INTRODUCTION

Acceleration refers to the act or process of moving faster or events happening more quickly than usual. When things progress as expected, there is often no cause for an alarm. However, when results exceed the normal pace or far surpass natural expectations, it calls for attention and reflection. A clear example is seen in the life of Elijah. Despite Ahab riding on a horse-drawn chariot, Elijah outran him to the entrance of Jezreel because "the hand of the Lord came upon Elijah" (1 Kings 18:46). This extraordinary feat was not by human strength or natural ability but by the divine intervention of God.

Divine acceleration occurs when divinity meets humanity, when God's supernatural hand rests upon an individual's life. Just as Elijah experienced, when God steps in, limitations are broken, natural laws are suspended, and what seems impossible becomes inevitable. With the hand of God, divine acceleration is not only possible but guaranteed.

 And they took them: and Elijah brought them down to the brook Kishon, and slew them there (1 Kings 18:46)
- 3. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, I receive divine favour that will overrule human benchmark for my upliftment.
 Now the king was attracted to Esther more than to any of the other women, and she won his favor and approval more than any of the other virgins. So he set a royal crown on her head and made her queen instead of Vashti (Esther 2:17).
- 4. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, I receive uncommon speed to recover all that had been taken away from me in full measure.
 And David recovered all that the Amalekites had carried away: and David rescued his two wives. And there was nothing lacking to them, neither small nor great, neither sons nor daughters, neither spoil, nor any thing that they had taken to them: David recovered all (1 Samuel 30:18-19).
- Father in the name of Jesus Christ, turn back the fortune of this nation.
 When the Lord turned again the captivity of Zion, we were like them that dream
 (Psalms 126:1).
- 6. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, cause the weeping of your church to seize.

 Weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning (Psalms 30:5b).
- 7. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, let your hand rest upon my life for supernatural accomplishment.
 - But the people who know their God shall prove themselves strong and shall stand firm and do exploits [for God]. (Daniel 11:32b)



Fulfilling Divine Mandate

WORD ON THE TOPIC: The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, to preach the acceptable year of the Lord. And he closed the book, and he gave it again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on him. (Luke 4:18-20)

INTRODUCTION: The word "divine" reflects God's vision and purpose, while a "divine mandate" refers to God's specific assignment for an individual or group. It is your ministry, your calling—something God commands you to do, not a product of personal ambition or desire. As believers, we are not mere spectators in the cultural and spiritual arenas but active participants in God's redemptive plan. Recognizing our calling as a divine mandate means understanding that the call to be "salt and light" (Matthew 5:13-16) is not optional; it is a binding, non-negotiable responsibility.

You must fulfill your divine mandate. To do so, remain firmly rooted in the unchanging truth of God's Word, guided by the Holy Spirit, and united in love. As we embrace and live out our mandate, may our lives shine as a reflection of God's glory, drawing others to the transformative power of His grace and love.

Prayers:

1. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, purify me from every dirtiness preventing me from fulfilling Your mandate.

Then flew one of the Seraphims unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar: And he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin purged (Isaiah 6:5-7).

2. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, I declare my total obedience to your service. I am I, send me.

Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, Here am I; send me (Isaiah 6:8).

3. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, I receive sufficient strength to go about my endeavours in life, empower me never to deliver excuse where results are required.

How God anointed and consecrated Jesus of Nazareth with the [Holy] Spirit and with strength and ability and power; how He went about doing good and, in particular, curing all who were harassed and oppressed by [the power of] the devil, for God was with Him (Acts 10:38).

4. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, I declare that everything shall work together for the fulfilment of the purpose for my existence.

And ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfil (Exodus 23:25-26).

5. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, give our political leaders the heart that fears you and dispense their assignment according to Your will.

If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen (1Peter 4:11).

6. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, we confront every affliction plaguing the Church with the fire of the Holy Spirit.

And Jesus answered him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jona! For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in heaven. 18 And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the powers of death shall not prevail against it (Matthew 16:17-18).

7. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, my position shall not be empty and I will not lose my divine identity.

