

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 7TH JULY, 2024 THEME: GODLY LOVE AND WORLDLY LUST

READING:

CONTRASTED PSALM 119:33-48; HOSEA 11:1-9; 1 JOHN 2:8-17; MARK 12:28-34.

Happy Sunday and new week in the peerless name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. You are welcome to Church and may the grace of God abound towards us as we fellowship together in Jesus name.

Godly love is **agape**, it goes beyond mere human emotions or feelings, and it is totally different from all other kinds of love which are:

Philia: this Greek word describes deep and meaningful friendship. It is a love which binds two people (friends) together and sustain them through their best moments and worst. The best example of this are David and Jonathan (1Samuel 18:1).

Storge: this speaks of the natural love that exists between family members, or people who are related in familiar ways. It grows naturally without having anything behind it as a gain, the love parents feel toward their children and vice versa.

Eros: the romantic love between a man and a woman. It is a gift from God as it is present from the beginning of creation. God saw that it was not good for Adam to be alone and so He created Eve to complement him (Genesis 2:18-24).

Agape is a Greek word used in the New Testament to describe the highest form of love. The unconditional love of God for humanity and the love that Christians are called to exhibit toward other humans. It is the expression of one's will and the harmony of individual purpose with the universal love. Agape emphasizes selflessness, love for others (not necessarily related nor connected with special feelings, but with the good of someone else), sacrificial giving and transcends personal desires, attractions and attachments.

The Bible provides a profound definition of this unconditional love in 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 that "Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres." (New International Version).

The above definition captures the essence of the type of love God calls us (the believers in Christ) to show others as:

• <u>Distributors of God's Love:</u>God wants us to take the advantage we have received of Him to give support and affection to someone who is grieving, hungry, afflicted and take the message of salvation to someone who still doesn't know of God's love in Christ that He can heal our hurts and give peace.

• <u>Channel through which His love flows to others</u>: when Jesus comes into our lives, He changes our hearts so that our hearts can accommodate His love for others, not for only those who love us back, but for those who doesn't and He wants this to be reflected in our actions when we do good to all no matter how they may have treated us (1 John 3:17). Once we recognize how



Jesus Christ exemplified love through His life, teachings, and ultimately, His sacrificial death on the cross for the redemption of humanity. In John 15:13, Jesus says: "Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends." (NIV). Jesus' love depicts qualities such as patience, kindness, humility, selflessness, forgiveness, and perseverance, and the unconditional nature of this love stands out, as it is not contingent on the actions or worthiness of the recipient.

The word Lust is to have a strong craving for something or anything that stands against the will of God. Hence, worldly love in the real context is lust, and it is the love that can love when loved, this love is very much interested in what you will gain from showing love to someone and is eagerly on the look out for when his action is to be reciprocated. It is therefore sacrosanct to note that:

1. <u>God's love is Compassionate in nature:</u> Compassion is a sympathetic consciousness of others' distress together with a desire to alleviate it, this is largely revealed at anytime He is to perform a miracle such like feeding the five thousand (Matthew 14:13-21), raising the dead son of a widow at Nain (Luke 7:11-17), raising Lazarus back to life wherein the scriptures recorded that, Jesus wept (John 11:35), it is often recorded that He (Jesus had compassion on them).

2. Those who dispense God's love are not attention

<u>seekers:</u> You will definitely understand the intention of every actions of men by the value attached to whatsoever they do for humanity or when rendering services as a form of worship unto the Lord. Jesus on several occasions after He might have performed any miracle would then say "tell no one about this", as we see in the cleansing of a leper (Luke 5:14), raising of Jairus daughter (Mark 5:43), and the healing of the deaf man in Mark 7:36, compared to the intentions behind every actions of the Pharisees as pictured in Luke 18:9-14.

Let us explore the differences thereof

1. Sources of Love:

Godly love finds its origin in the very nature of God Himself. As 1 John 4:8 tells us, "God is love." It is an outpouring of the divine love that flows from our Heavenly Father through His Son, Jesus Christ. Godly love always comes from God, as He is the very definition of love. Whereas, Worldly love, on the other hand, stems from human emotions and desires, often driven by selfgratification and expectations. It is based on self and what we can get from others. However, we need to recognize that we can't show divine love to others on our own without God in our lives. Our fallen nature tends to be selfish and self-centered, viewing love based on feelings and personal gains. But true Christian love, as commanded by Jesus in John 13:34, transcends mere emotions and self-interest.

2. Unconditional Love against Conditional Love:

Worldly love is often conditional, relying on external factors such as attractiveness, material gain, or social status. It fades when circumstances change or expectations are unmet, this

3. Selflessness and Self-Centeredness:

Godly love is characterized by selflessness. It seeks the wellbeing of others above our own desires. But worldly love tends to be self-centered, focusing on what we can gain or how others can make us feel.

4. Temporary versus Eternal:

Worldly love is often temporary, influenced by the changing circumstances and feelings. So, it is possible to stop showing love because the individual on the receiving end is not reciprocating up to your expectations or not at all. Godly love is eternal, reflecting the unchanging nature of God Himself. As Job 25:3 says, "Is there any number to his armies? Upon whom does his light not arise? This question was adequately answered in Matthew 5:45b(AMP) that "God makes His sun rise on the wicked and on the good, and makes the rain fall upon the upright and the wrongdoers [alike].

5. Love for All and Selective Love:

Godly love extends to all, regardless of their background, appearance, or behavior, we can further learn from the parable of the good Samaritan as recorded in Luke 10:30-35. Unlike Worldly love, it can be selective, favoring those who meet certain criteria or can benefit us in some ways, this again Jesus reiterated in Luke 6:32-34 that your choice of having set of people you do good to because you know they are capable of doing the same to you when the game turn to their side is a signal that you don't understand what Godly love is.

6. Rejoice in Righteousness versus Supporting Sin:

Godly love rejoices in truth and righteousness. It aligns with God's standards and values, while Worldly love may freely support sin or indulge in evil desires of the flesh and still be boasting around. Godly love draws strength from the father of righteousness as against the worldly love that rejoices when sin thrives.

7. Christ-Based and Infatuation-Based:

Godly love is Christ-based, reflecting the sacrificial love of Jesus, but Worldly love can be infatuation-based, driven by fleeting emotions and physical attractions.

Finally brethren, Godly love is rooted in God's character, it is unconditional, selfless, eternal, and aligned with righteousness. Worldly love, on the other hand, often revolves around selfinterest, conditions, and temporary feelings. As we seek to love others, let's strive for the kind of love that reflects God's heart and transforms lives. Shalom.
