

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 22ND OCTOBER, 2023 THEME: DELAY IS NOT DENIAL READING: PSALM 133; GENESIS 11:1-9, EPHESIANS 3:20-4:6; JOHN 11:17-27.

INTRODUCTION:

Happy Sunday and welcome to Church this fourth Sunday in October. Again and again, coming to Church is a blessing as highlighted in the Bible. We need the socio-spiritual blessings of being part of the body of Christ. Today, we are considering the topic, Delay is not Denial. Most of us get easily discouraged when our expectations, desires and requests are not met within our own timing. This message is thrusting on the fact that when we experience delay, it doesn't mean we are denied. However, we must be quick to differentiate between when God is at work and when the devil is at work. When the devil is at work, it is not delay. It is denial from the word 'go'. The devil has no joy. So he gives no joy. The devil has no hope, so he gives no hope. When a process is ongoing and care is not taken, the devil can intercept and make waiting agonizing (Daniel 10). God showed up in the situation and provided help. I'm glad to announce to you today that we have a God in Heaven who watches over his word to perform it. "Then said the Lord to me, you have seen well, for I am alert and active, watching over mv word to perform it. "(Jeremiah 1:12AMP)

So, God wants you to stop worrying about how long the breakthrough is taking to manifest, and focus on the fact that his promises don't expire. Whatever He said shall come to pass, no matter how long it takes. Delay does NOT mean denial! Delay is a period when something that might happen does not happen or does not happen quickly enough while Denial is refusal of something requested or desired.

All things being equal, minus the SKD (steal, kill & destroy) ministry of the devil, let's look at seven (7) truths about the concept of delay in the doings and workings of God.

Truth 1. God's delay is from the place of Love and Purpose

On the surface, it appeared Jesus was indifferent towards Lazarus and his family. John, however, reveals that love drove Jesus's choice. Every interaction of God with us is from the place of Love. "Now Jesus loved Martha, her sister, and Lazarus. So when he heard that he was sick, he stayed two more days in the place where he was" (John 11:5-6). He delayed because he loved Lazarus' family. The family had been chosen to show forth the glory of God (v4). Indeed they were a chosen people. Their fame would go forth and far. News would carry the incidence. You see there is a reason for the 5years or 10years or 15years delay of that which you are expecting. Abraham had delay. Hannah had delay. Joseph had delay. Elizabeth had delay. They all had delays and for a purpose. We know the outcome of the waiting period for all of them. Say with me this morning. "Father, I know you love me beyond my comprehension. Whatever you are taking me through me is because you love me and I am the called according to your purpose" Romans 8:28

Truth 2. There is always an answer – God always answers.

We must start to operate from the place of faith that God has answered our prayers.1 John 5:14-15, "Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him". God always answers our prayers one way or the other. There are three notable ways God answers our prayers. (i)Yes, you will have it at his specified time. (ii) Yes, but wait and be patient (iii) No, you do not need it. Now if God says you don't need something, please don't look for it by all means. It won't end well. When God declines, it is for our utmost good. Apostle Paul asked God to remove a thorn in his flesh (pain in his life) but God said 'NO' (2Cor 12:7). He pumped in more grace for him. Say with me 'I receive grace to wait on God and I stay contented and happy in the will of God for my life in Jesus Name.

Truth 3. God's ways are not our ways

Isaiah 55:8-9. "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways," says the Lord. "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts". God's thinking are totally different from the ways we think. God may be thinking 10years to respond while we are thinking 3years. In the Gospel of John that we read, Lazarus was not yet dead when Jesus was informed. He even told his disciples in verse 4 that the sickness is not unto death but for God's glory. He waited two more days. By the time he got there in verse 17, Lazarus had been dead for four days, yet he lived. God is the game-changer. God cannot be pinned to a formula or routine. He is sovereign. He does as he likes. He can choose a David to kill a Goliath. He can choose a manger instead of palace. He can heal through mud or word. I'll rather you stick to God's ways. It's better, safer and shorter in the long run.

Truth 4. God is dependably faithful to His Word.

Hebrews 10:23. "Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; for he is faithful that promised". God does not lie. He has never lied and will not lie. Deceit is never part of God. It is impossibly impossible that God would lie. His words are forever settled in Heaven and his faithfulness endures to all generations; He established the earth and it abides.... (Psalm 119:89-91). Most times, we do not always tend to agree with how God is running the world and our lives, but the truth is, He makes the rules, not us. It is futile for us to complain about His plan for the world and our lives. It is wise to submit our lives to his agenda rather than fight his loving and perfect plan. It could be frustrating when there is delay but we must know he is constantly dependable. Please tell yourself right now, "God is too faithful to fail me. It might be slow but he will come through for me. The journey might be slow but he will take me there"

Truth 5. God might be protecting you from harm.

Psalm 3:3 "But you, O LORD, are a shield about me, my glory, and the lifter of my head." The delay you are experiencing may be God's way of protecting you from something harmful. He knows everything about everything. He knows the people, places, things, and happenings in all places at all times. He knows the outcome before it occurs. Because he loves you deeply, he only wants those things in your life that will further his work and accomplish his will. 'Remember that all his plans are GOOD'. (Romans 8:28)

Truth 6. God might be delaying to grow your faith.

James 1:2 "Count is all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness." When we experience delay, it may just be God's way of growing our faith. He is saying "Just trust me". Our faith, our character, and our understanding of God can grow dramatically when we learn to trust him in the delays.

Truth 7. God might be delaying because he is waiting for you

Quite often when we think we're waiting on God, God is actually the one waiting for us. You may not be ready to handle the blessing he wants to give you, and so he's waiting for you to spiritually mature. The reason why he has not brought the man or lady you are to marry might be because he needs you to adjust something in your life. He is waiting. Maybe he needs you to turn away from a sinful lifestyle. Maybe he wants to you to reconcile with someone. Maybe he needs you to give something to someone. Two scriptures to consider are:

- "The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance" (2Peter 3:9 NIV).
- "And the Lord [d] restored Job's losses when he prayed for his friends. Indeed the Lord gave Job twice as much as he had before" (Job 42:10 NKJV).

CONCLUSION

Beloved, whatever the problems we are facing, we need to remember that God is working behind the scenes. We need to trust him, believe him, be prayerful and be patient. The Bible says, *"Therefore be patient, brethren, until the coming of the Lord. See how the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth, waiting patiently for it until it receives the early and latter rain. 8 You also be patient. Establish your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is at hand"* (James 5:7-8 NKJV). I pray for you that as you wait on God this week, your strength will be renewed. You will mount up with wings like the eagle. You will not be faint. You will not be wearied in Jesus Name. Amen. Have a blessed week.
