

We are called to feed on the Word of God. We are called to crave it, to desire it, and to feed on it daily. This is how we grow in our faith, and how we become more like Christ. But it's not just about reading the Word; it's about applying it to our lives. It's about living it out in our daily walk with God.(James 1:22-25)

Peter also reminds us that we are a chosen people, set apart for God's purpose. We are a royal priesthood, called to minister to God and

How can we do this? How can we live a life that is pleasing to God?

In John 15:1-5. Jesus teaches His disciples about the importance of abiding in Him. He says, "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing."

To abide in Jesus means to stay connected to Him, to remain in His love, and to allow His life to flow through us. When we do, we will bear much fruit. We will live a life that is pleasing to God, and we will be empowered to do great things for His kingdom.

What does it mean to be a Spirit-filled believer?

It means to be controlled by the Spirit, to be led by the be filled Spirit, and to with the Spirit. When we are Spirit-filled believers, we will live a life that is characterized by love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. (Galatians 5:22-23). We will be empowered to overcome sin and temptation, and we will be able to live a life that is pleasing to God.

And I have filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, and in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship, (Exod. 31:3)

3. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, saturate the entire atmosphere as we build with wisdom that descend from above.

This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish (James 3:15).

4. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, let Your fear permeate the heart of everyone that will touch this project.

There is none greater in this house than I; neither hath he kept back anything from me but thee, because thou art his wife: how then can I do this great wickedness, and sin against God? (Exod. 39:9)

Father in the name of Jesus Christ, we pray that everyone will hand this project with truth and integrity of heart
