THEME: CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP: HOW

**IMPORTANT** 

READING: PSALM 68:1-3; EXODUS 24:12-28;

HEBREWS 10:19-25; MATTHEW 18:18-

20.

All glory, honour and majesty to our God who has given us the privilege to witness another Sunday on earth. May His name be praised forever in Jesus name. Amen. Hebrews 10:25, tells us, "Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching." And Matthew 18:18-20, where Jesus declares, "Truly I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven. Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven. For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them."

Today we delve into a truth that is often overlooked, yet forms the very bedrock of our faith: **Christian fellowship**. It's not just about attending church services or sharing a meal. It's about the deep, abiding connection we have with each other, forged in the fire of our shared faith.

#### CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP: A BIBLICAL PERSPECTIVE

The Bible paints a picture of Christian fellowship as a deep, interconnected community bound by shared faith in Jesus Christ. It's not merely a social gathering, but a spiritual bond that transcends cultural, social, and even personal differences.

Here are some key biblical principles that define Christian fellowship:

- i. Unity in Christ: "For we are members of His body, of His flesh and His bones" (Ephesians 5:30). We are united as one body, each member playing a vital role in the whole body.
- ii. Love and Care: "Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ" (Galatians 6:2). We are called to love and care for each other, sharing in each other's joys and sorrows.
- how to stir up one another to love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching" (Hebrews 10:24-25) We are to appourage and build

iv. Shared Purpose: "Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving" (Colossians 2:6-7). We share a common purpose, following Christ and living out our faith together.

#### WHY IS CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP SO VITAL?

1. We Find Strength in Unity: Just as a single thread can easily be broken, but a tapestry woven together is strong and resilient, so too are we. The apostle Paul reminds us, "For as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so also is Christ" (1 Corinthians 12:12). When we gather together, we find strength in our shared faith. We encourage one another, pray for one another, and support each other through life's challenges. We are not meant to walk this journey alone.

Imagine a climber scaling a treacherous mountain. Alone, the climb is daunting, and the risk of falling is great. But with a team, each member supporting the other, and sharing the load, the journey becomes achievable. Christian fellowship is like that team, offering support, encouragement, and a shared purpose.

- 2. We Grow Together: The Bible tells us that "iron sharpens iron" (Proverbs 27:17). Through open and honest conversations, we learn from each other, challenge each other, and grow in the understanding of God's word. We are not meant to be stagnant in our faith. Think of a gardener tending a rose bush. Pruning, shaping, and nurturing the rose helps it bloom stronger and more beautifully. Christian fellowship is like that pruning, challenging us to grow, to shed unhealthy habits, and to blossom in our faith.
- 3. We Reflect Christ's Love: Our fellowship is a powerful witness to the world. When we love and support each other, we demonstrate the love of Christ to those around us. We are not meant to be silent witnesses.Imagine a lighthouse on a stormy sea. Its light, a beacon of hope, guides ships to safety. Our fellowship, fuelled by Christ's love, should shine brightly, offering hope and guidance to those around us.
- 4. We Are Called to Serve: As members of the body of Christ, we are called to serve one another. Through acts of kindness, compassion, and generosity, we show love to build up the community. We are not meant to be self-serving. It is like a family preparing a meal with each member contributing through chopping vegetables, setting the table, or cooking. Everyone's act of service, no matter how small, contributes to the



Christian fellowship is not an option, but a necessity. It is a vital part of our faith, a tapestry woven together by the threads of love, faith, and service. Let us embrace this gift, nurturing our connections with one another and reflecting the love of Christ to the world.
