

Each applicant shall submit a typed application letter, not more than two pages. addressed to "The Chairman, Educational Support Initiative, Archbishop Vining Memorial Church Cathedral, Ikeja, Lagos" The letter must include the name of the candidate, course of study, year of study, state of origin, and why the candidate believes that he/she should be given the scholarship award. The application letter must be accompanied by:

- Evidence of AVMCC membership of applicant or parent
- Or a letter from the Dean of AVMCC certifying that candidate is a member indicating the Society or ministry he/she or the parent belongs Evidence of membership of the Cathedral Youth Vanguard
- SSCE/NECO results and JAMB admission letter for fresh applicants
- A photocopy of the candidate's current school Identity card.
- A letter from the Registrar of the candidate's institution certifying that the candidate is a student of such institution.
- A letter from the candidate's current Head of Department, including correct information of the candidate's biodata, academic profile and CGPA for the last academic semester.
- Two (2) current passport photographs.

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 8<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER, 2024 THEME: THE CHRISTIAN'S DUTY TO THE POOR READING: PSALM 56; DEUTERONOMY 15:7-11; ROMANS 12:9-21; LUKE 16:19-31.

You are welcome to Church in the precious name of our Lord and SaviourJesus Christ.

"If you can't feed a hundred people, then feed just one" Mother Teresa. We as God's children are meant to be solutions to problems of people around us.Going by the saying of Mother Theresa, even if we cannot solve a large-scale problem entirely, our small contributions in people's life still matter.This maxim encourages us not to be discouraged by the degree of an issue, such as poverty or hunger, but to focus on what we can do within our means to salvage people in trouble, especially, the poor around us.

This topic is apt and timely because the economic situation in our nation today has thrown a lot of people into the pit of impoverishment. In fact, Even the rich arebleeding. This is a period when we must not look on the other side from the need of our neighbour. Helping even one person is significant because it makes a difference in that person's life and contributes to the broader effort of addressing the issue. The idea is that small acts of kindness and generosity can accumulate and lead to larger impacts over time.

In Deuteronomy 15:7 - 11, God told the Israelites to help the poor among them when they arrived in the Promised Land. This was an important part of possessing the land. Many people conclude that people are poor through some fault of their own. This kind of reasoning makes it easy to close their hearts and hands to the needy. But we are not to invent reasons for ignoring the poor. We are to respond to their needs no matter who or what was responsible for their condition.

The Lord admonished them against so malicious and selfish a spirit and exhorts them to give in a liberal spirit of charity and kindness, which would secure the divine blessing (Romans 12:8; 2 Corinthians 9:7). One might be inclined to withhold aid to a needy person on the fifth or sixth year because in the seventh year the debt would be cancelled. But a poor, hungry person could not wait a year or two! God expects generosity from his people.

In Luke 16:19-21, the Lord gave a parable of a very rich man who had the finest things imaginable, living every day enjoying his life of opulent luxury. But, outside the gate of his mansion was a poor beggar named Lazarus. He lay there every day, covered with boils, and all the neighborhood dogs would come and lick his open sores. The only food he had to eat was the garbage that the rich man threw away. This is a case of heartlessand wicked disposition to the helpless. The rich man completely closed the door of his heart to the poor man. The story of the Rich Man and Lazarus, found in Luke 16:19-31, offers several life lessons:

- 1. Compassion for the Needy: The rich man lived in luxury but ignored Lazarus, a poor man suffering at his gate. This teaches the importance of showing compassion and caring for those in need, rather than being unconcernedabout their suffering.
- 2. We are blessed to bless others: One of the main reasons why God bless His people is for them to be blessings to others around. Christians are not containers that receive and contain. We are channels that receive and release. It is an act of ingratitude to think that whatever we have is meant to meet our personal desire. Beloved, anytime we people who need what we have in abundance, God is simply ministering to us that someone needs our help.
- 3. **The** Consequences of Greed and Selfishness: The rich man's focus on his wealth and comfort led to his spiritual downfall. The story emphasizes that wealth and material possessions should not be our primary focus in life, as they can lead to selfishness and a lack of concern for others. Besides, if they are channeled in such a way that glorify God, they will lead to eternal damnation.
