

The word "ploy" simply means a tactic, strategy, or cunning plan designed to deceive, manipulate, or gain an advantage over somebody.Inrelation tothe topic for meditation today, "the ploy of Satan," is his strategic methods to deceive, tempt, and lead people away from God. According to Genesis 3:1, the Bible describes him as being *more subtle and crafty than any living creature of the field which the Lord God had made.* He came into the Garden with the sole aim to craftilymake Adam and Eve disobey God. He did not force them to do so but only asked a question that set their heart at motion against God. In a nutshell, this is temptation.

Why does Satan tempt us? Temptation is Satan's invitation to give in to his kind of life and give up on God's kind of life. Satan tempted Eve and succeeded in getting her to sin. Ever since then, he's been busy getting people to sin. He even tempted Jesus (Matthew 4:1-11). But Jesus did not sin!

Satan's ploys involve using deception, distortion of truth, and appealing to human weaknesses to achieve his evil purposes. His ultimate goal has always been to thwart God's plan and lead humanity into sin. From the Garden of Eden to the wilderness temptation of Christ and even today, he employs subtle and deceptive strategies to achieve his purpose.

The temptation of Jesus occurs immediately after His baptism (Matthew 3:13-17), where He was publicly affirmed as the Son of God. The Spirit then leads Him into the wilderness to be tested by Satan. The wilderness setting echoes Israel's 40-year journey, signifying a time of testing and proving faithfulness to God.

In Matthew 4:1 – *"Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil."* The phrase "led up by the Spirit" indicates divine intentionality. Jesus was not caught off guard by Satan's attack; rather, God permitted the testing to demonstrate Christ's obedience and readiness to fulfil God's greatest plan to redeem mankind from the bondage of sin. In God's will, testing refines His children: in Satan's hands it is meant



1. Satan's first ploy: The temptation of the flesh:Matthew 4:3 – "And the tempter came and said to Him, 'If You are the Son of God, command these stones to become loaves of bread." Matthew 4:4 – "But He answered, 'It is written: Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God."

Satan knew that after Jesus had fasted for forty days and night, the next thing he needed was food.The appeal to hunger is similar to how he tempted Eve (Genesis 3:6 – "good for food").Jesus quotes Deuteronomy 8:3, affirming that dependence on God's word is greater than physical needs. So, Satan often tempts us through legitimate needs, but yielding to temptation outside of God's will is sin.Thistemptation tested Jesus' reliance on God rather than using His divine power for personal and fleshly needs.

2. The Second Temptation (Pride and Presumption): Matthew 4:5-7 -Satan takes Jesus to the pinnacle of the temple and challenges Him to jump, quoting Psalm 91:11-12 out of context.Jesus responds with Deuteronomy 6:16, rejecting the idea of testing God.

Satan distorts Scripture to deceive. We have his likes in our generation who twist the truth to bamboozlethe people of God. This is why we must soak our heart in the Word of God.In the second temptation, Satan took Jesus to the pinnacle of the temple and challenged Him to throw Himself down. This was a test of pride and presumption. By challenging Jesus to force God's intervention, Satan tempted Him to prove His divine status through a spectacular miracle. This would have been an act of spiritual pride, demanding God's protection as a display of power. Jesus rejected this by quoting Deuteronomy 6:16, saying, "You shall not tempt the Lord your God." As believers,we must avoid prideful demands on God and to trust Him humbly without seeking self-glorifying signs.

3. The Third Temptation (Lust for Power and Glory): Matthew 4:8-10 –Satan offers Jesus the kingdoms of the world in exchange for worship.Jesus rebukes him with Deuteronomy 6:13, affirming that worship belongs to God alone.

In the third temptation, Satan took Jesus to a high mountain and offered Him all the kingdoms of the world in exchange for worship (Matthew 4:8-10). This was a test of lust for power, glory, and materialism, tempting Jesus to gain authority and wealth through compromise rather than obedience to God. Jesus rebuked Satan, declaring, "You shall worship the Lord your God,

- 4. Use the power of God's Word (Matt. 4:4& 10, Psm. 119:11, heb. 4:12))
- 5. Do not trust in human's strength but God (Isa. 41:10, 2Thes. 3:3,Psm. 37:5, Prov. 3:5-6).

# Conclusion

Satan's primary strategies are deception, temptation, and destruction. But the Scripture provides clear guidance on how to recognize and resist his schemes.
