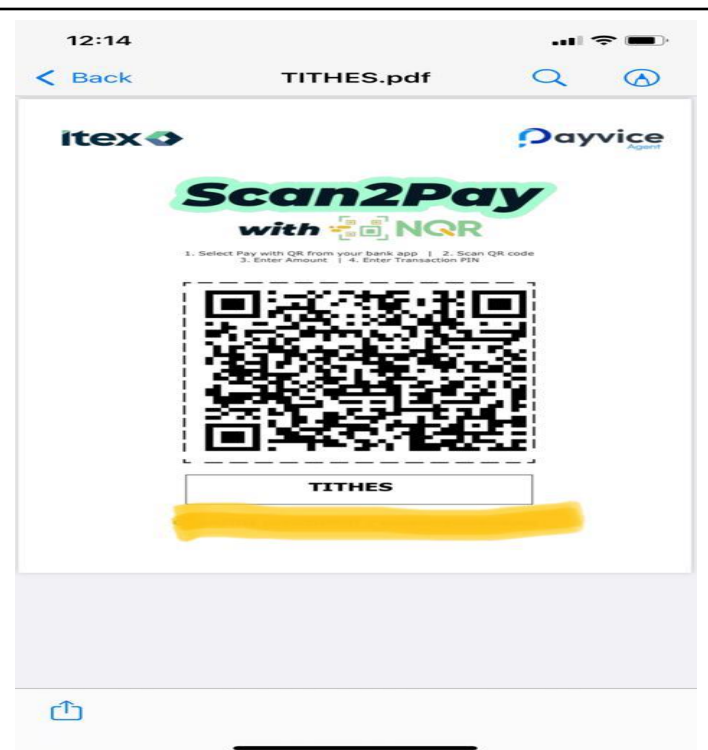

**4. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
SUNDAY, 8TH JUNE, 2025**

THEME: THE WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

READING: PSALM 130; JOEL 2:28-32; ACTS 2:1-21; JOHN 20:19-31.

INTRODUCTION:

Too often, the work of the Holy Spirit is either misunderstood or narrowly confined to emotional experiences or ecstatic moments. But when we look carefully at the story of Scripture, we see that the Holy Spirit is much more than that. The Spirit is God's very breath, active, present, and inclusive drawing people together, guiding them in truth, filling them with boldness, and leading them into healing and transformation.

As we reflect on today's readings, we will discover that the Holy Spirit is not only given to certain individuals or special leaders, but poured out upon all people. The Spirit does not isolate us in personal experiences, but calls us into community, into action, and into deeper faith. Let us journey through the Word and listen for the voice of the Spirit speaking to us today.

1. THE HOLY SPIRIT BRINGS CONVICTION – Psalm 130

In Psalm 130, we hear the raw cry of a soul weighed down by guilt: "Out of the depths I cry to you, Lord... If you kept a record of sins, Lord, who could stand?" These words echo the work of the Holy Spirit in our inner lives. Conviction is not about shame or condemnation; it is the Spirit's way of awakening our hearts to the reality of sin and our need for mercy.

What is beautiful here is that the psalmist does not remain in despair. He turns toward hope, saying, "With the Lord is unfailing love and full redemption." That turning—the movement from sorrow to trust is stirred by the gentle prompting of the Spirit.

And so, when we experience that inner stirring, a discomfort over wrongdoing, a longing to make things right, or a sense that we are far from where we should be, it is the Holy Spirit inviting us closer to God. Whether we are new in faith or have walked with God for many years, these moments of conviction are gifts. They are not to be hidden or feared, but embraced as opportunities for growth. In our communities of faith, we can support one another in this journey, not through judgment, but with grace and honesty, helping each other return again and again to the mercy of God.

**2. THE HOLY SPIRIT FULFILLS GOD'S PROMISE –
Joel 2: 28–32**

The prophet Joel delivers a stunning promise: "I will pour out my Spirit on all people." This declaration would have shocked Joel's audience. In ancient Israel, the Spirit was associated with prophets, kings, and priests, leaders set apart for special purposes. But now God is saying, "My Spirit is for everyone."

Sons and daughters will prophesy. Old men will dream dreams. Young men will see visions. Even servants, those on the lowest rungs of society, will be filled with God's Spirit. This is a vision of radical inclusion, where gender, age, and social status no longer determine one's access to the divine. All are welcome. All are called. All are gifted.

In the church today, we must carry this vision forward. It is not only the pastor or the elder or the worship leader who is empowered by the Spirit. Every member of the community, children and teenagers, men and women, elders and new believers can be filled and used by God. We are called to listen



3. THE HOLY SPIRIT EMPOWERS FOR MISSION — Acts 2:1–21

Pentecost was not just an exciting event with wind and fire and strange languages. It was the moment the Church was born. When the Holy Spirit came upon the disciples, they were not simply comforted, they were equipped. They went from being afraid and hidden behind closed doors to boldly proclaiming the gospel in the streets. People from every nation under heaven heard the good news in their own language.

What made this possible? It was the power of the Holy Spirit. Peter stood up, quoting Joel, and declared that what they were witnessing was the fulfilment of God's promise. The Spirit had come, not just to dwell with believers, but to send them out into the world.

This teaches us that the Spirit is not given only for personal encouragement, but for public witness. Every believer is called to share the message of Jesus, not just in words, but through love, service, generosity, and justice. The Spirit gives us courage to speak, wisdom to act, and compassion to care for others.

We do not need to wait until we feel strong or perfect. The Spirit empowers us in our weakness. As a community, we can encourage one another to use our unique voices and gifts to bear witness. Whether you are a student, a parent, a retiree, or a professional, your life is a platform for God's Spirit to shine through.

4. THE HOLY SPIRIT BRINGS PEACE AND PRESENCE — John 20:19–31

After the resurrection, Jesus appears to His disciples in a locked room, where they are hiding in fear. The first words He speaks are, "Peace be with you." Then He breathes on them and says, "Receive the Holy Spirit." This moment is gentle, intimate, and personal. It shows that the Spirit not only empowers us for mission but also comforts us in our fear and confusion.

Thomas, who was not present, struggles to believe. And yet, Jesus meets him too, not with rebuke, but with invitation. The Spirit, we see, is not impatient with our doubts. Instead, the Spirit leads us gently into deeper faith.

Many of us have experienced seasons of doubt, disappointment, or fear when life feels uncertain, and God seems distant. But the Spirit is near in those moments, bringing peace that goes beyond understanding. The breath of Jesus (the Holy Spirit) is God's promise that we are never alone.

As the Church, we are called to be a people of peace. We are called to create spaces where those who are hurting can find comfort, where those who are questioning can find safety, and where those who are afraid can be embraced with love. The Spirit does not divide or condemn; the Spirit unites and restores.

CONCLUSION:

Across these four texts, we see the Spirit working in many ways —convicting hearts, fulfilling promises, empowering mission, and offering peace. But more than that, we see that the Spirit is for all people. No one is left out. No one is disqualified. Whether you are young or old, male or female, new to faith or a seasoned believer the Holy Spirit is for you. And more than that, the Spirit works through us together, building a Church that reflects the fullness of God's love and truth.

So, let us not limit the Spirit to certain experiences, personalities, or traditions. Let us open our hearts fully to receive, respond, and walk together in the Spirit. May our homes be filled with prayer. May our relationships be marked by grace. May our communities be places of healing, service, and joyful witness. And may our churches be places where every person
