**5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
SUNDAY, 9TH JUNE, 2024**

THEME: DYING TO SIN AND LIVING IN CHRIST

READING: PSALM 71:16-24; DEUTERONOMY 6:17-25; ROMANS 6:3-11; JOHN 15:5-11.

It is with joy and gladness that I welcome you again on this second Sunday after Trinity. It is my prayers that the fullness of the Godhead will be domicile with you and made manifest over all that concerns you in Jesus name (Amen).

The theme we are addressing today is the one that particularly addresses the life of a believer and the expectations of God on him or her after salvation. Once a believer comes to Jesus Christ through confessing Him as Lord with his or her mouth and believing in his or her heart that God has indeed raised Jesus from the dead (Romans 10:9-10), the journey does not stop there rather the journey has just started. This theme will address the journey of a believer after salvation.

However, it is expedient to note that Sin is a “relationship-breaker” because it denotes deviating from the mark or stipulated instructions of God; it is what we do that God dislikes. By nature, Sin is both a Stinker and a Sinker; it punctures the life of the believer and exposes him or her to several demonic attacks as well as grounding such a believer from living a victorious lifestyle in Jesus Christ (Romans 6:23). By nature, we were all sinners through the first man, Adam (Romans 5:14, 1 Corinthians 15:22) and our desires are often times conflicting with the agenda of God, because the Flesh always strives with the Spirit (Galatians 5:17, Romans 6:19).

Nevertheless, when Jesus Christ came to die for us on the Cross of Calvary, He gave us redemption from the nature of sin which sponsors our desires for the things of the world and also that which provokes God to wrath. In Deuteronomy 6:17-25, the Israelites were commanded by Moses on what is expected of them after the Lord has given them the land of promise. He told them how they need to ensure that they obey the commandments of God, keep His testimonies as well as His statutes. Moses further enjoined them to see that it becomes a generational engagement because their children must be aware of what the Lord did for them in delivering the Israelites from the bondage of the Egyptians. This is what is also expected from a believer who has just given his or her life to Jesus Christ, the person is expected to do two major things; the first is that such a person must die daily to sin and the second, he or she must live daily in Christ.

WHAT DOES “DYING TO SIN” AND “LIVING IN CHRIST” DENOTE?

Dying to sin denotes the experience of having ceased to live under the power of sin. For as many who have come to faith in Jesus Christ, it is mandated or expected of them all to disallow sin from controlling their lives, instead they are to offer themselves daily to God so that they may serve His purposes. This is the focal point of Paul’s admonition in Romans 6:1-6, reminding believers that they have been crucified with Christ when He died on the cross and have been raised with Him as well (Galatians 2:20). Now, we must note that dying to sin does not mean we are sinless, because as long as we are on this side of eternity, there will always be struggle with temptations and sin (Romans 7:19-20, 1 Timothy 1:16), rather it means we have come to the point where we always say NO to any promptings of sin and the temptations of the devil. Also, Dying to sin is a daily process; that is why it is rendered in the continuous tense as “dying” and not “die”, as Paul himself reiterated by noting in 1 Corinthians 15:31 that He “dies daily”.

Furthermore, “Living in Christ” is the complementary aspect of our responsibility as believer when we are dying to sin. It is like the other side of a coin; when we die to sin, we must live in Christ, to fill up the vacuum. Living in Christ means abiding in Christ daily; it means allowing Him to lead us, guide us, correct us, reprove us and rule over us as we surrender our will unto Him. When we live in Christ, our will is lost in His, His agenda becomes our agenda and we will love what He loves and hate what He hates. Whoever claims to die to sin and fails to live in Christ is incomplete; the two sides must be joined to live a victorious life in Christ. The following are some of the characteristics of whoever is dying to sin and living in Christ daily:

Such a believer will daily forsake the biddings of the world and refuses to soil himself or herself in sin (1 John 2:15)

Such a believer will abstain from every appearances of evil and all manner of lusts (1 Thessalonians 5:22, Romans 12:1)

CONCLUSION

If we fail to die to sin and to live in Christ, we will not be able to please God as He desires and also we will hinder God from doing what He wants to do with our lives. This theme is a clarion call for us to examine our walk with the Lord as well as our faith in Him. Whoever claims to have confessed Christ and believed in Him must be ready to die daily to sin and also to live daily in Christ. There is no bending of standards for anyone because God is a respecter of no one (2 Timothy 2:19, Acts 10:34). If the attractions of this world and its system are hindering you from focusing on and following Jesus Christ, it is time to let them go, flee from sin and yield your all i.e. your body, your resources, your emotions, intellect and time to Jesus Christ because He also left His all for our redemption and justification (Romans 4:25; Romans 5:18; Romans 12:1-2).