Let your light so shine before men that they may see your moral excellence and your praiseworthy, noble, and good deeds and recognize and honor and praise and glorify your Father Who is in heaven (Matthew 5:16).



Marital Success

WORD ON THE TOPIC: And the Lord God said, it is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a help meet for him (Gen 2:18).

INTRODUCTION: God's creative work was not complete until He made woman. Although He could have formed her from the dust of the ground, as He did with man, God intentionally chose to create her from the man's flesh and bone. This act beautifully illustrates that in marriage, man and woman are united into one; a profound, mystical union of hearts and lives. Throughout the Bible, God treats this sacred partnership with utmost seriousness.

If you are married or planning to be married, are you prepared to honor and nurture the commitment that unites the two of you as one? The goal of marriage goes beyond friendship; it is about oneness, a deep, inseparable bond ordained by God. We live in a world filled with countless devastating stories about marriage. The frequent breakdowns witnessed today have led some to the false conclusion that "Marriage is a scam." However, such failure often stems from a lack of understanding and disregard for the Creator's design.

How can we effectively drive a car without understanding its manual? Similarly, marriage—an institution founded by God—requires us to consult the One who designed it. True marital success can only be achieved by acknowledging the Author of marriage and following the principles He has laid out in His Word. There are no shortcuts to marital success. The only path to a thriving and fulfilling marriage is through God. Outside of Him, marriage can quickly become a place of strife and suffering instead of the haven of love, peace, and joy it was meant to be. Let us return to the Author of marriage, seek His wisdom, and allow His presence to transform our marriages into a reflection of His perfect design.

- 1. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, strengthen our homes to truly manifest full expression of marital unity.
 - "Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their toil. For if they fall, one will lift up his fellow. But woe to him who is alone when he falls and has not another to lift him up!" (Eccl 4:9-10)
- **2.** Father in the name of Jesus Christ, let the true nature of divine love manifest in our homes.
 - Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things (1Cor 13:4-7).
- Father in the name of Jesus Christ, help me to honour my spouse and grant me wisdom that will edify my home.

 <u>Likewise, ye husbands, dwell withthemaccording to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered (1 Pet 3:7).</u>
- 4. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, mold a wall of fire around my marriage, to keep it away from strange men and women.
 - He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and fortress; My God, in Him I will trust (Ps 91:1-2).
- **5.** Father in the name of Jesus Christ, please give us wisdom to manage our finances with prudence and godly stewardship.
 - Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you (*Luke 6:38*).
- **6.** Father in the name of Jesus, teach us how to leave in unity, love, honor one another, and become one.
 - How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity! (Psalm 133:1)



Commanding the Year

WORD ON THE TOPIC: Then spake Joshua to the Lord in the day when the Lord delivered up the Amorites before the children of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel, Sun, stand thou still upon Gibeon; and thou, Moon, in the valley of Ajalon. And the sun stood still, and the moon stayed, until the people had avenged themselves upon their enemies. Is not this written in the book of Jasher? So the sun stood still in the midst of heaven, and hasted not to go down about a whole day. And there was no day like that before it or after it, that the Lord hearkened unto the voice of a man: for the Lord fought for Israel (Josh. 10:12-14).

INTRODUCTION: There is nothing that God has created that does not have the capacity to hear. Human beings hear, nature hears, systems hear, nations hear, and even times and seasons respond to the voices speaking into them (Joshua 10:13-14; Isaiah 49:1; Jeremiah 31:10). Our God is a *Speaking God*; He spoke creation into existence (Hebrews 11:3; Romans 4:17). As His children, it is our responsibility to replicate His nature by speaking life and purpose into our circumstances.

The New Year is like an open cheque placed in each of our hands. What we write on it, what we speak into determines the outcomes we will see. The year will only deliver what you intentionally command into it through your words. As Paul admonished in *Ephesians 5:16*, "Redeem the time, for the days are evil." God has given us the gift of a new year, but we have the responsibility to speak positivity, purpose, and blessings into it. Do not leave your year to chance. Frame the kind of year you desire with your pronouncements of faith. Speak life, favor, progress, and success into every aspect of the year. Let your words align with God's promises, and watch as the year responds to your declarations.

