THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 13TH AUGUST, 2023 4. **INGREDIENTS NEEDED FOR** THEME: SPIRITUAL GROWTH **READING:** PSALM 119:97-112; 1 CHRONICLES 29:1-9: ACTS 2:41-47: MATTHEW 25:31-46.
