

THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 4TH FEBRUARY, 2024 THEME: THE CHURCH'S HEALING MINISTRY **READING:** PSALM 77:1-15; II KINGS 5:1-14; JAMES 5:13-16a; MARK 2:1-12

All glory, honour and majesty to our God who has given us the privilege to witness the first Sunday in the month, February. May His name be praised forever in Jesus name. Amen.

Healing is part of God's plan for us this year 2024. Therefore, today we shall be looking at the healing ministry of the church as laid down by the Lord Jesus Christ.

When the Lord Jesus was on the earth He was very interested in he needs of people. He saw people who were in need of forgiveness of sin and Jesus forgave them. He saw people who had hurting hearts soJesus calmed their fears and came into their lives in a special way. Hesaw people who were physically ill and the Bible says that Jesus wasmoved with compassion on them. So, Jesus saw lepers and He cleansedthem; the lame and He gave them the ability towalk again; the blind and gave themability to see again. All kinds of physical ailments Jesus Christconfronted and in His power He spoke the Word and those people got well.

The Lord Jesus Christ has gone back to heaven and had given to His church the Holy Spirit. In the giving of the HolySpirit there is the power in the church today to do the ministry of Jesus Christ on this earth. When Jesus walked on the earth the firsttime He carried out His ministry in a physical body. Today, He doesn't work in His physical body on the earth, but He works inand through His spiritual body (the body of Christ) the church.

Healing Ministries is dedicated to the practice and teaching of healing prayer. It is one of the greatest opportunities the church has today for sharing the gospel. The healing ministry is available to all in the following ways:

- **PUBLICLY** as part of services.
- AT HEALING SERVICES including the Holy Communion: in hospitals, residential homes for the elderly and disabled people, prisons etc.
- **PRIVATELY** within the home, hospitals and discretely in church side chapels etc.

In co-operation with the medical and caring professions. The healing ministry of the Church is a Gospel imperative. Jesus commissioned his disciples to heal the sick on two occasions: (Matthew 10.5-15, Mark 6.7-13; Luke 9.1-5; 10.9). He explicitly linked healing the sick with going out into the community to proclaim the coming of the Kingdom (Mark 6:13; Matthew 4.23, 9.35-10.8).

Let us take a brief look at the principles of Healing Ministry of Jesus Christ and the importance he placed on it.

- The gospels tells us that Jesus healed multitudes. The implication of this is that healing was a common feature of his earthly ministry. Healing was not a secondary or subsidiary activity for him.
- 2. No one Jesus touched was left unhealed. No one who touched Jesus desiring healing was unhealed (Mt. 14:34-36). According to Mt. 8:16, he "healed all who were ill." What does this tell us about God's "heart" or "will" for healing? Read Ps. 103:3-5.
- Jesus never inflicted anyone with a disease or ever suggested that sickness was a blessing from God for obedient people. Healing and health are always portrayed in Scripture as the blessing of God, not disease and decay. (Lk. 4:39, Acts 10:38).
- 4. Jesus portrayed healing not simply as a sign that the kingdom was coming but as an essential element in the kingdom. (Lk. 9:2; 10:8-9). Healing is the presence of the kingdom!
- 5. Jesus self-consciously healed people by the power of the Holy Spirit (Luke 4:14-21; Mt. 12:22-28). The earthly ministry of Jesus, primarily his miracles and healings, were the result not so much of his divine nature but rather the power of the Holy Spirit working through him. And let us never forget that the Holy Spirit in Jesus is the Holy Spirit in us!
- 6. Jesus' healings were subject to two factors: (1) the presence or absence of faith (Mk. 6:5-6; Mt. 13:53-58), and (2) the purpose of his heavenly Father (John 5:19). As for faith, if you struggle to believe, let others exercise faith on your behalf (see Mark 2).
- Virtually all Jesus' healings were motivated by compassion. See Mt. 14:14; 20:34; Mark 1:41; 9:22; Lk. 7:13-15. In other words, he didn't do it to draw attention to himself, but because he cared deeply for the grief of the family.

Two concluding observations:

First, we must leave room for mystery in God's ways. Some things will always remain unexplained. Why God does or does not choose to heal is ultimately subject to his wisdom and sovereign purposes. Why God chooses to heal in part or in whole, now or later, this person but not that one, is often beyond our capacity to understand. Resist the tendency to replace divine mystery with human formulas

Second, we must be willing to bear the stigma of perceived failure. If you are unwilling to do so, you can stay safe and sophisticated, and you will eventually stop praying for the sick altogether. If there are 100 people who are sick and need prayer, it is the Lord who decides who to heal and not you
