**4. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
SUNDAY, 30TH JULY, 2023**

THEME: SET APART FOR GODLY USE

READING: PSALM 119:65-80; 1 SAMUEL 17:37-50; EPHESIANS 6:10-20; JOHN 17:11B-19.

A. INTRODUCTION

Great thanks to the Almighty for bringing us to see this year's Children Harvest. Happy Harvest to all of us. May this not be the last for any of us in Jesus Name. We congratulate our children and pray God's blessings upon them. For our meditation this morning, we have the topic, "Set apart for Godly use". We can use a more encompassing word – "consecrated or sanctified". In the text we read in 1Samuel 17, we could see how God made a good use of the boy David. He faced the mighty Goliath in the name of the Lord. His unlikely weapon was empowered to kill the giant. The main reasons for his success were because he gave himself to God and made himself available for God to use. He didn't hold back. David was around 15 years old when Samuel anointed him king in the midst of his brothers (1Sam 16:12-13).

He was somewhere between the age of 15 and 19 when his father sent him to the battle to check on his brothers. Even when he was a grown up, he wrote in Psalm 84:10 ...*"I had rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God, than to dwell in the tents of wickedness"*. So, as young people, we must be set apart for the great work God has for us and it starts from now. There are many ways we can be useful to God as young people, singing in the choir, joining the Boys & Girls Guild, Boys & Girls Brigade, Royal Gems and Vessels, drama ministry, evangelism ministry, media team, being useful in the Sunday School and Youth Chapel et al. In a society, both the old and young have roles to play. Same way, in the Christian community, we all have roles to play. Who is playing your role? What have you been set apart to do in AVMCC, your home, workplace and the community?

B. HOW DID JESUS DO IT?

Acts 10:38 made us know one of the secrets of Jesus' successful ministry here on earth. *"How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him"*. And so Jesus prayed for the believers in John 17:16-19 *"They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth. As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world. And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified by the truth"*.

If you check very well, three keywords emerged here, yet the same;

- I. Jesus was anointed with the Holy Spirit (Holy Spirit - Acts 10:38)
- II. Jesus was anointed with Power (Power - Acts 10:38)
- III. The disciples were sanctified by the Word of God (Word of God)

'I' and 'II' can roll into one because where the Holy Spirit is, Power is present (Acts 1:8)

'II' and 'III' can roll into one because the Word of God is power and powerful (Heb 4:12; Rom 1:16)

'I' and 'III' can roll into one because the Word of God is Jesus and the Holy Spirit is the Spirit of Jesus (1John 5:7)

Let's read 1John 2:20 from the Amplified Version. John was literally talking to young people *"But you have an anointing from the Holy One [you have been set apart, specially gifted and prepared by the Holy Spirit], and all of you know [the truth because He teaches us, illuminates our minds, and guards us from error]."*

C. PURPOSE OF CONSECRATION

So, basically, there are reasons for the consecration. We don't receive the Holy Spirit to just warm benches. We have the Holy Spirit to witness (Acts 1:8). **THE MOMENT JESUS CAME INTO OUR LIVES, WE BECAME ANNOINTED BY HIS SPIRIT AND POWER; LIVING AND WALKING IN THE TRUTH TO FULFILL THE PURPOSE WE WERE CREATED FOR. THE DAY WE GOT BORN AGAIN, WE WERE BORN OF GOD AND SET APART TO FULFILL DIVINE MANDATE. BELIEVERS ARE SET APART TO BE REFLECTIONS OF CHRIST IN THE WORLD (Ephesians 2:10)**

"For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto **good works**, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them" WE ARE HERE TO CONTINUE THE GOOD WORKS OF JESUS (Acts 10:38). "Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father" (John 14:12)

D. INGREDIENTS FOR PERFORMANCE

1. Walk In Jesus

In Ephesians 5:1-2, Paul said, *therefore, be imitators of God, as beloved children; and walk in love, just as Christ also loved you. "And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit"* The major growth catalyst is the Spirit of the Living God (Ephesians 2:22). Paul told the Athenians about God in Acts 17:28, "*for in Him we live and move and have our being... "Walking in Christ is walking in the Spirit. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit Gal 5:25. Walking in Christ is walking in the light of His teachings. Walking in Christ is appropriating the Word of God (Ps 119:105). Walking in Christ is reflecting the fact that we are in union with Christ, and we will grow in our knowledge and application of the gospel as we bow to Him as the Lord (Col. 2:7).*

2. Walk With Jesus

Three things are involved here; **(1) Association – Matt 4:19, (2) Humility – Micah 6:8 and (3) Learning – Matt 11:28-30.** Associate with Jesus – be born again. Be humble because He is the Master and He knows everything. If we want to fulfil the divine mandate given to us, we must be ready to walk with Jesus. We must be ready to cooperate with him. If you are humble, you will be able to learn from Him. Association is the first step to be taken if we are going to walk in Jesus's footsteps. There has to be a togetherness; a bringing in, an alliance, an agreement that fosters quality relationship. As Christians, our destiny is to walk with God. It is coming into a divine relationship with Christ. Consider the example of these three men in the Bible that walked with God - Enoch, Noah and Abraham.

- "When Enoch had lived 65 years, he became the father of Methuselah. And after he became the father of Methuselah, *Enoch walked with God* 300 years. Enoch walked with God; then he was no more, because God took him away" Gen. 5:21-24. Enoch's fellowship with God was so close that God caught him straight up to heaven to be with Him, without Enoch having to taste of death first.
- Noah was one of a handful of men that impressed the heart of God (Ezekiel 14:12-20). Like Enoch, he is described as a man who "walked with God". "*Noah was a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time, and he walked with God" Genesis 6:9; 7:1.*
- "...the Lord appeared to Abram and said, 'I am God Almighty, walk before me and be blameless'" Genesis 17:1. Like Enoch and Noah, Abraham walked with God (Genesis 24:40) but the New Testament describes the walk of Abraham in a way different from Enoch and Noah. "...'*Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness,*' and he was called God's friend" James 2:23. Abraham's fellowship with the Lord was so great that he was called the "friend" of God (2Chronicles 20:7). Like Enoch, Noah and Abraham, each of us has a choice between two walks - between walking with the world or walking with God (Jas 4:4).
