**THEME: WHEN REPENTANCE MEETS  
WITH PRAYER**

**READING: PSALM 95:1-7; 1 SAMUEL 7:4-16;  
1 PETER 2:1-10; JOHN 15:1-5**

You are welcome to this fresh week and to church in the most powerful name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Our endeavours this week shall richly blessed and beautified with the glory of God.

**INTRODUCTION:**

*“True repentance never leads to despair. It leads home. It leads to grace.”—John Ortberg*

Church is a congregation of the called out, that is, those who were called out of darkness into the marvellous light of God. Everyone called a child of God is someone who has come to God by genuine repentance which the blood of Jesus wrought for us on the cross of Cavalry.

Repentance is the act of sincere change of heart and a turning away from sinful behaviour. It is an essential aspect of the Christian life and is the first step towards salvation that restores our severed relationship with God. It involves acknowledging and admitting one’s sins or wrongdoings before God, expressing genuine remorse or sorrow for those actions, and making a conscious decision to change and live in accordance with God’s teachings. It goes beyond mere regret or feeling sorry for one’s actions and involves a deep desire to turn away from sin and align one’s life with God’s will.

Repentance is rooted in the belief that all humans are inherently sinful and in need of God’s forgiveness and grace. Through repentance, we demonstrate our humility, our willingness to seek forgiveness, and our desire to live a transformed life guided by the Word of God.

Undeniably, it is a crucial part of the Christian faith, emphasizing the importance of personal responsibility, forgiveness, and reconciliation with God.

Prayer is communion and fellowship with God. Engaging in prayer is a means of communing and deepening our relationship with God, experiencing His presence, and finding solace, comfort, and peace in His love. It is an altar where humanity meets with divinity. On this altar, we lay down our fears, worries and aspirations for God to take over and fight for us (Exodus 14:14)

*Proverbs 15:28 -29 The heart of the righteous studieth to answer: but the mouth of the wicked poureth out evil things. The LORD is far from the wicked: but he heareth the prayer of the righteous.*

God does not answer the prayer of a sinner. Therefore, before anyone can enjoy smooth relationship with God in prayer, what comes first is genuine repentance.

### Steps to repentance

1. **Recognize and acknowledge sin (1Pet. 2:1):** The first step is to honestly recognize and admit one's sins before God. This involves understanding that you have fallen short of God's standards and acknowledging the specific actions, attitudes, or thoughts that are sinful.
2. **Genuine remorse and godly sorrow:** Repentance involves feeling genuine remorse and godly sorrow for your sins. It is not just about being sorry for the consequences of your actions but having a deep sorrow for having offended God and broken His commandments.
3. **Confession:** Confess your sins to God in prayer. Be honest, specific, and transparent about your wrongdoing, expressing your genuine desire for forgiveness. Confession is an essential aspect of repentance, allowing you to bring your sins into the light and seek God's forgiveness.
4. **Repentant heart and turning away from sin:** True repentance involves a change of heart and a sincere desire to turn away from sinful behaviour. This step requires a commitment to intentionally stop engaging in the sinful actions, thoughts, or attitudes that you have confessed. It involves actively seeking to align your life with God's will and relying on His strength to overcome temptation.
5. **Seeking forgiveness and reconciliation:** Repentance involves seeking God's forgiveness and reconciliation. Trusting in the atoning sacrifice of Jesus Christ, ask God to forgive you for your sins, believing that through Christ's sacrifice, you can be forgiven and cleansed. Trust in God's mercy and grace, knowing that He is faithful to forgive those who genuinely repent.

Finally, our repentance must produce fruits which is demonstrated by a change in behaviour. As you grow in your relationship with God, allow His Spirit to transform you from within, producing the fruit of righteousness and holiness in your life. Let your actions, attitudes, and words reflect the transformation that God is working in you.

According to 1 Pet. 2:2, we must yearn to grow up by desiring the sincere milk of the word. When we are born again, we become spiritual new-born babies. If we are healthy, we will yearn to grow. How sad it is that some people never grow up. The need for milk is a natural instinct for a baby, and it signals the desire for nourishment that will lead to growth. Once we see our need for God's Word and begin to find nourishment in Christ, our spiritual appetite will increase, and we will start to mature. How strong is your desire for God's Word since you have repented?
