



- God, our compassionate Father, Look upon us with mercy Let Your Name receive our praises Now and for eternity. Amen.

And while this "going" and "coming" of Christ is important in the passage, the focus is more on "sorrow and joy." Specifically we are looking at sorrow fading away and joy taking its place. let us examine the two;

### 1. Sorrow

The pharisees, the wicked world and even those who wanted Barabas are glad for Jesus' death as he can no longer trouble them with his brilliant knowledge of God and the Scriptures. And the Pharisees, with Jesus' death, are less concerned about the Romans coming to destroy them. But the disciples will be sorrowful

This is Christ's promise to the disciples. There will be sorrow.

But this sorrow will turn into joy.

2. **Joy** 

And while he said ""You will weep and lament" and "You will be sorrowful," he also said "Your sorrow will turn into joy."

How is this possible? How can their sorrow turn into joy?

It is because they will know that Jesus has only left them for a brief period of time. He will return in his resurrection and also send his own Holy Spirit to be another comforter.

And the return of Jesus is extended in his sending of his Holy Spirit who remains with all Christians. And no one can take away that joy that they having, knowing Christ is risen and having he Holy Spirit permanently working in them. Joy, of course, is a fruit of the Spirit, the Holy Spirit.

# WHAT ARE OUR ASSURANCE FOR HEAVEN'S UNENDING JOY?

# 1. OUR JOY IS THE REASON CHRIST ENDURED THE SHAME ON THE CROSS ( Isa. 55:3-5)

For He was wounded for our transgression, bruised for our iniquities, the chastisement of our peace was upon Him and by His stripes we are healed. Hallelujah! In place of our supposed shame, reproach and ridicule, Christ was crucified and sacrificed for us. Hence, He bore the shame and regret. He paid the requisite sacrifice for those burdens of our heart. Be it marital, health wise, finances, to mention a few. Christ paid it all!

Now, how much understanding of this sacrifice do we recognize and comprehend ? We can be assured that heavens unending Joy is our lot if we believe in His death and resurrection and claim very not of the victory of Christ for us.

# 2. GOD CREATED YOU FOR HIS OWN GLORY.

God is most glorified in us when we are as glad and joyful and delighted in him as it is possible for us to be glad as believers.

The primary way that God pursues his own glory and fame is by producing in the hearts of a chosen people a deep, durable delight in who he is. In other words, it is precisely when you and I are fascinated with God above all else, satisfied with God more than with anything this life offers, delighted and excited and captivated and enthralled with God far beyond any other individual or experience, that he is most glorified and honored by us. And that's just another way of describing or defining the word "joy".

NOTE: "Joy in God matters profoundly because more than any other human response or experience, joy clearly and thoroughly and unmistakably reveals the worth and value and splendor of whatever it is that evokes it. That is why joy or delight is the single most effective means for glorifying and magnifying God".

# 3. GODS WORD ARE YE!

As believers we want to ask ourselves in the midst of turmoil, How do we know this is true? On what is this promise based? Beloved, the words of Jesus here in the upper room discourse give us the answer. The first answer is that our "joy" comes from being united to Jesus, abiding in Jesus, being with Jesus. And the reality of his resurrection from the dead is the assurance that he will never die again; he will never be taken from us; his presence and love and commitment to us is permanent and without end.

The joy that will never be taken from them is the joy that comes from knowing and seeing and being with Jesus. If your joy is in the physical pleasures of sex or the power that comes with money or the excellence with which you play a particular sport, or the skill with which you fulfill your job, your joy will be short-lived. Jesus is our only full, final, lasting joy.

Beloved in Christ, Jesus is saying I am able to heal you, my presence is with you. Yes you are in a bad shape at the moment, but I AM with you..... You are in the valley of the shadow of death, Yet I AM with you. Cleave to His word

# CONCLUSION

In this you can confidently trust: *the joy that Jesus gives to those who know and love him will never be taken from them. It will endure eternally.* It will sustain you through the worst that this life can throw in your face. It will uphold you when everything else crumbles and disintegrates. It is the only commodity, if I may be allowed to use that word, that comes with an iron-clad guarantee. It is iron-clad because it is blood bought.

And so Jesus offer to each of us today the joy that never ends, the joy that isn't dependent on physical health or worldly wealth or a faithful spouse or a car that never breaks down or a friend who always keeps his word. What I offer you is the joy that comes from the heart of Jesus himself into the hearts of those who truly know and trust him.

It can be yours today.

And once it is truly yours through faith in Jesus, it can never be taken from you.
