



5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 19TH MAY, 2024

THEME: IGNITED AND EMPOWERED BY THE

SPIRIT

READING: PSALM 130; JOEL 2:28-32; ACTS 2:1-21;

JOHN 20:19-31.

In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, we welcome you into another historic Sunday when the celebration of the Pentecost is celebrated. The Pentecost day is the Liturgical season set aside in the church to commemorate the descent of the Holy Spiritupon the Apostles and other followers of Jesus Christ. The Liturgical color for Pentecost is Red symbolizing joy and the fire and of the Holy Spirit.

"Pentecost" is a word that comes from the transliterated Greek word "Pentekoste" which means "fiftieth" and this gives us the timing of the celebration of Pentecost which is done on the fiftieth day after Passover according to Deuteronomy 16:10 and Exodus 34:22. The major event is well documented in the second chapter of the Acts of the Apostles, which reveals the backdrop of the celebration of the Pentecost in Jerusalem as at the time and also evokes the symbolism of Jesus' baptism in the Jordan River where He was empowered for the work of the ministry just as the Apostles. The author began by noting that the disciples of Jesus Christ were "together in one accord" and then he moved on with the attendant description of the coming of the Holy Spirit in the form of "a mighty rushing wind" and "cloven tongues of fire", which separated itself on the disciples who were gathered in the upper room.Consequently, they were all filled with the Holy Spirit signifying the fulfillment of the promise of God in the Old Testament (Joel 2:28 -32) and that of Jesus Christin the New Testament (John 14:16-17). The disciples after the baptism of the Holy Spirit began to declare the word of God in different languages as the Spirit gave them utterance. This was the beginning of their major empowerment by the Holy Spirit.

The word empowerment denotes being equipped or enabled i.e. giving a person authority or power in order to carry out a particular assignment or task. Someone who is ignited and empowered by the Holy Spirit in this context is someone who has been given authority or power to carry out the work of the ministry as given to him or her, such a person is "being set on fire" by the Holy Spirit. The empowerment of the Holy Spirit makes a believer extraordinary; the Holy Spirittransforms theperson with His supernatural abilities in such a way that the individual can do what he or she naturally is not capable of doing before.

Interestingly, there is no better time for one to desire the empowerment of the Holy Spirit than in this age where things have gone upside down; this is a time of duress and instability, a time when righteousness is always being relegated and iniquity propagated; a time where darkness or the evil ones dares the carriers of light because they have failed to allow God dwell in them. We are in the perilous time (2 Timothy 3) and if we will stand in this time and fight the good fight of faith, the empowerment of the Holy Spirit is a must. Life is full of battles from the day of birth to the day of death, the only advantage we have as believers in Christ is that we have access to the Holy Spirit and His Power. But how can we be ignited and empowered by the Holy Spirit?

WAYS A PERSON CAN BE IGNITED AND EMPOWERED BY THE HOLY SPIRIT

There are several ways one can prepare and present himself or herself for the Holy Spirit to ignite and empower him or her. The ways are discussed below;

- a. Consistent engagement in the place of prayer:when you pray to God, you are discussing with the Almighty and when you stay long enough with Him, you draw from Him just as the disciples did when they tarried in the upper room. Prayer is one of the vital ways you connect and draw from the Holy Spirit, pray in the Spirit and pray in your understanding as long as you can (Acts 4:31, Acts 6:4,Jude 1:20).
- b. Immerse yourself daily in the Scriptures: we must allow the Word of God dwell richly in us (Colossians 3:16). The Holy Spirit dwells and moves in the Word of God (John 6:63), when you are immersed in God's word daily, you will be ignited and empowered by the Holy Spirit.
- c. Cultivate a habit of fasting: another way to allow the Holy Spirit ignites us for His assignment is when we deny ourselves of food and other pleasure. Fasting has a way of humbling an individual, subduing the flesh and aligning his or her focus on God. It prepares your heart for an encounter with the Holy Spirit (Matthew 17:21, 2 Corinthians 11:27).

- 1. You will enjoy divine direction at all time and you will never be stranded (Isaiah 30:21)
- 2. You will be able to do extraordinary things (Acts 19:12)
- 3. You will be able to serve God better as He desires
- **4.** His empowerment helps us to pray aright and not amiss (Romans 8:26)
- 5. His empowerment enables us to preach the gospel and teach the Word of Christ with power and conviction (Acts 1:8,Luke 5:17)
- 6. You will be bold or courageous to confront unrighteousness and stand for the Lord (Daniel 3:16-18)
- 7. His empowerment helps us to subdue the workings of the flesh and its desires (Galatians 5:16) etc.

DANGERS OF NOT BEING IGNITED AND EMPOWERED BY THE HOLY SPIRIT

Just as there are benefits of being ignited and empowered by the Holy Spirit, there are also dangers if one is not empowered by the Holy Spirit. They are as follows;

- 1. Such a person is prone to making wrong choices in life
- There will be struggling in one's prayer life and Bible Study
- 3. Falling into temptation will become incessant as the flesh will always subdue the spirit
- 4. There will be fear in confronting ungodliness
- 5. The work of evangelism will also be hindered as there will be little or no passion for soul winning.
- Serving God will become a burden instead of a blessing etc.

CONCLUSION

The empowerment of the Holy Spirit is a necessity for all
