

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 7TH JANUARY, 2024 THEME: HOW GOD LEADS

READING: ISA 42:1-9; ACTS 10:34-38a; MATT 3:13-17

1. Introduction:

Today is the first Sunday of the brand New Year 2024. Happy New Year to all of us. We thank God who brought us into the New Year by his grace and mercy. 2023 was a year of many colours and happenings. It was a very difficult year in terms of the economy and governance but God saw us through by his love. Being alive is beyond anyone's permutation or calculation or carefulness or ability. It is basically the grace of God. We must approach the new year with renewed hope, believing God is able to do new things in our lives. We can prophetically lay claim to Deuteronomy 6:23 "Then He brought us out from there that He might bring us in, to give us the land of which He swore to our fathers" God brought us out of 2023 on purpose and brought us into 2024for a greater purpose. We must be sensitive to the doings of God and flow on same wavelength with the Holy Spirit. Our God who brought us to the first Sunday of 2024 is constant and able to take us to the last Sunday of 2024. For our medication this morning, we are considering the topic 'How God Leads'. God's ways are far above our ways but he has made his dwelling with us in Emmanuel. He is interested in revealing himself to us always.

2. God leads his people:

Jeremiah 10:23 says, O Lord, I know that the way of man is not in himself: it is not in man that walketh to direct his steps. In Psalm 25, the psalmist kept praying; "Show me your ways...Teach me...Guide me..." (Psalm 25:4,5&9). None of us really knows the happenings of this year. We can only rest on the one who knows the end right from the beginning. We have examples of God's leading in the Bible.

- Abraham left his native country on Gods instruction not knowing where he was going. He was wholly dependent on Gods leading (Genesis 12:1);
- (ii) Eliezer, Abraham's servant: He prayed to God to guide him as he went in search of a wife for Isaac (Genesis 24 : 42-67);
- (iii) Moses and the children of Israel: They were led by the pillar of cloud by day and of fire by night (Exodus 13:21-22);
- (iv) David: He inquired of God, saying, "Shall I go up against the Philistines? And will You give them into my hand?" Then the Lord said to him, "Go up, for I will give them into your hand." So they came up to Baal-perazim, and David defeated them there". (1 Chronicles 14:10-11). The Philistines made yet another raid in the valley. David inquired again of God, and God said to him, "You shall not go up after them; circle around behind them and come at them in front of the balsam trees". (1 Chronicles 14:13-14)
- (v) Philip: He was led by the Spirit of God to leave Samaria in search of the waiting eunuch of Ethiopia who needed salvation (Acts 8:5 and 26).
- (vi) Prophets and Teachers who were praying in Acts 13:1-2: God told them, "Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them"
- (vii) Wise men in Matthew 2:13-15: A mysterious star led them all the way from the East to Jerusalem and to Bethlehem. It was a long journey but they were safely guided. They didn't miss their way.
- (viii) Joseph, Mary and Baby Jesus: God sent his Angel to go and tell Joseph to flee with the baby and mother to Egypt (Matthew 2:13-15) because Herod was seeking to destroy him. Again, after the death of Herod, God spoke to Joseph in a dream to return, saying *"for they are dead which sought the young child's life"* Matthew 2:19-21.

3. How does God lead us:

a. God leads by his Spirit, the Holy Spirit:

Romans 8:14 "For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God". This is the very primary way God leads us. When Jesus bodily left the earth, he promised that his Spirit will come and stay with us. "Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come" (John 16:13).

<u>What to do</u>: This year, let us release ourselves to the leading of the Spirit of God. We must stop struggling with him.

b. God leads by His Word:

Psalm 119:105 "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path". God leads us by his word in the immediate (lamp to my feet) and in the future (light to my path). We cannot navigate the terrain of 2024 successfully without the word of God. The key to living well, living right and living successfully is in the word of God. "*Man shall not leave by bread alone but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God*"(Matt 4:4)

<u>What to do</u>: Immerse yourself in the word of God this year. Read, Study, Meditate and listen to Sermons. You can't separate the Word of God and the Spirit of God. They are inseparably the same (1Jn 5:7). As you immerse yourself in the word of God, the Holy Spirit interprets and illuminates your heart furnishing you for every good work (2Tim 3:17)

c. God leads by His Angels:

Exodus 20:23 "Behold, I send an Angel before thee, to keep thee in the way, and to bring thee into the place which I have prepared". Angels are still actively involved with us. They are God's foot soldiers (Heb 1:14). They carry out his directives. Angels ministered to Daniel Dan 6:22, Jesus Mtt 4:11; Lk 22:43; Philip Acts 8:26; Peter Acts 12:7-9; Paul Acts 27:23-24. We might not see them and we might see them but they are at work. Infact, most of the miracles we experience are carried out by them as God instructs them (Psalm 103:20).

<u>What to do</u>: Be sensitive in the Spirit. *The Angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear Him and rescues them* (Psalm 34:7)

d. God leads by His Servants:

Ephesians 4:11-12 "And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ". There were set leaders at different times in the history of God's people. Moses led. Joshua led. David led. Solomon led. Peter led, Paul led. Timothy led. Their main duty is to lead the people as God directs. They declare the counsel of God (Acts 20:27). They are overseers feeding the flock of Jesus (Acts 20:28). They serve in perfecting the saints. They do the work of the ministry. They serve to edify the body of Christ.

<u>What to do</u>: Pay attention to the Church Leaders. They have spiritual mandate to lead in the will of God.

e. God leads by Dreams, Visions and Prophecies:

Proverbs 29:18 "Where there is no vision, the people perish". Acts 2:17-18 Acts 2:17-18 "And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, that I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your young men shall see visions, your old men shall dream dreams. And on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days; and they shall prophesy". We are in the hour when God is pouring out His Holy Spirit. This outpouring of this Spirit is characterized by dreams, visions and prophecies.
