We give thanks to God Almighty for bringing us to this wonderful Sunday. Today is the 4th Sunday in Lent and the mothering Sunday. As we celebrate our mothers, we pray that the homes God has given to you will not crash in Jesus name.

Introduction

In Genesis 2:18, we see the institution of family as God's intention to bring a man and woman together as companions. God established the family as the first human relationship, emphasizing that man is not meant to be alone. Marriage, as the union of husband and wife, is the foundation of family life. God wants the two to live together as partners, in love, unity and for procreation. Accordioning to Genesis 2:24, the Bible described their coming together as one flesh. That is, they are fused together physically, emotionally, spiritually and sexually. They are indivisible, just as the body is one and cannot be divided without harm or hurt, family life is intended to be a permanent, covenantal relationship.

God's creative work was not complete until he made woman. He could have made her from the dust of the ground, as he made man. God chose, however, to make her from the man's flesh and bone. In so doing, he illustrated for us that in marriage/family life, man and woman symbolically are united into one. This is a mystical union of the couple's hearts and lives. Throughout the Bible, God treats this special partnership seriously. If you are married or planning to be married, are you willing to keep the commitment that makes the two of you one? The goal in marriage should be more than friendship; it should be oneness; a situation where two people work together for the common purpose of growth.

Undeniably, a strong and healthy home is the foundation of a stable church and society at large. Each family is a unit that makes up the church and society, so the standard of the family determines to some extent the standard of thechurch and society. The roles of the husband and wife in home building are divinely ordained and essential for the spiritual, moral, and emotional growth of the family. A wellbuilt home does not happen by chance; it requires commitment, sacrifice, and obedience to God's design.

There are copious roles that husband and wife must take to build their family, but we shall base our role on divine pattern as highlighted in the Bible.

The Role of the Husband Spiritual Leadership

1.

In Genesis2:15 God took the man and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it; not only to give him pleasant employment, but to place him on probation, and as the head of the garden. This is an indication that God wanted man to take the position of leadership and see to the oversight of the garden. The husband is called to be the spiritual head of the home (Ephesians 5:23). He must lead by example in prayer, worship, and the study of God's Word. In fact, the first pastor in every family is the husband. Psalm 18:27-38 emphasizes God's strength given to His people, and as the leader, the husband must rely on God's power to guide his family righteously.

2. Love and Sacrificial Service

A husband must love his wife just as Christ loves the Church (Ephesians 5:25). This love is selfless, sacrificial, and nurturing. Just as Moses' face shone after encountering God (Exodus 34:29-35), a godly husband reflects Christ's love in his home. His leadership is not about control but about serving and supporting his family.Besides, the love of Christ, a husband is someone who is ready to sacrifice for the comfort of the family. He does not have the attitude of winner takes all. He is selfless, seeing that his family comes first in all that he dies.

3. Providing for the Home

The Bible teaches that a husband must provide for his household (1 Timothy 5:8). This provision goes beyond financial needs; it includes emotional stability, security, and a nurturing environment where everyone can grow. He must be hardworking, diligent, and wise in managing family resources. To default on the basic care and support of a family member is the same as denying the faith, for no one can claim love and allegiance to God and at the same time neglect his or her family. To do so makes people worse than unbelievers, for even unbelieving idol-worshipers understood the responsibility of caring for family needs. Our families provide an arena in which we can demonstrate the quality of our love for God. John provided a scathing rebuke to any believer who would dare to claim affection for God but won't care for their own relatives. Believers who neglect the most basic human responsibilities have, for all practical purposes, denied what they believe.

4. Encouraging Growth and Development

The husband as the Gardener is expected to see that the garden is growing in all spheres. The members of the family are expected to experience growth under his supervision and encouragement. Just as Jesus encouraged His disciples to grow in faith (Matthew 17:1-13), a husband must support his wife and children in their personal and spiritual development. He should help his wife in her God-given purpose and encourage the children to fulfill their destinies.

The Role of the Wife

1. A Helper and Encourager

God created the woman as a helper to her husband (Genesis 2:18). The first intention of God to give Adam a wife was to give him a helper that will meet his need. This role is not about inferiority but partnership. A wife is to support, encourage, and strengthen her husband, making their home a place of peace and joy. II Corinthians 3:4-18 highlights how God's grace transforms and empowers believers, and a godly wife reflects this grace in her home.

2. Submission and Respect

The Bible calls wives to submit to their husbands as unto the Lord (Ephesians 5:22-24). Submission does not mean weakness but a willing heart to work together in unity. A respectful wife builds her home with wisdom (Proverbs 14:1) and fosters harmony through understanding and patience. The man is the spiritual head of the family, and his wife should acknowledge his leadership. But real spiritual leadership involves service. Just as Christ served the disciples, even to the point of washing their feet, so the husband is to serve his wife. A wise and Christ-honoring husband will not take advantage of his leadership role, and a wise and Christ-honoring wife will not try to undermine her husband's leadership. Either approach causes disunity and friction in marriage.

3. Nurturing the Family

Nurturing the family, which is the garden, is another fundamental reason for creating Eve. A wife plays a crucial role in shaping the home's atmosphere. She nurtures her family by providing emotional support, love, and care to create a warm and stable home. She fosters strong family bonds by offering guidance, encouragement, and understanding. Through acts of kindness, patience, and sacrifice, she ensures the well-being of her loved ones.

4. Prayer and Spiritual Influence

Like Moses and the apostles who encountered God's glory (Exodus 34:29-35; II Corinthians 3:4-18), a wife must be a woman of prayer. Her prayers, faith, and wisdom can guide the home through challenges and keep the family spiritually strong. Like Hannah, every issues affecting her family is taken to God on her kneels. The fire of prayer in her life serves as motivation for her children and everyone around her.

Conclusion

Building a godly home is not one sided, it requires both husband and wife to embrace their biblical roles with love, patience, and faith in God. The husband provides leadership, love, and provision, while the wife offers support, wisdom, and nurturing. When both partners walk in obedience to God's Word, their home becomes a beacon of light, reflecting the love and glory of Christ to the world.
