THEME: CHRISTIAN ATTITUDE TO

TERMINAL ILLNESS

READING: PSALM 103:1-18; II KINGS 20:1-7,

ACTS 9:32-35; JOHN 5:2-14.

INTRODUCTION

Rev. Billy Graham, in his syndicated advice column published in the Bowling Green Daily News, encouraged that People living with a terminal illness don't have to live in despair if they look at life from Gods point of view and not from their own. Graham encourages a terminally ill reader, saying that, though her prognosis may be bleak, death is not the end.

The reader said doctors projected that that years Christmas would likely be her last due to an inoperable brain tumor, and admitted that she's struggling to maintain a positive attitude. The reader was quoted as saying I know I ought to force myself to act cheerful and pretend I am enjoying the holidays, but I just can't do it. How can anyone in my situation be cheerful at Christmas; the woman, named Mrs. L.L., asked. In response, Graham reminds his reader that she matters to God. You are not insignificant; you are not something for whom death is the end. he said.

A. WHEN TERMINAL ILLNESS STRIKES.....

Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 36 As it is written: "For Your sake we are killed all day long; We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter."37 Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. [Romans 8:35 - 37]

Terminal illness is a disease or condition which cannot be cured and is likely to lead to someone's death. It is sometimes called a life-limiting illness. Hence, the negative psychological effects of this terminal diagnosis which include distress, anger, denial, insomnia, depression, anxiety and atimes substance abuse, test the faith of Christians as well as the church at large. Emotions comes to play. The devil begins to preach to our minds and begin to gainsay all the godly promises and the omnipotence of God. However, Paul admonishes us in our aforementioned text that we are more than conqueror! How then can we handle all this trying periods as children of God.

B. CHRISTIAN ATTITUDE TO TERMINAL ILLNESS 1. YOUR SITUATION IS NOT COMMON TO YOU. [1 Corinthians 10:13]

Did you miss the sermon last Sunday? One of the most noteworthy point is understanding that our situation is not peculiar to us. Now when Elisha had fallen sick with the illness of which he was to die, Joash king of Israel went down to him and wept before him, crying, "My father, my father! The chariots of Israel and its horsemen!" [2 kings 13:14]. Elisha was one who had double portion of oil from his mentor Elijah. Infact, the bible recorded 20 miracles from him and one when a dead man was placed on his grave, making 21 significant miracles. Albeit, the sickness was not mentioned, it was the strange illness that led to his death. A prophet can be ill. Although sick, he still functioned as occasion demanded from him as a Prophet to the king. Should your

II. GIVE THANKS TO GOD ALWAYS.. [1 Thessalonians 5:18].

Apostles Paul was giving us some rules of church life. And the third rule is to give thanks; in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. Painstakingly ponder on the word everything. So when cancerous illness comes, we give thanks! As adults or elderly, when dementia comes, we give thanks! When neurological diseases like parkinson buffet us, we give thanks! Advanced heart diseases, lung disease to mention a few, we give thanks! Why? Because it is the will of God the Father. In that popular hymn; Take my life and let it be; A stanza says; Take my will and make it thine, it shall be no longer mine; because our thoughts are not his thoughts and our ways are not His ways, we align with His will for our life per season.

III. STRENGTHEN YOUR HOPE IN GOD IN PRAYER THROUGH THE HOLY SPIRIT. [Romans 5:3-5].

And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; and perseverance, character; and

character, hope. Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of

God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was

given to us. Beloved, first hand we have seen God do the miraculous

by turning situations around. Jesus went about doing good and healing

ALL those who were oppressed. Our hope in Him can not disappoint!

IV. ALWAYS REMEMBER JESUS CARES FOR YOU. [I PETER 5:7]

Jesus cares and understands. If you are in Christ, you have the indwelling Holy Spirit who is ever-present and active (John 14:16). Rely on Him daily to carry you through. Remind yourself of the truth of God's Word. For example, Psalm 46:1–3 might be comforting: God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear though the earth gives way, though the mountains be moved into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble at its swelling.

V. Corruptible Made Incorruptible: 1 Corinthians 15:50-53,

Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption. Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.

We as a whole face impediment. Christians who have physical, mental, or mental impairments are basically mindful of this. Some might be visually impaired however they can see a better approach to live. Some might be hard of hearing; however, they can hear God's Good News. Some might be maimed; however, they can stroll in God's adoration. Likewise, they have the consolation that those debilitations are just transitory. Paul lets us know that Christians will be given new bodies when Jesus returns and that these bodies will be without handicaps, never to end up being sick, ill, debilitated, or to die. This should give us hope and trust during our languishing

CONCLUSION.

Jesus knows all about our struggles, He will guide till the day is done, There is not a friend like the lowly Jesus, No, not one! No. not one! Not only is Jesus a great physician.
