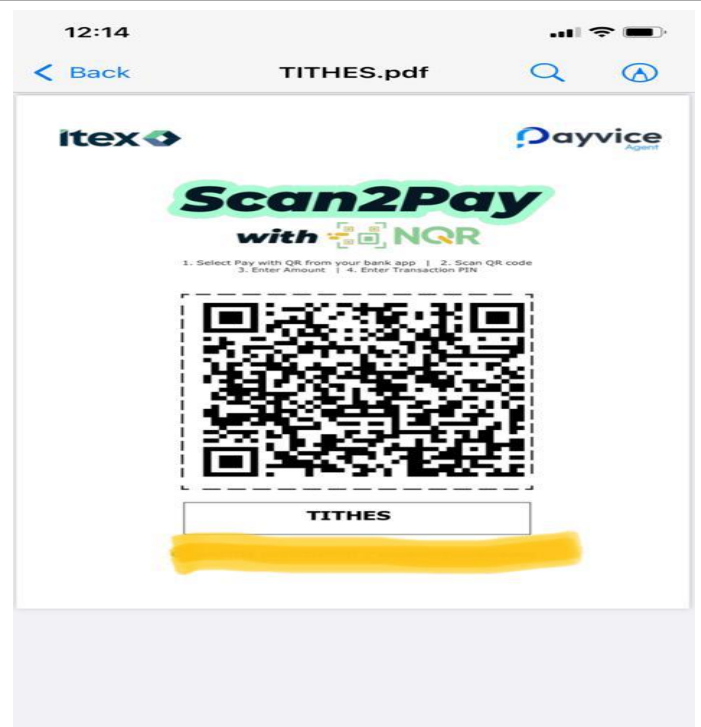

SUNDAY, 25<sup>TH</sup> MAY, 2025**

THEME: VICTORIOUS CHRISTIAN LIVING

READING: PSALM 68:14-20; EZEKIEL 38:8-13;  
COLOSSIANS 3:1-11; JOHN 16:23-33

Victorious Christian living denotes embracing a life empowered by faith and the grace of God (Cf. Hebrews 11), a life characterized by joy, perseverance and a focus on the will of God (Philippians 4:4). It encompasses actively seeking the presence of God and obedience to the Word of God at all times. It is also a life that relies on the strength of God especially during turbulent seasons, embracing His peace and recognizing that victory comes through the power of God alone and not on our own.

It is the desire of God that believers live a victorious Christian life, sadly many do not today and that is why it is very important for us to examine the following **key aspects of Victorious Christian Living;**

- 1. Faith in God and Reliance on the Holy Spirit:** this is one of the essential ingredient for living a victorious life as a believer, it entails trusting in the sovereignty of God and His ability to empower us live a life of victory. We must understand that without faith in God and total reliance on the Holy Spirit it is impossible to please Him and also to become victorious in this side of eternity (Hebrews 11:6, 1 John 5:4, John 16:13-14).



2. **Obedience to the Word of God:** To live a victorious Christian life, the study of the Word of God is crucial and after reading and studying we must apply them because it is in the application of His word that our obedience is revealed or authenticated (Isaiah 1:19, Joshua 1:8).
