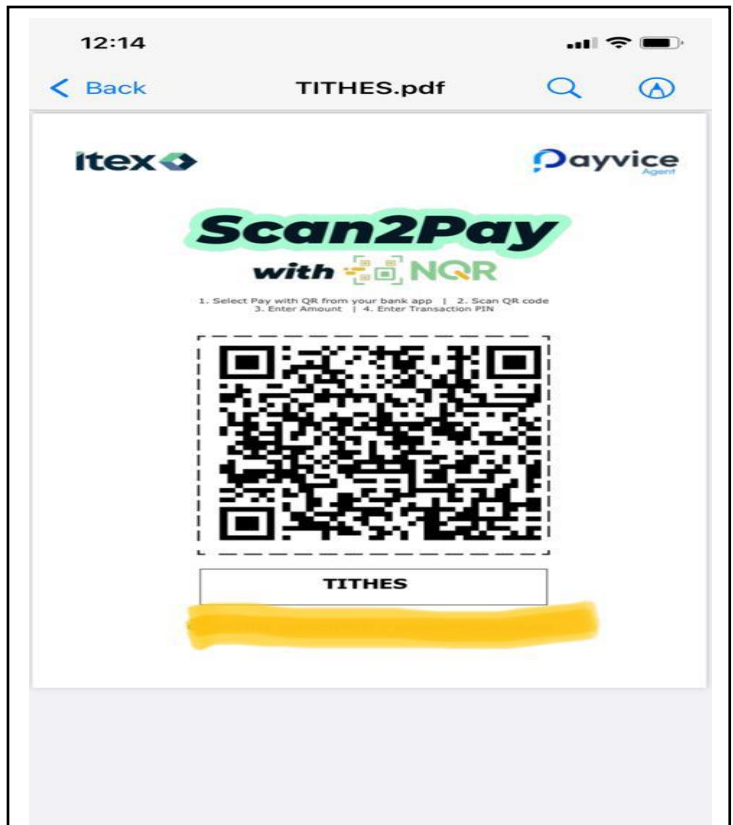

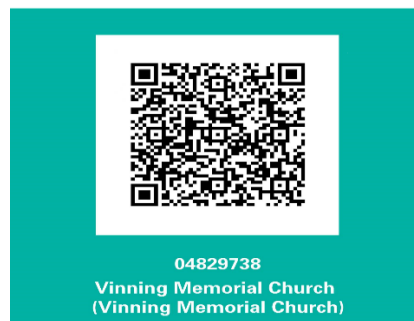

**4. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
SUNDAY, 8TH OCTOBER, 2023**

THEME: THE KEY TO SUPERNATURAL LIVING

READING: PSALM 65:1-7; DANIEL 6:10-23;

HEBREWS 11:1-2, 8-16; MARK 2:1-12.

INTRODUCTION

Glory to God who has given the grace to be among those who will sing living praise to Him in His Sanctuary today. I pray that His majestic presence will form our experience as we gather to fellowship in Jesus Christ name.

Living in the supernatural is a life guided by faith, which has a close relationship with God. It involves experiencing the presence and power of God in one's daily life. Supernatural life is a life that can only be lived by the in dwelling power of Holy Spirit.

This life that goes beyond the ordinary and natural aspects of existence. It implies experiences, phenomena, or aspects of life that cannot be explained solely by natural laws or scientific understanding. God is the main source of this kind of life. Therefore, for anyone to access it, he must know God. That does not mean we just know about Him by hear knowledge which is perculiar to virtually everybody. Knowing Him means having an intimate relationship with Him. It means He is the first thing we think of when we open your eyes in the morning, and the last we think of when we go to bed at night. Listening to Him all day, every day, and letting Him talk to us through His written Word and by His Spirit is how we get to know Him. Brethren, we come to really know the Lord by actively seeking Him above everything else and recognizing Him as our source (Matthew 6:31-33).

Supernatural life is closely tied to a spiritual relationship with God and the transformative work of the Holy Spirit in the lives of believers. Here are some keys to supernatural life:

FAITH (Heb. 11:1-6): Living in the supernatural requires faith in God and His promises. If the truth be told, the first key that unlocks the supernatural realm is faith, without it, no one can please God. In every situation of life that we pass through, what God is always looking for is our demonstration of faith. *Heb 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.*

Hebrews 11:1 *defines faith as the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.* Faith is the force that enables us to believe the words of God even when we are yet to see the physical manifestation. The world standard is *"seen is believing."* That is, whatever that can not be emperically proven has no standing point and is baseless. Conversely, with faith, you must believe before seeing the glory of God. John 11:40 *"Jesus saith unto her, Said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldest believe, thou shouldest see the glory of God?"*

BORN AGAIN (John 3:3-8): another veritable key to living a supernatural life is a life that has been transformed through the word and the Spirit of God. Life beget life. Being born again signifies a spiritual rebirth where believers receive a new, supernatural nature. Adamic nature, a man in his fallen and old life can never experience supernatural until it is rebirth. A supernatural life involves a transformation of character and conduct as believers become more Christ-like. This transformation is described in 2 Corinthians 5:17: "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"

INDWELLING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT: A supernatural life involves the presence of the Holy Spirit within believers. This Spirit guides, empowers, and transforms their lives. (Romans 8:9-11). In Act chapter one, Jesus told His disciples He wanted them to receive this power, to be "endued with power from on high." He gave them instructions to wait in Jerusalem until He sent the Holy Spirit for this purpose. And, before being crucified He said: "Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do, because I go unto my Father" (John 14:12).

Greater works-exploits! That's what Jesus expects us to do. And we can when we yield to the Holy Spirit who dwells within us. Jesus knew His disciples had to have the Baptism in the Holy Spirit to do the mighty works God planned for them. That has not changed. Knowing Jesus as our Savior and being filled with the Spirit are keys to supernatural living.

A LIFE OF PRAYER (Daniel 6:10-23) Regular prayer and communication with God are essential for believers to seek His guidance, receive His blessings, and experience the supernatural. In the above passage, Daniel was known as a man of prayer. In fact, when the enemies could not find any fault in him, they resorted to get him through is love for God and prayer. Even though the enemies thought they had seen the end of Daniel when he was thrown into the den of lion, but because he was a man who was operating from the supernatural, the mouths of lion were shut. Prayer is an altar where the natural meets the supernatural for spiritual endowment.

A LIFE SATURATED WITH GOD'S WORD: the mind of God and the will of God are in the word of God. It is only through the Word of God that we can get the shine and guiding light into this realm. All it takes is one flash of light from the Word to change our life forever. One flash of faith and we will realize, God said I can have that! As we speak that promise, it will become more real to us than anything else. That is when we have the victory on the inside. The Word can transform the natural to supernatural.

WALKING IN LOVE AND OBEDIENCE: Living in the supernatural also involves living a life of love, compassion, and obedience to God's commandments. Everyone who enjoy constant access to God was a man who said "yes Lord" to everything He commanded.

In essence, a supernatural life, is one that is characterized by a deep, personal relationship with God, the presence and work of the Holy Spirit, the development of godly character, and the experience of spiritual gifts and blessings that go beyond the natural world. It's a life that reflects the transformative power of faith in God. Besides, this life is beautified with the gifts prophecy, healing, speaking in tongues, interpretation of tongues etc. if there be any life that any christian should desire most, it is this kind of life. By it, we are launched into the avalanche of revelation power of God.
