SUNDAY, 2ND JULY, 2023
THEME: CHARACTERISTICS OF BELIEVERS
READING: PSALM 119:57-64; EXODUS 20:1-17;
EPHESIANS 5:1-10; MATTHEW 19:16-26.**

Let the beauty of Jesus be seen in me
All His wondrous compassion and purity
O Thou Spirit Divine
O my nature refine
Till the beauty of Jesus be seen in me...

The above lyrics of a popular Scripture Union chorus seems to summarize the import of the topic of today's thought for the week... **Characteristics of Believers.**

In common Christian parlance, believers are defined as those who have turned to Christ out of godly sorrow through confession of sins, water baptism and in-dwelling of the Holy Spirit, and are constantly in fellowship with the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

These ones abide in Christ as they enjoy the right to be God's children by adoption- Rom.8:15-16. While this common definition subsists, the world outside the believers' clan looks beyond the intrinsic factors of repentance, confession, baptism etc. to Christ-like characters for identification of believers. This should not be a surprise because, they, the world outside the community of the early Church, first called the followers of Christ Christians because of their resemblance of Jesus Christ in character- Act.11:26.

In today's mingled world of religious inclusivism with its attendant character eclipse that makes it difficult to differentiate between Christians and unbelievers, it becomes necessary to, from time to time, push forward short readings like this to serve as reminders of those characteristics that qualify us to be called Christians, i.e. believers in Christ.

This is the more necessary because the whole created order have their expectations of us, and eagerly wait to see us manifest them as they found in Christ and his disciples of old at Antioch- Rom.8:19.

1. **Walking in faith**

The first characteristic of believers is life of faith and in the sufficiency of the sacrificial death of Jesus Christ on the Cross for our justification and salvation. This faith calls for obedience to the commandments of God as entrenched in the Scriptures. Keeping the commandments of God out of reverential fear for Him, according to Eccl.12:13, is the whole of man- the full, original purpose of his creation, the object of God's providence, the root of character, the foundation of all happiness, the adjustment to all inharmonious circumstances and conditions under the sun and the whole duty for every man.

2. **Walking in love**

God through Moses gave us the Ten Commandments that we might by simple obedience to them play our part in fulfilling God's purpose of creation and live in happiness. Christian Theologians and Bible Scholars categorized the Ten commandments into two essential duties viz Our duty to God (Commandments 1-4) and our duty to our fellow humans (commandments 5-10). And that is what today's Old Testament reading emphasizes; living out the virtues of the commandments. Jesus in Mk.12:29-31, quoting Deut.6:4, affirms LOVE as the summary of the whole commandments of God - "The first of all the commandments is: 'Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one. ³⁰And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' This is the first commandment. ³¹ And the second, like it, is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these." NKJV. This places LOVE as a very essential characteristic of believers. Apostle John says "If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, how can he love God whom he has not seen?" 1 John 4:8.

3. **Walking in Light**

"For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light ⁹(for the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth), ¹⁰finding out what is acceptable to the Lord. ¹¹And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather expose them" - Eph.5:8-11
