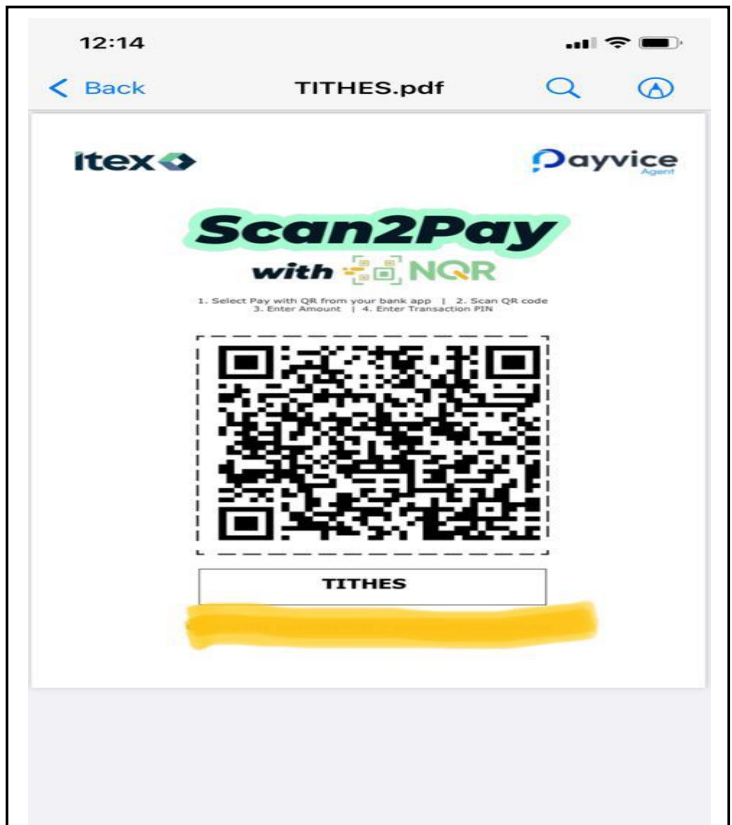

This week's topic is another subject that is important for every child of God to pay keen attention to. The lord Bishop of this Diocese would always say that bad attitude is like flat vehicle tires. Apparently, it will reduce the control and stability of the vehicle. Besides, there will be high risk of accident, the wheel is damaged, the fuel efficiency is decreased and chiefly the vehicle is stuck if it is not addressed going by the detriments this could cause, is important to address it with urgency.

Our attitude serves as the compass that is used to navigates life's journey, influencing our decisions, relationships, and ultimately, our destiny. Just as a compass guides a ship through uncharted waters, our attitude directs our path, shapes our experiences and outcomes. The Bible emphasizes the significance of our mindset which is the processing centre, stating that "as a man thinks in his heart, so is he" (Proverbs 23:7). This means that our thoughts and attitudes have the power to transform our life, for better or worse. A negative attitude can limit our potential, strain relationships, and blind us to God's blessings, while a positive attitude can unlock our potentials, foster meaningful relationships, and open doors to new opportunities. Beloved, attitude is everything in our life. It is the library of our experiences, and the prophet of our future.

In the epistle to the Romans 8:12-13, apostle Paul emphasized that we are no longer bound to live according to the sinful nature ("the flesh" "bad attitude, carnal nature), to live a life ruled by the standards set up by the dictates of the flesh. Instead, we have a new obligation to live by the Spirit. This shift signifies a transformation in our lives, where we are called to reject sinful behaviors and embrace a life led by the Holy Spirit.

As human beings, we all have evil desires, and we cannot ignore this fact. but for us to follow the Holy Spirit's guidance, we must deal with them decisively (Gal 5:24) These desires (Bad

sins, such as hostility, jealousy, and selfish ambition Gal. 5:19-21). Those who ignore such sins or refuse to deal with them reveal that they have not received the gift of the Spirit that leads to a transformed life. Hence, their speed in spiritual matters that relate to God is stuck. They aren't going anywhere.

Attitude is very important even in the Master's assignments committed to us. In Matt. 21:28-32, The son who said he would obey and then didn't represent the people of Israel in Jesus' day. They said they wanted to do God's will, but they constantly disobeyed. They were insincere in their heart and immersed in their bad attitude. It is dangerous to pretend to obey God when our heart is far from him because God knows our true intentions. Our actions must match our words.

In the light of this, cultivating right attitude start from the transformation of our heart. "Let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think (Rom. 12:2)." It is possible to avoid most worldly customs and still be proud, covetous, selfish, stubborn, and arrogant. Only when the Holy Spirit renews, reeducates, and redirects our mind that we are truly transformed. God wants us to be transformed people with renewed minds, living to honor and obey him. Because he wants only what is best for us, and because he gave his Son to make our new life possible.

A positive mindset, you empower yourself to navigate life's challenges with confidence and resilience. By focusing on what is true, noble, right, pure, lovely, and admirable (Philippians 4:8), you can transform your thoughts and emotions, aligning them with God's truth.
