Happy and glorious Sunday to each and every one of us today. We thank God for bringing us into the year 2025 and we pray it shall be a year of fruitfulness and productivity in Jesus' name.

Today is second Sunday in Epiphany. This word "Epiphany" comes from Greek roots that mean "to show, to display", to bring out. It is the manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles as represented by the Magi. His glory at birth was revealed to the world to show that Light has shown in the midst of darkness in order to bring many into the Kingdom of God.

A mission is an official command or a go-ahead. It is a matching order that is not negotiable, it is a commission, and the Great Commission is the instruction of the resurrected Jesus Christ to his disciples (equivalently all believers, God's servants) to spread the gospel to all the nations of the world (Matthew 28:19-20).

The Bible has a great deal to say about servanthood because the central theme of the Bible is "**the Servant of all—Jesus Christ**". "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many" (Mark 10:45). When we give Jesus Christ His rightful place as Lord of our lives, His lordship will equally be expressed in the way we serve others (Mark 9:35; 1 Peter 4:10).

"A great man is different from an eminent one in that he is ready to be the servant of the society", says B. R. Ambedkar.

The best definition to explain who a servant is, is "willingness and obedience", Jesus Christ the Saviour of all performs the salvation rites for all on the platform of obedience and willingness! Full of obedience to the will of God and he is ever willing to see it fulfilled (Psalm 40:8; Matthew 26:42; John 9:4; Phil 2:6-8; Heb 10:7). He (Jesus) then set an example for all (God's servants) who will come after him.

Leveraging on the priesthood of all believers "that all humans have access to God through Christ the true high priest, and thus do not need a priestly mediator", so also all who have access to God are His servants (either male or female, without seclusion).

Hence, our text today speaks volumes of our mandate. Major things to note from our text are:

• Fulfilling All Righteousness (Matt 3:15): Jesus uses the word "it is proper for us" to indicate that he is inclusive! He came to be baptized (the sinless one with the sinners to fulfill God's plan of salvation, the sinless went down to the water of baptism that is the portion of the sinners), and he was empowered like every other servant needs empowerment from on high to fulfill God's mandate for them (Matt 3:16; Acts 10:38).

It is clearly stated of Jesus in Isaiah 53 that the suffering servant was to be numbered with transgressors, with that, the LORD would lay the iniquity of all on Him, and Isaiah further described him as the righteous servant of God.

Righteousness being fulfilled is the right living, good deeds, virtues, acts, and so on. This is established as Jesus went about doing good (Isaiah 42:5-7; Acts 10:38).

• Introduces The Messiah to the World (John 1:29; 36): The account of John on the baptism of Jesus by John records that on the arrival of Jesus, John announced... "Behold the lamb of God". This singular act of John is part of fulfilling his own God given mission, because it is the mandate given to the forerunner to introduce the Messiah (who is greater than the kings of the earth) to the world (Psalm 89:27).

Every believer is God's servant, anointed to fulfill God's will on earth (Acts 1:8). We must realize that as servants, God is our master, He has chosen us to be His messengers who will relay His desired message to the world, not with our own motive but according to His will.

Philip Doddridge penned down in the wordings of a hymn (the church of Nigeria Hymnal **575** stanzas 1 & 2)

- > Ye servants of the Lord, each in his office wait, Observant of his heavenly word, And watchful at his gate.
- > Let all your lamps be bright, and trim the golden flame: Gird up your loins, as in his sight, for awful is his name.

The mandate is God's will which every Christian is expected to fulfil. We are not placed here to do our will but to strictly do our best for the best of the Kingdom of God willingly and in perfect obedience.

DECLARATION INTO 2025

In 2025, I will walk in divine direction and favour. Every step I take will be ordered by the Lord, and doors of opportunity will open before me. By divine guidance, my steps are ordered into God's mandate for my life, bringing clarity and purpose to every decision. The light of God will shine on my path, dispelling every form of darkness. My steps are ordered by the Lord, and He shall delight in my way (Psalm 37:23).

Year 2025 shall be my year of restoration. Everything the enemy has stolen will be returned sevenfold, and new beginnings shall spring forth in every area of my life. Fresh breath from the Holy Spirit will quicken my mortal body, revitalizing my spirit, soul, and body. The Lord will restore to me the years that the swarming locust has eaten (Joel 2:25). There shall be ways in my wilderness, and from my desert shall spring up rivers of living waters, creating paths of abundance and joy (Isaiah 43:19).

In 2025, my health will spring forth speedily. Sickness and disease will be far from my abode, and I will walk in divine strength all through the year. My health will not fail, and I will enjoy vitality and wholeness in my body. No organ in my body will shut down or malfunction. My body will not be a chamber of sickness but a temple of the Holy Spirit. The Lord will increase my strength and vitality, renewing my energy for every assignment.

I shall lack no good thing in 2025. The windows of heaven will be opened over me, and I shall experience supernatural provision and abundance beyond human expectations. My gate shall be opened continually for kings and queens to bless me with the riches of their kingdoms. And my God shall supply all my needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:19). God's provision will overflow in every area of my life, eliminating every form of lack.

2025 will be a year of peace and joy for me. The peace of God will guard my heart, silencing every anxiety and fear, and I will rejoice in His goodness daily. The peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard my heart and mind through Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:7). My home, relationships, and endeavours will radiate God's peace, and I will find joy in His unfailing love.

No weapon formed against me in 2025 shall prosper. I will triumph over every challenge, rising above trials with God's help; the Lord will fight for me, and I shall hold my peace (Exodus 14:14). Whoever raises an evil sword against my family shall fall by the sword, and every tongue that condemns me shall be silenced. The grace to walk through the year 2025 unhurt and uninjured rests upon me in Jesus' name. Victory shall be my portion in every battle.

In 2025, I will be fruitful in all areas of my life. My efforts will multiply, and I will enjoy the work of my hands, experiencing abundant harvests. Wherever my seed drops in 2025, it will bring forth fruits a hundredfold. My seeds will subdue the earth and establish dominion (Gen. 1:28). The Lord will make me abound in prosperity, and I will flourish in all I set my hands to do. My spiritual life will experience a fresh outpouring in 2025. I will hunger for God like never before, and His power will flow through me, making me a vessel for His glory. I receive grace to wait on the Lord for renewal of strength, and out of my heart rivers of living water will flow (John 7:38).

All of these and many more shall be my portion in 2025 and beyond in Jesus Christ's name. Amen.

CONCLUSION
