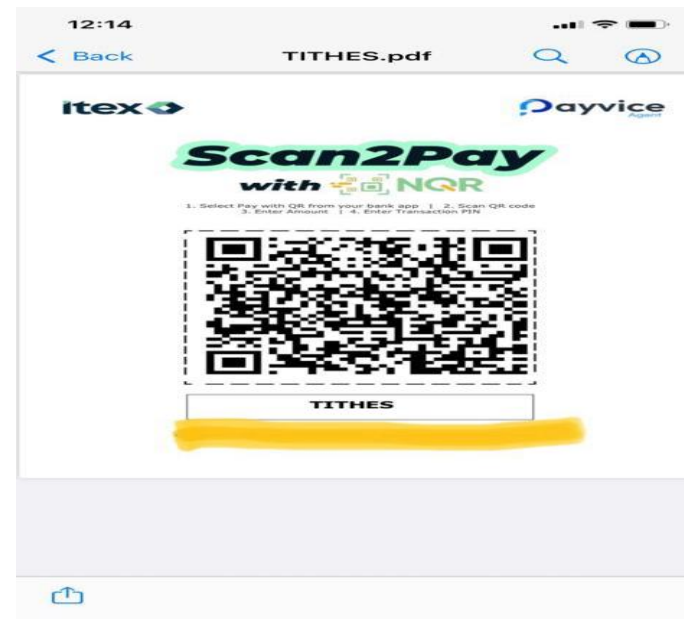

4. **THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
SUNDAY, 20TH JULY, 2025**

**THEME: COURAGEOUS OBEDIENCE: COSTS
AND BENEFITS**

**READING: PSALM 119:17-32; GENESIS 12:1-9;
ROMANS 12:1-8; LUKE 15:11-32.**

INTRODUCTION

I welcome you once again into the presence of the Lord and it is my prayers that this Sunday will usher in good news for you and for your family in the name of Jesus Christ.

The topic we are discussing briefly today is an important one for all believers, especially believers who desire to please the Lord and also to showcase Him to the world. However, it is important to clarify terms before delving fully into the theme at hand. From our theme, the major words are; courageous and obedience.

DEFINITION OF TERMS

The word courageous has its root from courage and by definition courage means the ability to face challenges, overcome fears, obstacles and difficulties with confidence and determination. It is the act of stepping out of one's comfort zone and taking bold action even when uncertain or afraid. However, obedience denotes following instructions or laid down rules.

In the context of the Bible, courageous obedience depict showing bravery in following the commandments of the Lord; it entails trusting in the sovereignty of God and persevering/standing in the will of God even in the face of adversity.

**EXAMPLES OF THOSE WHO SHOWED
COURAGEOUS OBEDIENCE IN THE BIBLE**

We have countless examples of those who showed courageous obedience in the Bible and they include Esther who was ready to risk her life to speak up for her people (Esther chapter 4- chapter 7); Daniel who also refused to compromise his faith even in the face of persecution (Daniel 6); the three Hebrew boys (Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego) who refused to bow down to the King's image even at the face of fire (Daniel 3:16-18); the servant who took the water that became wine to the master of events at the wedding in Cana of Galilee (John 2); Abraham willing to sacrifice Isaac as God requested in Genesis 22 and Jesus' obedience to the Father's will even to the point of death on the cross (Philippians 2:8-10) among several others.

It is important to point out that God expects us all to obey Him courageously without minding the trends of the world system or the distractions of the world. However, it is crucial to note that courageous obedience to God's injunctions has costs as well as benefits. The following are the costs of courageous obedience;

THE COSTS OF COURAGEOUS OBEDIENCE TO GOD

When a believer courageously obeys God, it often comes with significant costs which include potential opposition, sacrifices of personal desires and even physical harm. Infact, in some cases it may lead to death. However, the encouragement that we have is that the costs are often outweighed by the blessings, spiritual growth and eternal rewards that obedience brings.

To put it more pointedly, the costs of courageous obedience are;

1. **Opposition and Persecution:** in the Bible, individuals who obeyed God faced oppositions from those who did not share their faith or values. It can also lead to social isolation or rejection from those who do not share the same belief. Noah endured ridicule for many years for building the ark and the Apostles were persecuted for following the commandment of Jesus Christ to preach the gospel to the whole world.
2. **Sacrifice of comfort and Security:** courageous obedience at times will require you to forfeit personal comfort, security and worldly ambition. Often times we casually read the story of Abraham's obedience to sacrifice Isaac in Genesis 22, have we consider the emotional trauma that He would have had in carrying out that instruction? Do we consider what would have happened to his marriage if God had not stepped in to stop him? What kind of father do you think Isaac will consider Abraham to be after that incident? These are thought provoking issues that we should examine as Bible students.
3. **There is potential for Suffering and Loss:** in some cases, courageous obedience can lead to physical suffering, loss of possession, positions and can even lead to death. The early Christians faced persecution, many were displaced from their lands and some were martyred for their faith due to their courageous obedience to be different in their world. Remember the suffering that Joseph went through in the prison just because he courageously obeyed the Lord's commandment on holiness and would not cohabit with his master's wife.

THE BENEFITS OR REWARDS OF COURAGEOUS OBEDIENCE

There is no one who has stood courageously for the Lord that has lost his or her rewards. It is very explicit in the Bible. The following are some of the benefits of courageous obedience;

1. **Blessings and Favor:** God often blesses those who obey Him, granting them favor, prosperity and protection (cf. Abraham after his attempt to offer Isaac as a sacrifice to God); Genesis 22, Isaiah 1:19.
2. **Spiritual Growth and Intimacy with God:** courageous obedience leads to spiritual maturity and also deepens our relationship with God. It is as we obey God that we know Him better and He takes us deeper in spiritual things.
3. **Eternal Life and Rewards:** courageous obedience is a key element in entering into eternal life and receiving rewards in heaven.
4. **Impact on others or winning others to God:** courageous obedience has the tendency to inspire and also encourage other people to follow God and this leads to contributing one's quota in making a world a better place.

CONCLUSION

It is expedient to note that courageous obedience to God entails faith, trust and willingness to surrender personal desires and face potential challenges. However, the benefits of courageous obedience in both this life and in the world to come, outweigh the costs.
