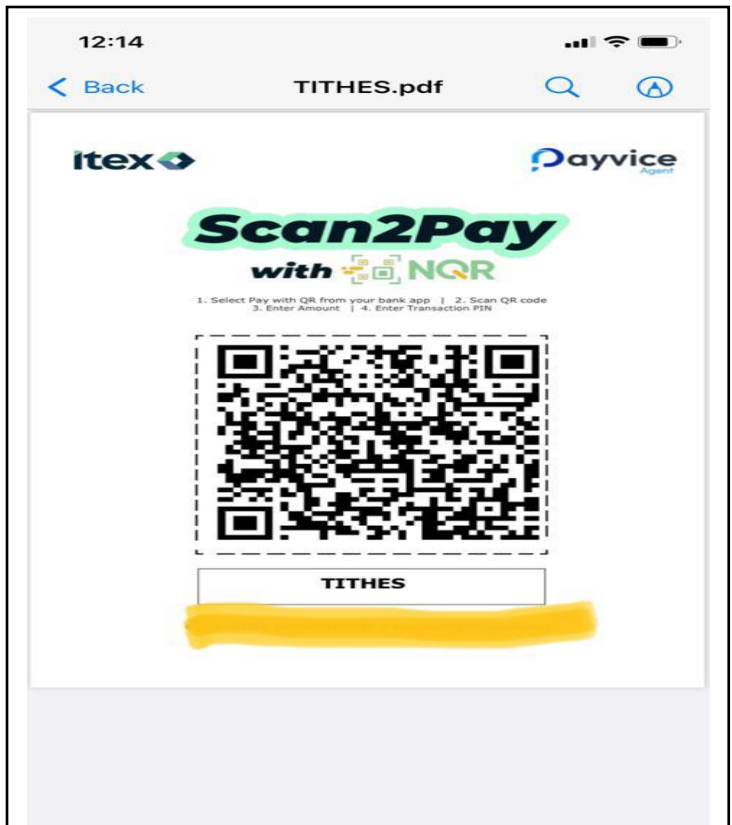

**4. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
SUNDAY, 7TH MAY, 2023**

**THEME: THE MIRACLE OF MULTIPLICATION
BY GOD**

**READING: PSALM 1; PROVERBS 4:10-19;
1 CORINTHIANS 4:14-5:5; JOHN 16:5-22**

No doubt that we now live in a world where life is defined
by riches and possessions.

Money and all that money can do, have become the
yardsticks for measurement and definition of increase
and progress. This has become so driven into our
consciousness that an average poor person believes that
his life is worthless and devoid of God's blessings. And,
this is because in our world of today, blessing means
money and money means blessing.

This malady does not exempt the religious institution
where ministry success is defined by money and all that
money can do. If miracle is simply understood as the
wonders of God, i.e. deeds and occurrences that are
beyond human explanation, it then becomes very easy for
us to know that life or human existence is sustained by
the miraculous power of God. When we pause to ponder
about the kind of divine multiplication that guarantees the
inexhaustible provision of rice, wheat, corn, fishes in the
sea, lagoon and rivers etc. that feed and sustain
humanity, we will then know that every human being,
irrespective of faith leaning, social or financial status, is a
beneficiary of the miracle of multiplication by God.

By this topic, what has to be done is to identify those
things that dispose us to special/particular miracle of
multiplication in our personal individual economies, in
view of the facts that first, God is the author of life and
giver of all that is needed to sustain it; second, before
God, in the order of creation, created man, He created all
that man would need for his life sustenance; and third, all
good and perfect gift comes from Him above.

Jos.1:8 identifies and promises prosperity and good
success that is predicated on the Book of the Law not
departing from our mouth, but instead, meditating in it
day and night, so we may observe to do according to all
that is written in it. Branding the obedience-based
success a good success suggests that there is a brand of
prosperity and success that is not good. And this is what
our appointed psalm, Ps.1, and the Old Testament
Reading for today, Pro.4:10-19, emphatically teach.

Ps.1:1-3 opines that divine blessedness belongs to the
man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor
stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the
scornful; but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and in
His law he meditates day and night. That righteous man
is likened to a tree planted by the rivers of water, that
brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall
not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper.

The similarities in the characteristics/requirements of
good success of Jos.1:8 and divine blessedness of Ps.1
are so obvious for all to see. Pro.4:10-13 exhorts that
walking in divine instructions and wisdom lengthens ones



All the readings warn against the prosperity of the wicked which appears to be trending in our time and clime. People want to increase and enlarge their coasts by hook or crook; Pastors there are, who deploy satanic means to achieve geometrical increase in their memberships numerical strength and establishment of multiple branches; Christians there are, who are into secret cult, ritual killings and all sorts of ungodly things; and by the way, how many Christians in the Church of God can be trusted with management of Church projects and finance, talk less of being trusted with judicious management of public fund? Pro.4:14-15 warns, Do not enter the path of the wicked, and do not walk in the way of evil. Avoid it, do not travel on it; turn away from it and pass on (NKJV) while Ps.1:5 says that the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment. (NKJV).

Today's topic is therefore a reminder to, and a call on true believers to shun the temptation of making it at all cost and believe God for the multiplication, that is, increase, enlargement, prosperity etc that come from divine breath upon our labour.

The Bible clarifies in Ps.127:1-2, Unless the Lord builds the house, they labor in vain who build it; unless the Lord guards the city, the watchman stays awake in vain.

It is vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, To eat the bread of sorrows; for so He gives His beloved sleep. The Bible says in Ps.24:1 that the earth is the Lords and the fullness thereof. and also says in Hag.2:8 - 'The silver is Mine, and the gold is Mine,' says the Lord of hosts.

One thing that is lacking in today's Christianity and which we must learn is godly contentment which the Bible in 1Tim.6:6 describes as great gain. V.7 is instructive - For we brought nothing into the world, and obviously we cannot take anything out of the world; and verses 8-13 warn us against desperation in the pursuit of money. The Bible does not encourage laziness, neither does this article; but it is needful, instructive and profitable to note and bear in mind the admonition of the preacher in Ecl.9:11- I returned and saw under the sun that the race is not to the swift, nor the battle to the strong, nor bread to the wise, nor riches to men of understanding, nor favor to men of skill; but time and chance happen to them all. What the Old Testament called time and chance is the grace that we enjoy in today's New Testament dispensation.

Grace makes the difference and indeed, God is God of multiplication of grace- Jhn.1:16, and sufficiency of grace - 2Cor.12:9 and God of miracle of multiplication- Gen.47:27; Ex.1:7, 12, 20; Deut.1:10, 11, 10:21, 22; 1Chro.5:9, 21:3a; Ps.107:38; Is.9:3; Jer.30:19, 33:22; Dan.1:20; Mat.14:17-20

The miracle of divine multiplication is for all in Christ Jesus, faith can bring it to bear upon your effort, if only you believe in the sufficiency of God for your success, breakthrough and increase. QED!

I pray, God will multiply/increase faith in you- Lk.17:5; grace and peace upon you- 2Pt.1:2b; the word of God in
