



experience unprecedent progress, the people must live a just, fair, and equitable lifestyle. The three major words from this topic which are just, fair, and equitable are interconnected and intertwined. They are veritable virtues needed even for the edification of the body of Christ.

To be just: means to act in an upright, moral, and impartial way, upholding principles of justice and righteousness in all our dealings with everyone regardless of their spiritual, academic, social, or cultural background. Being just involves living righteously, uprightly and treating others with fairness and without discrimination, ensuring that their rights are respected, and making decisions or taking actions that align with biblical standards.

Being fair: means to treat people, situations, or issues with impartiality, equity, and justice, without favoritism or prejudice. Being fair involves making decisions or judgments that are free from bias and are based on objective criteria or principles. It often implies giving everyone an equal and just opportunity, considering all relevant factors, and ensuring that the outcome or treatment is reasonable and unbiased.

Being equitable: means ensuring fairness and impartiality in the distribution of resources, opportunities, and benefits. It involves recognizing that people have different needs, circumstances, and abilities, and making adjustments to provide them with what they need to achieve a similar outcome. Equity seeks to address and rectify systemic inequalities and disparities that can result from historical or structural factors. In essence, equity aims to level the playing field and promote fairness by acknowledging and addressing differences in a just and fair manner.

If the truth be told, it is only a life that is deeply saturated with the love of God that can manifest all these three qualities. The tree upon which branches you can find them is love. "Love" is a theme that is at the core of the Christian Gospel. John 3:16 tells us that "for God so loved the world that he gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life." The gift of grace through Christ is for "whoever believes". No discrimination or segregation as to who can enter into this grace. God is just to the point that everyone needs the same measure of grace to be saved. God's love for mankind is evident, and Christ's call for believers to replicate that love is also at the core of living an authentically gospel-driven life. Christ's love is characterized by compassion, forgiveness,

"The sacrifice which costs us nothing is worth nothing". In the gospel assigned for today, we see a man who did everything to rescue the life of someone he has never met. What a just and fair man? This man exhibited love which knows no boundary, and end. Even when those expected by their religious inclination passed-by and looked away, this man gave his attention, time, and money to rescue the perishing and dying soul.

The Parable of the Good Samaritan teaches us numerous life lessons, but the core of the message is to love and be fair to one another Even if we are busy, tired, late, don't know them, or don't like them - we are still called to love.Jesus used the Parable of the Good Samaritan to describe what it means to *love our* neighbor. He described that when we help those in need (like the Good Samaritan did), we're helping Him. When we see someone in need, we're seeing a 'brother or sister' of Jesus. The Good Samaritan likely had things to do and places to be because he was on a journey. He had a life and obligations. Besides, he may have been inconvenienced to help the hurt man, but he was not deterred.

This man puts his life aside for the moment and did what was required to make sure the man got the help he needed. When God calls, do we listen? When he puts a circumstance in our path, do we walk around it, as the priest and Levite did, or take it on, as the Samaritan did? Do we let our obligations and worldly wishes get in the way of loving our neighbors as Jesus asks of us? A good intention that is never acted upon is worth nothing in God's Kingdom. What matters to Jesus is the *action* we take in the form of the help and support we give to those in need.

This topic is a clarion call that we should check how we deal with people around us. Our concern, passion, and empathy to people around us who need our help must flow from a godly, just, and fair heart. Every step taken in a bid that the recipient should reciprocate is selfish and unacceptable to
