4. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 13TH JULY, 2025

THEME: WALKING IN CHRIST'S FOOTSTEPS **READING:** PSALM 119:57-64; EXODUS 20:1-17; EPHESIANS 5:1-10; MATTHEW

19:16-26.

INTRODUCTION.

What a delight to witness another Sunday! Sequel to last weeks teaching's from the Dean on "Dangers of Materialism", we are then going to consider a template for doing otherwise in "Walking in Christ's Footsteps". In other words, Christ as a prototype. Have you ever seen a child trying to walk in their parent's footsteps on a sandy beach? They stretch their legs, try to match stride for stride, wanting to be just like the one they admire. That's the image Paul paints for us here in Ephesians 5—believers walking in the steps of Christ.

The path of Christ is narrow, costly, and countercultural. It is not just about obeying rules or doing good things—it's about giving Him your heart, your will, and your all.

However, from the text given today we could discern the following from the life of the young man Jesus was speaking with;

Good Intentions aren't enough to work in the footprint of Jesus(vv. 16–20)

The young man was moral and religious—he kept the commandments and lived uprightly.

But good behavior isn't enough. Jesus shows that entering the Kingdom is not about checking boxes—it's about your heart.

"If you want to be perfect, go, sell your possessions and give to the poor..." (v. 21)

As believers, many Atimes, we try to walk with Christ while holding tightly to comfort, wealth, or status. Beloved, We must ask: What do I treasure more than Christ?

Walking in Christ's Path Requires Total Surrender (v. 21)

Jesus points to the idol in the young man's heart: his wealth.

To follow Jesus fully, we must let go of whatever replaces God in our hearts.

"Then come, follow me." Following Christ means letting go—whether it's riches, pride, unforgiveness, ambition, or self-will.

Once more, You can't hold Jesus with one hand while clinging to the world with the other.

18.

3. Walk in Light; "For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light..." Eph 5:6.

Paul doesn't say we were "in" darkness but that we were darkness. Our identity changed when we met Christ. Now, we are light in the Lord, and that light should be seen in how we live—honestly, righteously, and fruitfully. Walking in light means exposing sin, not partnering with it.

As parents, leaders, priest etc.. Are we bringing light to our homes, workplaces, and relationships? Ask: "Is this pleasing to the Lord?" before every decision (v. 10).

Hence to work in Christ path, To walk in Christ's footsteps is to love sacrificially, live purely, and shine brightly.Let us remember, Love is the path, Holiness is the footprint, Light is the evidence.

4. Walking in Christ's Path is Humanly Impossible but Divinely Empowered When the disciples heard Jesus say, "It is hard for a rich man to enter the kingdom...", they were shocked.

"Who then can be saved?" (v. 25) Jesus replied: "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible." (v. 26) God gives the grace and power to surrender, to walk with Him, and to forsake all for His sake. Don't rely on your own strength to follow Jesus. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you live a surrendered life. Salvation is not earned—it is a gift received through faith and obedience.

CONCLUSION

Practical Steps to Walk in Christ's Path from This Passage:

- 1. Seek eternal things, not temporary riches (v. 21)
- 2. Let go of idols—especially the ones you love most
- 3. Rely on God's strength, not your own (v. 26)
- 4. Choose obedience over comfort
- 5. Follow Jesus daily—personally, sacrificially, wholeheartedly.
