

4. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 2ND MARCH, 2025 THEME: CHRIST: THE FRIEND OF SINNERS READING: PSALM 99:4-9; HOSEA 14:1-7; COLOSSIANS 1:18-23; MARK 2:13-17.

INTRODUCTION

It Is a delight that we have been preserved by God to see another new month in the land of the living! Once again, welcome to Quinquagesima Sunday, the Sunday preceding Ash Wednesday. It's another time of reflection and meditation. May we indeed encounter God as we prepare our hearts to seek His face and find Him. Amen

JESUS AND THE TASK COLLECTORS

1. The scandal of grace

The work of tax collectors.

In the time of Jesus the Roman empire was a vast organization that required enormous funding.

That funding came through a variety of taxes. There were fixed taxes: land tax, income tax, a poll tax just for being alive. These were collected by Roman citizens.

Then there were duty taxes: sales, import and export, road and harbor tolls. These were farmed out to locals who bid for the collection of a region.

The Romans calculated a base number which would be required from the local collector. That collector's income came from whatever he gained on top of the base tax rates. This most often came from cheating people with unfair demands.

Tax collectors are among the most reviled people in Jesus' day because of the corruption associated with the office. Customs duties on goods transported through Galilee are among the taxes collected, and it is likely that Matthew, whom we meet in today's passage (Matt. 9:9), gathers these fees. In his work he collects a set amount for Herod Antipas, the ruler of Galilee, who in turn sends it to Rome. Matthew is free to assess the value of the goods carried through his region and, like other collectors, demands a tax higher than what the government requires and keeps the difference for himself. This offers ample opportunity for unjust taxation, giving the people reason to hate tax collectors." –Ligonier

However, When Jesus walked up to Levi at the tax collector's booth and said, "come follow me", it was absolutely scandalous. It was even more scandalous when Jesus attended a dinner party at Levi's house with his social network of fellow tax collectors and sinners. To dine with someone was to commune with them. It involved a connection, an exchange. To dine with someone who was sinful or unclean was to



It was unthinkable to imagine the Messiah lounging at a table with that kind of crowd.The problem was not that Jesus interacted with sinful people. John the Baptist did that. Out in the wilderness he called the sinful people to repentance.

> Even tax collectors came to be baptized. "Teacher," they asked, "what should we do?" Luke 3:12

> The scandal was that Jesusassociated with these people prior to any sign of repentance.

"The scandal of this story is that Jesus does not make moral repentance a precondition of his love and acceptance. . . Rather, Jesus loves and accepts tax collectors and sinners as they are. If they forsake their evil and amend their lives, they do so, as did Zacchaeus (Luke 19:1-10), not in order to gain Jesus' favor but because Jesus has loved them as sinners. Jesus' association with such people is not coincidental. He does not happen to be with them or wait for invitations. He initiates the fellowship, " 'I must stay at your house today' " (Luke 19:5). We are not told how many sinners and tax collectors repented and reformed. We are only told that Jesus sowed love as profligately and uncalculatedly as the sower who threw seed in unpromising places (Mark 4:3-9)

Jesus communicates in word and deed that accepting and following him are more important than following Torah. When the unreformed and unregenerate do that, they will enter the kingdom of God before the scribes and Pharisees. In table fellowship with "sinners and tax collectors," Jesus scandalously asserts his exousia, his own person over Torah, and the profligate love of God over merit. That is the scandal of grace."

2. The power of grace

That love is powerful. That love melts hearts and produces genuine repentance.

Zacchaeus, another tax collector, after experiencing the love of Jesus responded to that love with repentance. Take a minute and read this again;

But Zacchaeus stood up and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord! Here and now I give half of my possessions to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount." Luke 19:8.

Levi the tax collector was Matthew the apostle. The world saw a despised tax collector, scum. Jesus saw a saint, a leader and a writer of Holy Scriptures.

The grace of Jesus is scandalous and it is immensely powerful.

3. The mission of grace

When the scandalized Pharisees asked Jesus' disciples – "why does he eat with sinners and tax collectors?". Jesus

A doctor doesn't come for the healthy, but for the sick.

Given that mission, it is as senseless for Jesus to shun tax collectors and sinners as for a doctor to shun the sick. The grace of God extends to and overcomes the worst forms of human depravity. Ironically, in one sense great sinners stand closer to God than those who think themselves righteous, for sinners are more aware of their need of the transforming grace of God.

"You would expect to find a savior among those who need to be saved."

The question is, Where ought we to find those who serve a savior?

What ought we to find them doing?

But, Jesus' statement also said much about sinners. Recall it. He said: "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. I came not to call the righteous, but sinners"

Don't miss what Jesus is doing. Jesus said he was like a doctor going to the sick. He did not come for righteous people, but sinners. What did he mean? Was he trying to say the Pharisees were righteous, without sin, and not in need of his help?

Not at all! Some of the Pharisees became Christians, champions of the gospel. Paul the Apostle had been a Pharisee before he realized his need for Christ. But Jesus is saying that he cannot help the Pharisees. They didn't know they were sick. They couldn't see their sin. And, as long as someone thinks they have no sin, Jesus cannot help them. Just as someone who thinks they have no sickness will not pursue medical attention, so someone who thinks they're righteous will not turn to Jesus.

Beloved of God, what's our take home today

- 1. God is intentional about us: Jesus was sent for this course. He desires fellowship
- 2. God gave us His son even while we were yet sinners: for God so love the world that He gave His only begotten son!
- 3. Jesus' mission was and is for the lost!
- 4. Jesus loves you but doesn't love our sinful nature.
- 5. His grace is sufficient for you: often the devil fill out heart with guilt and shame. But he is the father of liars.

CONCLUSION.

You see, in Jesus' estimation, we are all sinners who have fallen short of the glory of God. The problem with this label today is that most will object. I'm not broken! I'm not a sinner! I don't need to be well! But those who've received the gospel had to first say, I am a sinner! I need grace! I am broken! So are you! And this offends.

But this is who we are, Beloved, sinners seated around the table with Christ. We need him. We need his grace, forgiveness, and cleansing. We need the great doctor to come and heal us. And to keep on healing us! No matter who we are, what our background is, or what our temptations are, we need Jesus. Our broken minds and wills and feelings and souls and bodies are all in need of his constant attention. Sin has plagued us, and Jesus is our only answer!
