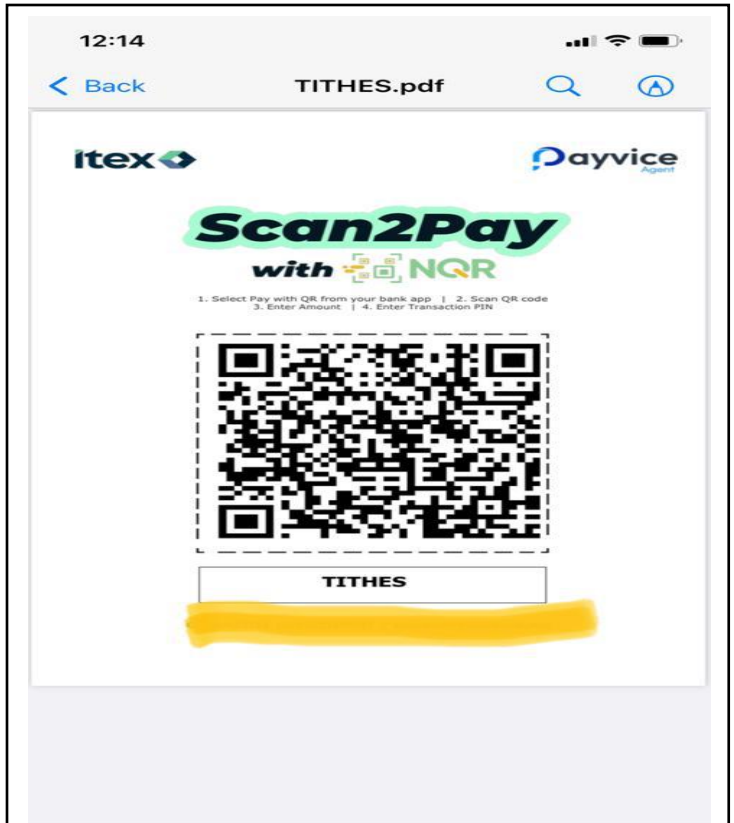

THEME: GOD: THE ULTIMATE HEALER  
READING: PSALM 77:1-15; II KINGS 5:1-14;  
JAMES 5:13-16A; MARK 2:1-12.

**Introduction:**

Sickness goes beyond merely being ill or having a physical ailment; it represents a state of dysfunction and an unhealthy condition of both body and soul. When considering healing, many individuals concentrate primarily on the physical body, yet the condition of the soul is far more crucial. A person can be physically healthy and still face financial struggles. Likewise, one might be financially secure but morally unwell, and someone can be fit in body while suffering spiritually.

In essence, we live in a world that is unwell. Not only is the world in a state of sickness, but each person within it is affected in some way. Thus, the need for healing is more pressing than ever.

**Facts we ought to know about our God**

- The God we worship is the God of all possibilities. He has the power to reverse health issues that people have deemed incurable (Deuteronomy 32:39). There is no illness that can undermine His healing abilities (Jeremiah 32:17).
- Our God is a caring God—He desires the best for His children (Isaiah 57:18-19). He is also the God of restoration, bringing back life, health, and comfort (Jeremiah 33:6; Isaiah 38:16-17).

He is the God of healing, offering complete recovery to those who are downcast (Isaiah 40:29; Isaiah 41:10). As the Creator of all, He has the ability to recreate, replace, reprogram, and revitalize any organ or life (Isaiah 45:7; Isaiah 66:2; Revelation 4:11).

### Mark 2:1-12 Insights:

- Jesus is always available to help when you seek Him (v2).
- While Jesus can heal any illness, faith is essential to activate His healing power (v5).
- Not all illnesses are due to sin, but sin is a significant cause of many (v5b, 6-7).
- The greatest ailment is sin, and without its cure, evil persists (v8-9).
- God often uses our problems and illnesses to glorify Himself (v12).
- God desires us to be healthy and at peace (3 John 1:2, John 14:27).
