

4. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 6TH AUGUST, 2023 THEME: THE CHURCH IN GOD'S DESIGN READING: PSALM 99; EXODUS 34:29-35 11 CORINTHIANS 3:4-18; LUKE 9:28-36.

But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord (2 Cor. 3:18; NKJV).

In the New Testament, the word church does not refer to a denomination or building, but to believers who gather together to worship Jesus as Lord and Savior. The Christian church traces its beginnings back to the first Pentecost following Jesus' death and resurrection. Some have asked, "Did Jesus intend to found a church?" The answer is **yes**, at least according to Jesus' statement in Matthew: "build my church" (Mt 16:18), and calling himself the "Good Shepherd," which implies a community of believers to care for. In Paul's letters, the church is called "the body of Christ," of which Jesus is the head, and "the bride of Christ," of which he is the groom. We worship God when we come together to pray and praise his name, to hear his word, to partake in the sacraments, and to be in fellowship with other believers.

The Church in God's design, which is the theme of this week's meditation, is defined by five attributes, the first four of which are entrenched in the Creeds of our faith. The creeds, especially the Nicene Creed, confess the church as one, holy, catholic and apostolic; four defining characteristics of what the church is called to be. Now, let's look at these defining characteristics:

- i. One There are hundreds of denominations, but only one church, only one people of God, only one body of Christ. Being one, however, does not mean that the church must everywhere be uniform, which allows for differences in history, language, church governance and forms of worship. One of the tragedies of the church is the wasteful time and effort spent fighting "within the family" over doctrine, the sacraments, missions and other matters when there are still so many outside the church. For the life of the Church to be effective, Christians everywhere must eschew divisiveness and be united in faith, heart and mind.
- ii. **Holy** The word holy, in general parlance, often means "religious, pious or sacred." With regard to the church, it means being separated, distinct and set apart for ministry in and to the world.

- iii. **Catholic** The word catholic does not mean *Roman Catholic* but "**universal.**" The church of God is the whole church, the ecumenical church, the worldwide church, created for all peoples everywhere that they might be one human family under the Lordship of Christ.
- iv. **Apostolic** Apostolic means the church founded by the apostles; the church's agreement with the apostles' preaching and teaching about Jesus; and the church's apostolic mission to make him known "to the ends of the earth."
- v. **Transformative** - Ours is a dynamic world that has changed over time for worse and the only solution to the (sin) problem of the world is Jesus Christ who came to the world to save sinners (1 Tim.1:15) and more so that there is no salvation in any other (Acts 4:12). Jesus solves the sin problem through the instrumentality of the Church (body of believers). In the mind of God, the Church is purposed and designed to transform the people within and outside the fold into the perfect image of Christ. Ostensibly because humans are made of flesh and blood, Christians do err; even the very best of us still show that we are human and show forth our frailty in disappointing failures. So, for this very reason, the Church has not been effective in her mission of transforming the ailing world and this has become a matter of grave concern because of its backlash on the Church, making her to lose her unique identity and relevance. Our pivotal Scripture from 2 Cor.3:18 places transformative role on each and ever one of us that bear the name of the Lord as Christians.
- vi. **Purpose-driven** The Church that Christ established is vested with a five-dimensional purpose of <u>worship</u>, <u>fellowship</u>, <u>discipleship</u>, <u>ministry</u>, and <u>mission</u>.
- vii. Glorious and Obedient The transfiguration of Jesus Christ on the mountain (Luke 9:28-36) depicts the glorious nature of the Church Christ was going to build; the Bible says his appearance was glorious. The voice from heaven gave a command to the Church and the world through the disciples that were present "This is My beloved Son. Hear Him!"
