4. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 1ST OCTOBER, 2023

THEME: HANDLING OPPOSITION

READING: PSALM 145:14-21; NEHEMIAH 6:1 -16; 1 PETER 4:7-11; MATTHEW 25:14-30

INTRODUCTION

When Igor Sikorsky was 12, his parents told him that competent authorities had already proved human flight impossible. He went on to build the first helicopter. In his American plant, he posted this sign: "According to recognized aerotechnical tests, the bumblebee cannot fly because of the shape and weight of his body in relation to the total wing area. The bumblebee does not know this, so he goes ahead and flies anyway"

Igor Sikorsky's story is synonymous to that of Nehemiah. He was intentional about rebuilding the walls of Jerusalem and reforms the people. We are not oblivious of the hoax of the devil as recorded in John 10:10; "For the thieve cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. Hence, the adversary is swift in using all in his cruel arsenal to oppose the people of God and Gods work.

It should interest us that the devil doesn't interest himself in the faint hearted or the half hearted people who do not have a right spiritual standing. He launches out for the strong, those who are burning and intentional about a godly cause and the gospel. As long as you dust off spiritual lethargy and refrain from worldly perceptions, thereby committing yourself to godly things and being radically committed to radical obedience in Christ Jesus, you will begin to face strive; oppositions as did Nehemiah when rebuilding the wall of Jerusalem.

THE OPPOSITION OF MEN [Nehemiah as case study] Nehemiah, through chapter 3 to 6 shows the different setback that was experienced. There is a cycle of setbacks and progress during this time.

The cycle in this chapter shows that the Christian life is a conflict. The oppositions will come thick and fast and the adversary will try to sidetrack you. Even though it was Gods will for the wall to be rebuilt, God didn't remove the opposition. God wants us to grow in faith and Christian life, yet, He will not refrain us from oppositions. Our response to this opposition will drive us to greatly depend on God and to perform His will for your life.

OUR TEXT REVEALS FEW OPPOSITIONS THAT MAY COME OUR WAY.

- 1. THE VEXATION OF OTHERS AGAINST YOU; [Neh. 4:1,7] Sanballat, the governor in Samaria was Vexed. From the Hebrew word it means burning mad. Should Jerusalem be secured and independent, threatens his hold in that area hence affecting his economy. He then jettisoned his grievances with neighboring governors to fight this progress. The devil uses people's anger to squelch the new found joy of a believer.
- 2. MOCKERY & SARCASM [Neh. 4:2] Sanballat and the others stood afar to mock the Nehemiah and is proposed work. Tobiah scoffed at him and questioned the credibility of the wall should a fox fall on it. Satan uses ridicula accinet the people who stood for Christ and do



Sanballat and his cohorts use some gangs to harass those who are working and intimidate them. And tell the Artaxerxes otherwise. Satan today uses herdsmen etc to harass and intimidate the people of God. He uses subtle and intimidation at work place, family, society and even in the church!

- 4. **DISCOURAGEMENT** [Neh. 4:6, 10] the song of exhaustion and discouragement was echoed by the workers when they didn't notice any form of progress. Their spirit was down. Satan knows when to strike the people of God and bring weariness to their spirit. When begin with Christ we are enthused, but half way most times, we become tired and the zeal begin to deem.
- 5. **FEAR**. Fear is the cumulative factor of the aforementioned. Satan uses fear to paralyze Gods people and make them withdraw from doing that which is the will of God.

Therefore, how then do we respond as children of light? Nehemiah chapter 4 is a template on how to deal with opposition in our Christian journey.

- 1. WE RAISE AN ALTAR OF PRAYER. Often when we are hit with opposition, we get angry and our response is to defend ourselves. But we are rightly meant to build an altar of prayer around such matters. Prayer reminds us of the omnipotence of God over our adversaries. This was not a prayer for vengeance. It was a prayer to God to Judge sinners. Secondly, it was a prayer to judge those hindering the work of God and his kingdom and lastly it was to establish Gods kingdom on earth as it was in heaven. When we pray to God, our life reflects him as our strong tower and shield.
- 2. WE PUT OUR HEART TO WORK; [Neh. 4:6]it was obvious in the scripture that the people had a heart to work. They kept up with the pace of the work even when the enemy was right behind them. In Titus 1:9-16, false teachers were refuted and the sound doctrine was thought. However, we won't get distracted fighting them and forget the primary work. We can defend ourselves and the faith with God's word so that we can build the kingdom with the trowel. To get sidetracked onto defending the faith to the neglect of winning and building people is to forget our goal.
- 3. WE ARE VIGILANT AGAINST THE ADVERSORY HOAX; Albeit Nehemiah prayed, he setup his guard. "Trust God and keep your powder dry" As much as he prayed, it didn't take away the enemies opposition and threat. We aren't expected to just pray alone, we must also watch! We as Christians must not be oblivious of the tactics of the adversary. We must put on the full armour of God so that we would not be devoured by the devil. 1 Peter 5:8. The companies we keep, what we expose our self to. We must have a network of godly brethren whom we can pray together like Nehemiah during the devils opposition.
- 4. WE FOCUS OUR MIND ON THE LORD. [Neh. 4:14] when the oppositions hit, it is easy to get our mind off the will of God. Nehemiah was intentional and strengthened the people in the text to refocus their mind to the Lord who is able to deliver them from the hoax. 1 Cor. 10:13 and Col 3:2 reminds us of Gods unwavering power. We must keep our mind focused on the Lord.


