5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 14TH JANUARY, 2024

THEME: OBEDIENCE LEADS TO BLESSING READING: PSALM 19; I SAMUEL 3:1-10; 1 CORINTHIANS 6:11B-20; JOHN 2:1-11.

(John 2:1-11, 1 Corinthians 6:11-20, 1Samuel 3:1-10)

All thanks and glory be unto our God and giver of wisdom. It wasn't a coincidence last week Sunday, but a godly and timely order to have started the journey of the year 2024 with such a wonderful topic as "HOW GOD LEADS" and to leverage on that premise today, we have before us "OBEDIENCE LEADS TO BLESSING". To save ourselves from unnecessary definition and exposition, our major focus for today is "OBEDIENCE TO GOD'S COMMAND LEADS TO BLESSING".

For any man to enjoy the blessing of God, there is need for partnership, man must partner with God on every matter if testimony is expected, partnership of God and such a man is the only way man can host the unusual manifestations of God! This is not to proof that God is limited as some may term it, this is to reaffirm that we serve and have a living father who wants His children to be responsible and not to be a bunch of liabilities. Man has to do his best even as God shoulders the unimaginable remaining aspect that is called "miracles".

There are three major things in man that must positively contribute to man's enjoying the blessings available through God, They are:

i. **The heart:** The heart of a man must be readily available, pure, free of anxieties and able to host the word of God that would come through hearing (Matthew 13:13-15).

<u>ii. The ears</u>: Ears on the other hand must not be dull of hearing whenever the Lord is speaking (Matthew 13:13-15).

<u>iii. The eyes:</u> The eyes must be intact, safe and clean to see through the lens of faith, the miracles that the word of God is commanding even before it manifests (Romans 10:17; Hebrews 11:1).

It is important to note that God did not stop speaking in the days of Eli when the word of God was rare and there was no open vision (1 Samuel 3:1), the heart of Eli, the set man in that period has grown gross (fat and dull), full of many obstacles that does not allow the word of God to find expression, his spiritual ears were dull of hearing and he could no longer see the visions from God; but God found the young Samuel, even in that same time frame. For us to enjoy the kind of blessing we are talking about today from God's end, we have sacrifices to pay, we must be ready to come down from our horses of age, status, fame, be available for God and ready to obey.

INSTANCES WHERE PEOPLE OBEYED AND RESULTED INTO BLESSING

1. Peter the fisherman at the lake of Gennesaret (Luke 5:1-11): Hardship can be a reason for someone to have a troubled heart to the extent of not willing to listen nor

troubled heart to the extent of not willing to listen nor entertaining any conversation either reasonable or not, labouring with all strength, skills, tactics and experience without any tangible result could as well be. Peter though a professional fisherman with his people had toiled all the night with no single catch, they already washed their nets and ship and we're ready to go in shame when Jesus showed up, Peter made his ship available for Jesus and was able to obey the word of Jesus despite fruitless labouring all through the night, they ended up experiencing nets breaking catch in a broad day.

2.1-12): What you have is not enough if you have not surround yourself with men that matters! No one is to be termed irrelevant or useless, such shoulders might be the ones to bear you up in the days you ought to be disappointed. Who could have imagined that ordinary servants can hear the word from Jesus and obey without any iota of doubt? When the celebration ought to have ended in shame because the wine got exhausted, Jesus' mother showed up and said to the servants "whatsoever he ask you to do, do it" Jesus only commanded them to "fill the waterpots with water, draw out some and take it to the Chairman of the feast". The servants only obeyed the word of Jesus and the rest was avalanche of blessing.

3. Father Abraham, the friend of God (Genesis 12:1-4): Here is a special and unique obedience, the servants of Abraham as well had what to work with, but Abraham had none and yet he was ready to obey God, he obeyed when it did not make sense, he did not delayed his obedience (he set out immediately the word of God came to him), he was ready to sacrifice his only son even though he waited for so long before he could gave birth to him (Genesis 22:1-19). The rest was blessings unlimited.

The major factor we can point to in the life of these examples is "**FAITH**", it takes faith to obey God, it takes faith to enjoy His blessings and without faith you can not please Him. Get faith in all your gettings (Hebrews 11:1).

God again is calling your attention today, if only you can obey Him. All things are lawful but not all things are expedient and helpful, your body is the temple of God, the moment you join it with immortality, you automatically cut yourself off, of the blessings associated in Christ Jesus, if only you can obey, the blessing that would follow is yet to be seen, heard or known by any man (1Corinthians 2:9).
