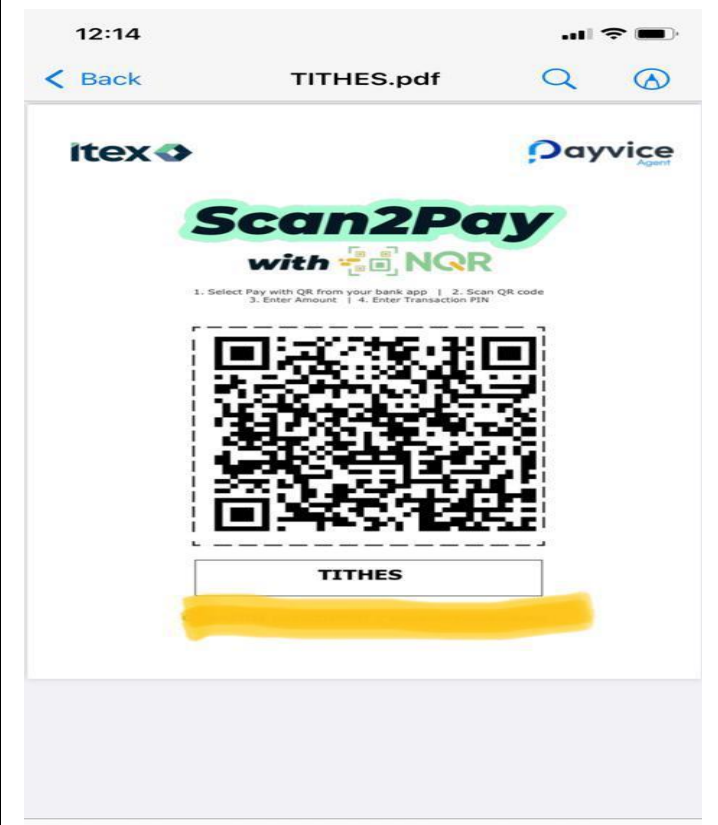

While eternal life is a free gift given because of God's grace (Ephesians 2:8-9), each of us will still be judged by Christ. He will reward us for how we have handled all His graces given to us. God's gracious gift of salvation does not free us from the requirement of faithful obedience. Most of the parables of Jesus point to the truth that God has deposited committed something to us and we must give account of all He had given to us. All Christians must give account on the day of judgment of how they have lived (Matthew 16:27; Romans 14:10-12; 1 Corinthians 3:10-15).

In John 5:2-14, we find the account of Jesus healing a man at the Pool of Bethesda, a place known for being surrounded by the sick, blind, lame, and paralyzed, waiting for an opportunity to be healed. The story begins with a question Jesus asks the paralyzed man: "Do you want to get well?" (John 5:6). This question serves as a test of the man's desire and accountability for his condition. The man's response, describing his inability to reach the water without help, reflects both his helplessness and his need for assistance. For us, this moment exemplifies the importance of recognizing our limitations and areas where we may need spiritual help, as well as understanding our part in pursuing healing and transformation. The situation of this man described many of us while we were yet sinners and could not help ourselves, neither could anyone in flesh, until Christ came to our rescue. Just like the paralyzed man, each person will one day give a full account of their response to God's offer of grace, salvation, healing, and restoration.

After the man gave the account of his inability to help himself, Jesus commanded the man, **"Get up! Pick up your mat and walk."**

This command comes without conditions or rituals, underscoring Jesus' authority over physical ailments and limitations. The man's immediate response of faith is significant because he obeyed without hesitation, experiencing healing as a result. His response to Jesus was an implicit form of accountability; he chose to act on Jesus' command, reflecting his belief in Jesus' power and authority. This aspect of accountability is crucial for us as believers, as we are called to live in obedience to God's word, responding to His guidance and direction as part of giving a full account. In the Bible, it is not everyone who had an encounter with Christ that obeyed His voice. Some did, while some jettisoned His offer. Nevertheless, everyone will be held responsible for how he/she responded to His call. Dear reader, how responsive are you to His call? Do you only respond when the call benefits you only?

After the healing, Jesus finds the healed man in the temple and tells him, **"See, you are well again. Stop sinning, or something worse may happen to you"** (John 5:14). This is indeed another clarion call. Jesus called the man to a transformed life, one that turns away from sin. This instruction illustrates the deeper spiritual implications of accountability; it's not only about receiving physical healing but also about pursuing spiritual health and righteousness. Jesus is highlighting the need for the man to account for his life choices and relationships with others, challenging him to live differently in response to the grace he has received. Hence, the worse may happen. Undeniably, the man's healing is not solely a private matter; it becomes a public testimony of Jesus' power, creating an opportunity for the man to give an account of who healed him. While the healed man initially doesn't know Jesus' identity, he later learns it

was Jesus who healed him and shares this information with the Jewish leaders. In a broader sense, this shows the importance of testifying about the transformative power of God in our lives. Our personal experiences of God's grace, healing, or guidance are not only for us but are meant to be shared, encouraging others and bringing glory to God.

Therefore, "to Prepare to give a full account" is living a life that acknowledges God's grace, responds in obedience, and pursues holiness. It encourages believers to be mindful of their actions, aware that their choices reflect their faith and devotion. Giving a full account means recognizing that our lives are a testimony to God's work, and each of us is responsible for how we respond to His grace and commands. We must realize that the account we give is not only about the words we say but about the way we live, allowing our actions to reflect our gratitude, faith, and commitment to God's purposes.

in Romans 14:12, Each person is accountable to Christ, not to others. While the church must be uncompromising in its stand against activities that are expressly forbidden by Scripture (adultery, homosexuality, murder, theft), it should not create additional rules and regulations and give them equal standing with God's law. Many times, Christians base their moral judgments on opinion, personal dislikes, or cultural bias rather than on the Word of God. When they do this, they show that their own faith is weak; they do not think that God is powerful enough to guide his children. When we stand before God and give a personal account of our life, we won't be worried about what our Christian neighbor has done (2 Corinthians 5:10).

Beloved, have you genuinely encountered Christ? Have you been washed from your sin? If no, why not? if yes, how are you walking before Him? If He comes today, what account will you give? The motto of Boy Scouts says, "Be Prepared". So, as Christ's soldiers, we must be prepared at all time to give account.