Begin to command your year—declare it, proclaim it, and see it manifest!

- 1. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, I decree that in this year, my testimony shall be come and see what the lord has done.
 - ... then said they among the heathen, The LORD hath done great things for them. The LORD hath done great things for us; whereof we are glad (Psalm 126:3).
- 2. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, I decree that I will walk in divine direction this new year, my heart is illuminated to understand the deep things that God desires for this world this season/year.
 - Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words (Rom 8:26).
- 3. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, this year, I will be divinely guided into realms of supernatural abundance and breakthroughs.
 - And the LORD shall guide thee continually, and satisfy thy soul in drought, and make fat thy bones: and thou shalt be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters fail not. (Isa 58:11).
- 4. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, I command nature and all creature to work in my favour.
 - Then spake Joshua to the Lord in the day when the Lord delivered up the Amorites before the children of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel, Sun, stand thou still upon Gibeon; and thou, Moon, in the valley of Ajalon. And the sun stood still, and the moon stayed, until the people had avenged themselves upon their enemies (Josh. 10:12).
- 5. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, I decree that this year, everything I do prospers and everything I lay my hands upon turns to gold.

 Then shall the earth yield her increase; and God, even our own God, shall bless us (Psalm 67:6).
- 6. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, beautify Your church with goodness and mercy.

 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever (Psalm 23:60).



Anointing Of Touch-Not

WORD ON THE TOPIC: He suffered no man to do them wrong: yea, he reproved kings for their sakes; Saying, Touch not mine anointed, and do my prophets no harm (Psalm 105:14-15).

INTRODUCTION: The act of anointing with oil in the Bible is performed in religious ceremonies. This is called ceremonial anointing in the Old Testament. It was a physical act involving the smearing, rubbing, or pouring of sacred oil on someone's head/or on an object as an outward symbol that God had chosen and set apart the person (or object) for a specific holy purpose.

In Psalm 105:15, the Psalmist tracing down the history of the Israelites recounted the fulfilment of God's promises to make Israel great and He particularly noted that God anointed them with "The Oil of Exemption" forbidding others to harm them. The anointing of "Touch Not" is an exemption anointing in which God pours upon His own people to secure them. Anyone who touches a person upon whom this anointing is poured is never spared by God.

God is jealous over the life upon which the anointing of touch-not is poured. Nothing harms them nor injures them.

Prayers:

1. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, I command every evil hand stretch towards my family to wither.

And it came to pass, when king Jeroboam heard the saying of the man of God, which had cried against the altar in Bethel, that he put forth his hand from the altar, saying, Lay hold on him. And his hand, which he put forth against him, dried up, so that he could not pull it in again to him (1Kgs 13:4).

- 2. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, I decree that whoever raises evil sword against my family shall fall by it.
 - And it came to pass, as he (Sennacherib) was worshipping in the house of Nisroch his god, that Adrammelech and Sharezer his sons smote him with the sword (2 Kings 19:37).
- 3. Father in the name of Jesus Christ, by the power of Your Word, I neutralize every force of enchantment against my life.
 - Surely there is no enchantment against Jacob, neither is there any divination against Israel: according to this time it shall be said of Jacob and of Israel, What hath God wrought! (Num. 23:23)
- 4. Father in the name of Jesus, I refused to fall into the snare set by my Haman.

 So, they hanged Haman on the gallows that he had prepared for Mordecai. Then was the king's wrath pacified (Esther 7:10).
- 5. Father in the name of Jesus, I received the anointing of touch not by my supplanter in 2025.
 - It is in the power of my hand to do you hurt but the God of your father spake unto me yesternight, saying, take thou heed that thou speak not to Jacob either good or bad (Gen. 31:29).
- 6. Father in the name of Jesus, we command all the enemies of Your church to rise and fight one another.
 - And when they began to sing and to praise, the Lord set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten (2 Chron. 20:22).
- 7. Father in the name of Jesus, I declare there shall be peace withing the boarder of the nation.
 - The Lord shall fight for you, and ye shall hold your peace (Exod. 14:14).
