5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 12TH MAY, 2024

THEME: LEARNING HOW TO FOLLOW FROM

ELISHA

READING: PSALM 97; II KINGS 2:1-15;

EPHESIANS 4:1-13; JOHN 16:12-24.

THE MAN CALLED ELISHA

Elisha is a significant figure in the Bible, particularly in the Old Testament. Here are some more details about him:

- 1. *Background*: Elisha was a prophet who lived during the 9th century BCE in the Northern Kingdom of Israel. He was chosen by God to succeed Elijah as a prophet.
- 2. *Call to Prophet Hood*: Elisha's call to prophethood is recorded in 1 Kings 19:19-21. He was plowing a field with twelve yoke of oxen when Elijah passed by and threw his mantle over him, symbolizing his call to be Elijah's successor.
- 3. *Miracles and Ministry*: Elisha's ministry was marked by numerous miracles, similar to those performed by Elijah. Some of his notable miracles include:
 - Parting of the Jordan River (2 Kings 2:14)
 - Healing of the waters of Jericho (2 Kings 2:19-22)
 - Multiplication of the widow's oil (2 Kings 4:1-7)

- 6. *Death*: Elisha died of natural causes and was buried in Samaria. Even after his death, his influence continued, as a man was resurrected when his body came into contact with Elisha's bones (2 Kings 13:20-21).

Elisha's life serves as an example of faithfulness, dedication, and service to God, inspiring believers to trust in God's power and follow His will wholeheartedly.

The relationship between Elisha and Elijah

The relationship between Elisha and Elijah was profound and significant in the biblical narrative. Elijah was a renowned prophet in Israel during a time of widespread idolatry and apostasy. When Elijah encountered Elisha plowing in a field with twelve yoke of oxen, he threw his mantle over him, symbolizing Elisha's call to succeed him as a prophet (1 Kings 19:19-21).

Elisha's response to Elijah's call demonstrated his commitment and devotion. He immediately left his oxen and ran after Elijah, asking to kiss his parents goodbye first. Elijah's response, "Go back! As Elijah's ministry came to a close, he asked Elisha what he could do for him before he was taken up to heaven in a whirlwind. Elisha requested a double portion of Elijah's spirit, indicating his desire to continue Elijah's prophetic ministry with even greater power and authority (2 Kings 2:9).

After Elijah was taken up to heaven in a whirlwind, Elisha inherited his mantle and continued his prophetic ministry. He performed numerous miracles and carried on the work of confronting idolatry and calling the people of Israel back to the worship of the true God.

The relationship between Elijah and Elisha exemplifies the importance of mentorship, discipleship, and passing on the mantle of leadership to the next generation. Elisha's devotion to Elijah and his desire to continue his legacy serve as an enduring example for believers today

SACRIFICES MADE BY ELISHA

Elisha made a significant sacrifice in order to follow Elijah and answer the call to become his successor as a prophet. When Elijah passed by him and threw his mantle over him, symbolizing his call, Elisha was plowing a field with twelve yoke of oxen. In response to Elijah's call, Elisha slaughtered the oxen, used the equipment as fuel, and cooked the meat to share with the people. This act demonstrated Elisha's decisive commitment to leave behind his previous occupation and way of life in order to follow Elijah and embrace his new calling as a prophet of God. It was a symbolic act of dedication and surrender to God's will.

What sacrifices should we make to follow Christ?

Following Christ often involves making sacrifices, as it requires wholehearted commitment and devotion to Him. Here are some sacrifices that individuals may need to make in order to follow Christ:

- 1. *Sacrifice of Selfish Desires*: Following Christ means prioritizing His will above our own desires. It may require sacrificing worldly ambitions, material possessions, or sinful habits that are contrary to His teachings.

- 7. *Sacrifice of Control*: Following Christ means surrendering control of our lives to Him and trusting in His plan and timing. It requires relinquishing our desire for control and submitting to His authority in every area of our lives.

Ultimately, the sacrifices we make to follow Christ are outweighed by the abundant blessings, joy, and fulfillment that come from knowing and serving Him. As Jesus Himself said, "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me" (Luke 9:23).

WISDOM / TRUTH FOR THE CHURCH AND THE CONTRACTORS

1. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, let Your Spirit of wisdom hover over the site and take charge of every thought and activity.

Then wrought Bezaleel and Aholiab, and every wise hearted man, in whom the Lord put wisdom and understanding to know how to work all manner of work for the service of the sanctuary, according to all that the Lord had commanded (Exod 36:1)
