

4. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 26TH JANUARY, 2025

THEME: THE RENEWING TOUCH OF GOD PSALM 27:1-8; EXODUS 33:12-END; 1 JOHN 1:1-7;MATTHEW 8:1-13.

Today, we looking at the theme The renewing touch of God. Our texts, 1 John 1:1-7 and Matthew 8:1-13, reveals how God's touch brings healing, transformation, and renewal to our lives.

In 1 John 1:1-7, John speaks of having seen, heard, and touched the Word of Life—Jesus Christ. This passage emphasizes the reality of God's presence and the fellowship we are called into. The renewing touch of God is about restoring us to a right relationship with Him and each other.

The Nature of God's Touch:

- Healing: In Matthew 8:1-3, we encounter a leper who approaches Jesus, seeking healing. Lepers were outcasts, living in isolation due to their condition. Yet, Jesus reached out and touched him, saying, "I am willing; be cleansed." This healing touch was an act of compassion and acceptance, reminding us that no one is beyond God's reach.
- 2. <u>Cleansing:</u> The leprosy represents spiritual impurity and sin. Just as the leper was cleansed, the renewing touch of God purifies us from sin. John assures us that "the blood of Jesus...cleanses us from all sin." This cleansing is ongoing as we walk in His light.
- 3. Equipping for Service: God's touch empowers us for service and ministry. Just as Jesus touched the lives of His disciples, calling them into mission, His touch equips us with the gifts and abilities needed to fulfill His purpose. In Acts 1:8, we see that the Holy Spirit empowers believers to be witnesses. When we experience God's touch, we are not only healed but also commissioned to share that healing with others.
- 4. Changing Our Identity: The renewing touch of God transforms our identity. In 2 Corinthians 5:17, we are reminded that in Christ, we are a new creation. God's touch reshapes who we are, moving us from labels of shame, guilt, and brokenness to identities marked by grace, love, and purpose. When we allow God to touch our lives, we step into the fullness of our identity as beloved children of God.
- 5. Renewing Our Minds and Hearts: God's touch also brings about a transformation in our thoughts and desires. Romans 12:2 instructs us to be transformed by the renewing of our minds. This transformation equips us to discern God's will and leads us to live according to His purposes. As we allow His touch to renew our

6. Reassurance in Times of Trouble:

- God's touch brings comfort in moments of pain and uncertainty. Psalm 34:18 tells us that the Lord is near to the brokenhearted and saves the crushed in spirit. His touch reassures us that we are not alone in our trials. When we seek His presence, we find solace and strength, reminding us that God walks alongside us through our darkest times.

The Power of Faith in God's Touch:

Matthew 8:5-13 presents the remarkable faith of a centurion who sought healing for his servant. His understanding of authority and faith in Jesus' power highlight the importance of faith in experiencing God's renewing touch.

- Recognizing Authority: The centurion recognized that Jesus had authority over illness and believed that His word alone could heal. This faith in Jesus' power and authority is crucial for us. We must trust that God's touch can transcend our limitations and circumstances.
- 2. <u>Expecting the Impossible</u>: The centurion's faith led to his servant's healing, demonstrating that faith opens the door to God's miraculous intervention. When we approach God with faith, we invite His renewing touch into even the most impossible situations.
- 3. Opening Doors to the Supernatural: Faith acts as a catalyst that opens the door to the miraculous. In Mark 9:23, Jesus states, "All things are possible for one who believes." When we approach God with unwavering faith, we invite His supernatural power into our situations. The centurion's faith in Matthew 8 demonstrates that even a simple word from Jesus can unleash profound change. Our faith can activate God's intervention in our lives and the lives of others.

Throughout Scripture, we see numerous accounts where faith led to miraculous outcomes. The woman with the issue of blood believed that touching Jesus' garment would heal her (Mark 5:27-29). Her faith not only brought her healing but also revealed the deep connection between belief and God's response. These examples remind us that genuine faith can lead to extraordinary manifestations of God's power.

- 4. Trusting His Perfect Plan: Faith also involves trusting in God's timing. Often, we may desire immediate solutions, but God's ways and timing are perfect. In John 11, when Lazarus was sick, Jesus delayed His visit. Martha and Mary's faith was tested, yet they ultimately witnessed an incredible miracle—Lazarus being raised from the dead. This teaches us that our faith must encompass trust in God's greater plan, even when circumstances seem bleak.
- 5. <u>Endurance through Trials:</u> Faith is not just about expecting immediate results; it's also about endurance through trials. James 1:2-4 encourages us to consider it pure joy when we


